If you are looking at doing something different to the average holiday then you have come to the right place! Our exciting overland tours and expeditions offer a unique way to travel and will get you to places far from the tourist crowds as well as to the famous sites on your bucket list.

## WHAT IS AN OVERLAND TOUR?

Overlanding is as much about the travel experience as the places you visit. Joining our trips involves travelling in a group of adventurous travellers, on a custom built expedition truck led by our experienced crew. Our multi-country itineraries range from 13 days to 47 weeks and are designed to visit the best places both well known and off the tourist map. We stop at sites for you to explore or where activities are on offer and take in travel icons such as Machu Picchu, unmissable sites like China's Terracotta Warriors and incredible experiences - safari in the Maasai Mara, anyone? Everyone pitches in together to help with the running of the trip, for example shopping for food in local markets and cooking meals over the campfire. In the evening we set up camp or overnight in a local hostel or hotel. If camping or getting involved in the running of the trip are not for you, check our Small Group Adventure tours where our local tour leader accompanies, using local transport or private minibuses, small locally owned hotels and no cooking required!

## TRAVELLING OVERLAND

The areas of Africa, South America, Central Asia and South East Asia that we visit are an adventure in themselves. Many countries will not have the infrastructure, services or standards that you may be used to so come prepared for anything! Things do not always go to plan and we may not be able to stick precisely to our itinerary but our extensive experience means we are prepared for the many and varied eventualities that we may come across - closed borders, impassable roads, officialdom and inclement weather to name a few! This is all part of the adventure and the challenge of travelling overland. What is very important, more than age or fitness, is that you join these trips with a positive attitude, an acceptance that things will not always go to plan, and with a willingness to sleep in a tent, pitch in, help out and work as part of a team. You don't need to be very fit, but you do need to be able to carry your luggage some distance, and be physically and mentally self-reliant. Here at Oasis Overland we believe overlanding is an incredibly rewarding way to travel where you can get involved in your trip, make life-long friends and experience some of the most fascinating places on Earth. Escape the daily routine and come join us on an adventure of a lifetime!

## WHO JOINS AN OASIS TRIP?

Our groups are made up of adventurous people aged from their 20s up to their 60s and 70s from all walks of life and nationalities who are seeking to experience different cultures with like minded travellers. While some travellers come on our trips with a friend or a partner, at least half travel on their own. If you are travelling solo, then on our overland trips we will pair you up with a traveller of the same sex to share accommodation with so we won't charge you a single supplement fee. You may be able to upgrade to single rooms during the route, or bring your own tent so that you don't need to share. Single supplements may apply on some small-group trips.

## OASIS OVERLAND VEHICLES

Oasis Overland has designed and built many overland expedition vehicles over the years, with most custom built in the UK. The trucks are made with practicality and comfort in mind and to handle the terrain and climates we encounter along the way. Regular maintenance is carried out by our drivers who receive training at our Harare workshop and on the road.

Most Africa overland trucks have large open windows - great in hot weather and for viewing wildlife! A unique feature of many of these vehicles is 'The Beach', an open-top area at the front of the truck. Tarpaulin sides roll down over the windows and across the Beach when needed.

In South America and Central Asia our trucks do not have tarpaulins due to the colder temperatures we often experience, for example in the Andes and Patagonia. These have glass windows which slide open. Trucks generally seat between 20 and 28 people.

Our diagrams and descriptions provide a typical idea of the layout of most of our trucks, however layouts may differ between vehicles. For example, since the Covid pandemic we do now use some trucks with all forward-facing seats.





# TRAVEL STYLES

## SMALL GROUP ADVENTURES

Small Group Adventures in Central Asia, Pakistan, Peru, Bolivia, the Galapagos islands, China, SE Asia, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon and Morocco, using many forms of transport, including; trains, mini vans, 4 x 4 vehicles, overnight trains, private vehicles, camels and planes. You stay in mainly locally owned hostels and hotels allowing interaction with local communities, as well as the occasional night camping (e.g. Inca Trail Trek in Peru). No cooking involved, meals are usually at local hotels, restaurants or cafes. Group size is limited to 14-20 people per tour leader/guide. Please check individual itineraries for various modes of travel.



