INDIGENOUS HISTORY

Oliver, BC, is situated on the traditional territory of the Syilx People of the Okanagan Nation, whose ancestors have lived in the region for thousands of years. The Syilx people have a deep connection to the land, with archaeological evidence suggesting their presence in BC since the last ice age. The Osoyoos Indian Band, part of the Syilx Nation, has played a significant role in the region's history and development.

For thousands of years, the Syilx Okanagan people were self-reliant, utilizing the land and its resources to create a sustainable economy through hunting, fishing, growing, harvesting, and trading. The Osoyoos Indian Band continues to honor their heritage and culture, promoting economic growth and sustainability through various initiatives. Their efforts have transformed the landscape and contributed to the vibrant community of Oliver. Today, they remain dedicated to preserving their cultural heritage and fostering a prosperous future.

nsyilxcən Language

The nsyilxcan language, spoken by the Syilx Okanagan people, is integral to their cultural identity. As an Interior Salish language, nsyilxcan is used across eight Syilx communities, including the Osoyoos Indian Band. The Syilx Nation is committed to preserving and revitalizing their language through immersion programs, language nests, and digital resources. The Osoyoos Indian Band, in collaboration with various organizations, is committed to preserving and promoting nsyilxcan. Through educational programs and community initiatives, they ensure this vital language continues to thrive for future generations.

History of Oliver, BC

FAIRVIEW TOWNSITE

Oliver, BC, has a rich and diverse history, beginning with the establishment of the gold mining town of Fairview in the late 19th century. Discovered by Fred Gwatkins and George Sheehan in 1887, Fairview quickly became a bustling community with ten mines, multiple stamp mills, hotels, and various businesses. However, the town's prosperity was short-lived. The decline in gold prices and depletion of resources led to Fairview's decline, and by the 1920s, it had transformed into a ghost town. Today, remnants of Fairview, such as the stone and slate chimney, offer a glimpse into its vibrant



THE DITCH AND AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT

In 1918, Premier John Oliver initiated the Southern Okanagan Lands Project with a vision to transform the semi-arid desert of the South Okanagan into fertile farmland. This ambitious project included the construction of a 40-kilometer concretelined irrigation canal, known locally as "The Ditch." Completed in 1927, this extensive irrigation system turned 8,000 acres of desert into arable land. The irrigation infrastructure is often referred to as the "life line" of the community, enabling the successful cultivation of various crops in the region. The canal allowed farmers to irrigate their lands efficiently, which significantly boosted agricultural productivity.

AGRICULTURAL GROWTH

Following the establishment of the irrigation system, Oliver experienced significant agricultural growth. The fertile land attracted settlers and veterans returning from World War I. The town quickly became known for its fruit orchards, producing a wide variety of fruits such as apples, cherries, peaches, and apricots. By the 1920s, Oliver had gained a reputation for its cantaloupes, becoming known as the "Cantaloupe Capital of

Canada." The hot climate of the area made it the only place in North America where cantaloupe was grown outside of California. This agricultural success helped the community boost its economy, especially during the tough times of the Great Depression.

WINE CAPITAL OF CANADA

In the 1980s, vineyards began to replace some of the orchards, laying the foundation for Oliver's reputation as the "Wine Capital

of Canada." In 2002, Queen Elizabeth II was touring Canada as part of her Golden Jubilee, officially gave Royal Assent to the fact that Oliver is the Wine Capital of Canada. Today, Oliver boasts numerous wineries and vineyards, contributing to its vibrant agricultural and tourism sectors. The town's history is a testament to the region's transformation from a gold mining hub to a thriving agricultural community, highlighting the pioneering spirit and resilience that define Oliver's heritage.

Vaseux Lake



Kelowna International Airport

Serving as a major entry point to the Okanagan, Kelowna International Airport connects travelers to Oliver with a 3-hour bus ride or a quicker option of driving or taking a taxi for approximately one hour and 50 minutes, offering flexibility for your travel plans.

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
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