## OVERLAND ADVENTURES

Overland trips in Africa, Central Asia and South America on purpose-built overlanding vehicles. Africa trips are mostly camping (mainly at campsites but with a few wild camps and plenty of options to upgrade along the way), while trips in South America and Central Asia involve a mix of camping and hostels or simple hotels.

Overland Adventures are run on a full participation basis so expect have fun helping to cook for the group and taking an active involvement in the day to day running of the trip. Expect to sometimes get dusty and dishevelled and not to be able to have hot showers every night. Groups of up to 28 people are led by two Oasis crew.

## ULTIMATE OVERLAND EXPEDITIONS

The BIG ones! Travel off the beaten track on ultimate overland expeditions of up to 47 weeks through Africa, Central Asia and South America. A tougher, more extreme style of our Overland Adventure trips but still using our purpose built vehicles, with one or more Oasis crew and carrying up to 28 travellers. You must expect an even more active day to day involvement in the running of the trip and to wild camp more regularly where there are no facilities. You must expect a higher degree of hardship and to be away from civilization for days at a time. Expeditions are generally long in duration and at times you will be travelling and camping in remote areas and extremes of weather. Step outside your comfort zone to travel somewhere different.





## MINI ADVENTURES

Short on duration but big on experience! Trips range from 3-days in the Maasai Mara to an 8-day Galapagos adventure and can be booked as a standalone trip or added on to your overland trip. We use local operators who we have worked with for many years and who give an excellent service using top quality guides. Kilimanjaro treks, Spanish School in South America and Amazon Rainforest trips are just a few of our Mini Adventures on offer.



## VOLUNTEER PROJECTS

Projects take place in East and Southern Africa and Ecuador in South America. A variety of projects include wildlife and conservation, health and community and children and education. A day's work can range from preparing meals or teaching sports, administrative tasks or children's creative activities, to observing Great White Sharks and tracking wild animals. Projects are run at a grass roots level to ensure benefits are kept within local communities. You need a minimum of 2 weeks to take part in volunteering and if you can take a longer trip, the more you and the project gains from it. You can book a Volunteer Project as a standalone trip or add it to your overland trip.



## FAMILY ADVENTURES

Trips range from 8 days to 29 days in the Middle East, Africa and South America. These adventure trips may use our overland vehicles local transport or private minibuses. Travelling with other families, you will often stay in locally run and owned hostels and hotels allowing interaction with local communities, as well as the occasional night camping (e.g. Berber Camp in the Sahara, felucca sailboats in Egypt, Inca Trail trek in Peru). 

# MINI ADVENTURES & ADD-ONS

Mini Adventures are short in duration but big on experience! Galapagos trips can be done before or after your overland adventure or booked as a small group tour adventure on their own. The Inca Trail and W-Trek options are done during your overland trip.

## W-TREK

The W-Trek is one of the world's great hikes through stunning scenery in Torres del Paine National Park in southern Chile. It is available on all overland tours that travel between Santiago and Ushuaia. With jaw dropping views at every turn, snow capped peaks and ice blue lakes punctuate every photo. Expect to cover around 46 miles (71 km) in total over 4-days hiking.

What's included:

Two nights in Puerto Natales, guide to the Base of the Towers, transfers, park fees, tents and all meals.



## RIO ACCOMMODATION

Many of our trips start or finish in Rio, and we time our itineraries so that we are in Rio either for New Year's Eve or for the Rio Carnival. This accommodation package provides a room and breakfast for 4-6 nights in a simple centrally located hotel very close to a Metro stop. Packages may also include Metro tickets to Copacabana beach for NYE, or Sambadrome tickets for the Carnival.

Explore the wax palms coffee farms around **Salento** and Parque Los Nevados. We venture east into stunning mountain scenery and a gruelling drive through Parque Purace. San Agustin - option to visit the Archaeological Park, home to ancient carved volcanic stone figures and tombs, set in verdant mountain scenery. Popayan - beautiful colonial city. **ECUADOR** - Travel to Otavalo, a bustling market town. Cross the Equator and arrive in the capital, **Quito**.

**ARGENTINA** - Buenos Aires - cosmopolitan city, museums, football matches, tango shows and the best steaks in the world. **URUGUAY** - Montevideo, beaches of Punta del Este and Salto hot springs. **PARAGUAY** - Trinidad Jesuit Mission and Asuncion. **Iguazu Falls** - boat trips, helicopter flights and mountain biking.

A guided tour reveals the bustling medina, tanneries, and vibrant souks. Relax before an optional evening of traditional Moroccan food and entertainment including music and dancing!

### Days 7 & 8 (6 meals)

Drive over the Moyen Atlas to **Midelt** for a short afternoon hike. The next day a stunning drive and an afternoon relaxing and swimming. Then we trek into the desert by camel to spend the night at a **Berber Camp**. Enjoy local food and music under the Saharan stars.



### Days 1 & 2 (2 meals)

**Cairo** - Meet at Cairo airport and transfer to start hotel on day 1. Day 2 sees us exploring the city of Cairo, starting with the **Pyramids and Sphinx** of Giza. We'll have a guided tour and additional free time to explore and enter one of the pyramids if you wish. We'll also make a stop for a tasty traditional Koshary Lunch. In the evening of day 2 we board the overnight VIP seater train to **Aswan**, with an option to upgrade to a private cabin on the sleeper train.

### Days 3 & 4 (2 meals)

After our night on the overnight train, we arrive in to Aswan where we'll visit the **island temple of Philae**, arguably one of the most beautiful temples in Egypt. Later, we'll board a motorboat to travel south of Aswan, to the **Nubian villages**, where we'll stay the night in a local guesthouse and have a chance to explore the local village, seeing traditional homes and the Nubian way of life. From here we board a traditional Felucca sailboat, to enjoy an afternoon sailing along the Nile, watching

rural life as we drift by and sleeping on the deck, beneath the stars. An optional visit to Abu Simbel is also available prior to boarding the Felucca.

### Days 5 & 6 (2 meals)

After spending the night under the Egyptian sky, we return to land and travel to **Luxor**, via the **temple of Edfu**, probably the best preserved ancient temple in Egypt. Luxor is the jewel in Egypt's crown with the largest concentrations of ancient ruins in the Nile Valley, if not the world. These are split across both banks of the Nile, with the City of the Dead on the West Bank and the **Temples of Luxor and Karnak** on the East Bank. In the evening there is an optional tour available to Luxor Temple by night.

On day 6 we have an included tour to the West Bank of the Nile, where we'll visit the famous **Valley of the Kings**, the mortuary temple of **Queen Hatshepsut**, the Valley of the Artisans and the huge **Colossi of Memnon**. We then re-join the overnight seater train for our journey back to Cairo. An optional **hot air balloon flight** is available whilst in Luxor.

### Days 7 & 8 (2 meals)

After arriving back in to **Cairo**, we transfer to our hotel and the day is then free to explore Cairo as you choose or you may take an optional tour.



These include a city tour in Cairo which visits Coptic Cairo, the Citadel and Mohamed Ali Mosque, or a half day tour to Saqqara, Dashour and Memphis to learn more about the history and evolution of pyramid building. Airport is included. Another full day option further afield includes a trip into the desert outside Cairo to see the World Heritage Site of the Valley of the Whales at Wadi Rayan. ### Days 1 & 2 (1 meals)

**Amman** - Meet at Amman airport and transfer to start hotel on day 1. We start day 2 by heading out of Amman to **Jerash**, one of the best-preserved sites of Roman architecture in the world outside Italy. Fondly referred to as the 'Jewel of the North', Jerash boasts an unbroken chain of human occupation dating back more than 6,500 years.

After returning from Jerash we spend the afternoon exploring Amman our tour will include **the Citadel** - the former home of the ancient Temple of Hercules, The Umayyad Palace and the Byzantine Church. We'll also visit the 6000-seat Roman Theatre - which dates to the Roman period, when the city was known as Philadelphia.



### Days 3 (1 meals)


We leave Amman behind as we drive along the King's Highway to Petra. Our first stop will be at **Madaba**, as we visit the Greek Orthodox Church of St. George - famed for its 6th century Byzantine Mosaic map of the Holy Land. Next, we visit **Mount Nebo**. Our last stop before we reach Petra is **Shobak Castle**, which forms part of several Crusader castles built during the 12th century on the Egypt-Syrian caravan route.

### Days 4 (2 meals)

Today is all about exploring the **Nabatean site of Petra**. We have most of the day available to explore this ancient city (2-3 hour guided tour, then free time to explore independently). Our guide will explain how the treasury, and other buildings here, are mainly elaborate facades carved into the rock from the top down, and also discuss the spiritual significance of the building style. You'll have plenty of time to explore the ancient city today before we leave Petra in the afternoon and drive into the spectacular desert scenery of **Wadi Rum** where friendly Bedouin hosts are ready to greet us at a comfortable camp beneath the towering rocks and cliffs. We spend the evening and night relaxing at the camp, watching the stars and enjoying a delicious traditional Jordanian meal.

### Days 5 & 6 (2 meals)

We start the day early, exploring the beautiful desert and mountain scenery of Wadi Rum. Keep an eye out for the copper-coloured rocky 'jebels', which mesmerised



TE Lawrence during his visits to the desert during the Arab Revolt and were later famed in the movie Lawrence of Arabia. We'll take a jeep safari through the stunning landscape, seeing more of the sheer cliffs and bizarre rock formations. We then head north to the **Dead Sea**, the lowest point on Earth, to enjoy a 'swim'. The intensely salty waters lead to a unique experience where normal swimming is not possible; it is far easier to simply float on the surface. You may also choose an optional trek through the canyons of Wadi Mujib. After free time at the Dead Sea, our tour comes to an end on day 6 with a transfer included to the airport.

### Days 1 & 2 (2 meals)

**Beirut** - Meet at Beirut airport and transfer to start hotel on day 1. After leaving Beirut behind on day 2, we head north, making our first stop to explore the awe-inspiring **Jeita Grotto**. Here you'll get a chance to explore part of the system of limestone caves which span a total distance of almost 9km.

Our next stop is **Harissa**, which is famous for the mountain top Christian shrine, dedicated to the Virgin Mary. We'll take the cable car up to visit the church and enjoy the stunning views of the coastline. Our final stop of the day is the unique **Baatara Gorge** sinkhole, where in spring and after rainy periods a 255 meter waterfall cascades down into the enormous cavern. We'll have time for a short hike here and we'll also explore a nearby Douma Village, where a traditional lunch is included.

We spend the night in the **Monastery of St. Anthony**, in a separate building with simple but comfortable en-suite accommodation.

### Days 3 (1 meals)

For early risers, you can join the monks for their morning prayers in the monastery. After breakfast, there will be time to explore some of the **Qadisha Valley**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**.

After leaving the valley, we visit the village of Becharre, famous for being the birthplace of the iconic poet and novelist, Kahlil Gibran. Next, we'll visit the Cedars Ski Resort, famous as being one just a few ski resorts in the Middle East. Later, we arrive in **Byblos**, an ancient Phoenician city that is thought to have been inhabited for up to 7000 years.


### Days 4 (1 meals)

Our destination today will be the **village of Zahle**, however we'll be making a stop along the way at the **Ksara Winery** which is possibly the oldest winery in Lebanon. The caves and tunnels have a total length of approximately 2 miles and have been used for generations as wine cellars. You'll have a guided tour of the caves and winery before sampling (and buying if you wish) some of the produce in a wine tasting session.

### Days 5 & 6 (2 meals)

Next is **Baalbek**! Referred to as 'Heliopolis' or 'City of the Sun' by the Romans and Greeks, it is home to a sanctuary dedicated to worshipping the Heliopolitan triad of gods; Jupiter, Venus and Mercury. In ancient times, thousands of pilgrims would flock to the temple in order to venerate the triad. Today, the temple remains remarkably well preserved.

After leaving Baalbek we'll make a stop at the Umayyad city of **Anjar**, located within the



**Bekaa Valley**. You'll see mosques, palaces and baths. We end the day with a drive back to **Beirut** where we'll spend the night. After a final night in Beirut our tour comes to an end on day 6 with a transfer included back to Beirut airport.

### Days 1 & 2 (2 meals)



After a snack lunch we return to Amman and visit the fun and interactive **Children's Museum** with exhibits dedicated to the human body, ancient civilisations, stars and space, optical illusions, and some fun flight simulators built into child sized planes, hot air balloons, pedal planes and much more.

## Days 3 & 4 (3 meals)

Leaving Amman, we drive along the King's Highway, one of the most scenic roads in the Middle East. We will include a stop to see the **Roman mosaics at Madaba**, a leg stretch amidst the huge canyon and olive groves of **Wadi Mujib**, and time to explore

the walls and tunnels of the huge **crusader castle at Kerak**. We then have one of the main highlights of the tour, as we tour the fascinating hidden **Nabatean city of Petra**. ## TRIP COST & LOCAL PAYMENT

Most of our trips involve two payments. One is the Trip Price which is payable to Oasis Overland or your Travel Agent before departure. The other payment is what we term a 'Local Payment' or LP, which is payable to the Tour Leader upon joining the trip. Once the Trip Price has been paid and Local Payment collected they are guaranteed and Oasis Overland will not ask you for more money. Both these payments go towards the total trip price and are not refundable once your trip has started. Local Payments are not applied on our Small Group Adventure trips.

## WHAT IS THE LOCAL PAYMENT?

This is a pre-determined amount which contribute towards various local costs that cannot be paid or are costly to pay from the UK. It enables your crew to pay for some services in cash directly to local people on the ground such as for food, local guides, accommodation, gas, firewood, entrance fees to sites or game parks. This helps reduce the overall price of the trip which in turn passes cost savings onto you. The advantage of Local Payments over 'kitty' based systems is that once this has been collected it is a guaranteed amount - you will not be asked for additional payments. Once your trip has started, the Local Payment, as with the pre-paid trip price, is not refundable even if you leave the trip temporarily, stay in different accommodations, or finish early.

## OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS & ACTIVITIES

Optional excursions and activities can be organised during your trip and are run by the local operator, not by Oasis. You can decide whilst travelling which of these you may want to do. We feel that having optional excursions gives a greater degree of flexibility and independence to decide how much your spending budget can afford. They are paid for on the day direct to the local operator, ensuring your money stays with that operator in the local community and also ensuring that you are paying the true price for any excursions you do. If you decide not to join an excursion, you will have free time to relax or wander off to a market, village or beach, depending on where we are. Prices shown on our website are given as a guide only.



## MINI-ADVENTURES & TRIP ADD-ONS

In certain areas you can experience a Mini-adventure/Add-on before, or after your trip - some you can do even without booking one of our trips. These are activities such as accommodation during Rio Carnival, Masaai Mara game safaris, climbing Mt Kilimanjaro or a Galapagos Islands trip.

Some other Add-ons that take place during our trips can also be added before you travel, and indeed need to be booked and paid for in advance so that we can make sure all the permits and arrangements are in place. These include the Inca Trail and W-Trek in South America, and primate trekking permits in Africa. Please see our website for details of current options.

## RESPONSIBLE TRAVEL & LOCAL COMMUNITIES

Oasis Overland realise the important role we play in ensuring that our trips are run responsibly to maximise the potential benefits to local communities and minimise the negatives. We believe that our trips should benefit local people and their environments, or at the very least not harm them. On all our trips we aim to put as much back into local communities as possible. We endeavour to shop at local markets and use locally owned and run hotels, campsites, operators and guides. We have a clear environmental policy which travellers are advised of prior to travel and this is reinforced by our crew at the start of each trip. Travellers are advised of things they can do on their trip that will make a positive difference to the environment, people, wildlife and regions through which we travel.

Oasis Overland is committed to working with local operators and service providers and supporting communities with our trade. We recognise that we have gained so much from the countries we have operated in over the years that we also want to give something back to those who are unlikely to benefit much from tourism.

As such, we support community, wildlife and children's projects in Kenya, Egypt, Zimbabwe and Tanzania. This includes an annual set of day trips for the 100 plus children from a Zimbabwean Children's Home on our overland trucks which our Oasis crew volunteer to run.

# TRAVEL INSURANCE & FINANCIAL PROTECTION

## Travel Insurance

We believe that your safety and holiday enjoyment are very important. It is a mistake to think an accident or injury "will never happen to me". It is a compulsory requirement on ALL Oasis Overland trips that anyone joining one has adequate travel insurance.

## Travel Insurance requirements

When selecting your policy, you must ensure that it is designed for adventure & overland travel. Your travel insurance must cover you for all the adventure activities you may plan to do on your trip, such as white water rafting (up to grade 5), bungee jumping, mountain biking, quad biking, trekking & horse riding etc. and at the very least you are insured for all necessary medical & repatriation costs. If you already have an annual travel or a credit card travel insurance policy, please check carefully with your insurers that they provide the cover you require, as many limit cover for trekking above a certain altitude, mountain biking, white water rafting above grade 3, quad biking etc. Whilst you may find cheaper insurance you need to be aware of EXACTLY what activities your policy covers you for and more importantly what they DO NOT.

It is also extremely important that you check the full extent of your cover relating to 24 hour Medical Emergency Assistance and Covid-19, and any potential travel through areas with government travel advisories in place.

## ADVENTURE TRAVEL REALITY CHECK

A journey anywhere in the world, even from your home to place of work, can expose you to risk of an accident. However, travelling in the developing world can expose you to risks not normally faced at home and the type of travel on all our trips can sometimes (be it our Small Group Adventures, Overland Adventures, Ultimate Overland Expeditions or Family Adventures) can sometimes be less predictable than you may expect. We therefore ask you to read the information online (or in our brochure) as well as our booking conditions and the pre-departure information for your trip, along with the information here.

## ADVENTURE TRAVEL WITH OASIS OVERLAND

The countries we visit can have lifestyles and expectations very different to more developed countries and events may occur that will require patience and understanding from you the traveller. Health and Safety and operational standards, particularly of hotels and local transport, can be unpredictable and are generally not up to western standards. However experienced and organised we and our Tour Leaders are, we are often at the mercy of the unpredictable. It is important to remember this and be aware that our type of trips can never be guaranteed to be without a hiccup or two. Especially on our longer overland trips, it is essential that you join with a positive attitude to pitching in, helping out, embracing some camping, and are both physically and mentally self reliant.

## ITINERARIES

Because we do not operate normal 'package holidays' the maps and itineraries displayed in our brochure and website cannot be guaranteed to run exactly as shown. However, it is rare that we have to make major changes and if we do, this will be discussed with you either before or during the trip. If it isn't possible to enter a certain country or region due to safety concerns, visa problems or political turmoil etc, and it becomes necessary to overfly in order to continue a trip, all costs for flights will be borne by you and not Oasis. Should it not be possible for an Oasis trip to start/finish at a scheduled location due to border closures, civil unrest or other reasons out of our control, Oasis will make all reasonable efforts to start/finish the trip at a convenient alternative location. However, all additional costs that you may incur in travelling to/from the alternative location will be paid by you or your insurance company and not Oasis. On some of our expeditions we may pass through a country or region that the British Government ([www.gov.uk/foreign-travel-advice](http://www.gov.uk/foreign-travel-advice)) advise against travel to. On these occasions Oasis will inform you in advance.

## ACCOMMODATION & YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

We aim to use accommodation that is locally owned and operated. However, while reasonable care is taken in selecting accommodation, the Health and Safety regulations in the countries through which we travel are not up to the standard of western countries. Care should be taken by you to familiarize yourself with the general layout of the accommodation, in order to become aware of any specific risks or safety features, e.g. what route you would take to exit in a fire or if a hotel or campsite has a swimming pool it may not have any safety signs. You should also expect occasional problems such as unreliable plumbing and a lack of hot water. Some of our trips may only pass through a particular area once or twice a year and in this time the standard of the staff and accommodation can change a lot, so please be prepared to accept inconsistencies such as this as these are things we have very little control over. If you choose to travel on this type of adventure trip in developing countries you must be prepared to accept that these types of incidences are all part of the experience.

## TRANSPORT & ROADS

In many countries in which we operate the road conditions and the transport regulations and facilities are not up to the standard of advanced western countries. Roads can be very badly potholed with unmarked speed bumps, lack of warning signs and road markings. Sometimes we will drive off road on dirt roads or unmarked pistes. Other road users are often in vehicles which are poorly maintained or driven. Passenger Liability Insurance may not be available in some countries, and in some areas we may be able to arrange it, but with very low coverage levels.

## EMERGENCY SERVICES

In many countries we visit, once we are outside major cities the emergency services and hospital facilities can be of a very limited nature compared to western countries. In summary it is very important to accept that our trips involve an element of personal risk and are of a potentially hazardous and unpredictable nature.
