



In a world of successful resortstyle cruising options catering for the next generation of cruise aficionados, it is possible to overlook those smaller companies offering a classic approach to cruising. Read on to hear from cruise expert Jamie Robins as he reveals why he fell hook, line and sinker for 'The Olsen Way' as the family-operated cruise line celebrates over 170 years of seafaring heritage across five generations and two World Wars.

With three ships in the current fleet, Balmoral, Borealis and Bolette, and no more than 1,400 passengers per ship, you'll get the traditional, intimate feel of these ships with fewer passengers than so many of

the new builds. These sisters also visit a wider range of ports thanks to their smaller size and ability to navigate narrow waterways and canals. Fred. Olsen ships also depart from a greater range of UK ports than many of their competitors, such as Southampton, Portsmouth, Dover, Liverpool and Rosyth - a welcome option for passengers wanting to avoid flights and hours of travel prior to embarkation.

TAKING THE PLUNGE

On revealing my inaugural plans to get my feet wet, figuratively, with Fred. Olsen, I was surprisingly greeted with comments alluding to a 'different demographic' and

experience to mine. I am in my 40s, to be clear, and it had never occurred to me to not choose a cruise line that largely attracted an 'older' British clientele. I wanted to find out if 'The Olsen Way' was a myth and, my goodness, this preconception of age equating to an experience unsuitable for someone like me was one I would strongly challenge.

THE OLSEN WAY

Opting for a five-night cruise on board Borealis which sailed from Liverpool, we docked in colourful Cobh, Ireland, and historic Belfast, Northern Ireland. On embarking Borealis, I really did get all the 'feels' of a homely ship, with a





To say I was impressed by my inside cabin was an understatement. I am not usually a fan of windowless accommodation, but finances dictated so. However, with ample space, splashes of colour, a wonderful cabin stewardess, in-cabin dining options and close proximity to amenities (on a ship the size of Borealis, everywhere is easily reachable), a windowless life did not seem so bad, and my envy

of passengers with ocean views and verandas was mitigated - if not completely subsided.

With a retractable roof for all weather conditions, the lido deck, featuring a large, heated pool, comes to life with the addition of large hot tubs, a well-stocked bar, regular live music and poolside grill serving delicious brunch and lunch options - included in the cruise fare.

"For £10 per person sharing a cabin, try the thermal suite located at the front of the ship. You get the entire space to yourselves for each hour you reserve. Yes, just you and your cabin mate (or ditch them!), hot tub, saunas, outdoor section with loungers, showers - I even ordered canapés and half a bottle of bubbly to luxuriate further - bliss!"

What I say now is no exaggeration; the food on board Borealis was the biggest surprise to me, not just for the quality and variety of options served in the buffet (which is no ordinary buffet with its many live cookery stations) and main dining room, but also the Asian speciality dining at the Vasco and Colours & Tastes restaurants. These cost £10 per person if booked in advance and, at over 60 cruises I have



enjoyed across multiple lines, Fred. Olsen has some of the best food at sea. I challenge anyone to disagree!

HOME

The overall experience was one of little luxuries often missing on other cruise lines. Efficient, proud service by a happy crew wanting to make you feel every bit as special as you are. A sense of space and calm throughout no queues, no endurance tests. Exquisite food, interesting ports of call with excursions for all. And ves, every time I stepped back on board, I knew I was at home and experiencing The Olsen Way. Did the 'older crowd' put me to shame with their high energy and dance moves? Absolutely. Will I be back? I think you know the answer...

In August 2023, I was lucky enough to experience my firstever cruise on Norwegian Cruise Line's brand-new ship, Norwegian Viva, on her inaugural sailing. We embarked at Barcelona and sailed to Rome, stopping at Cannes and Florence; and, whilst a short cruise, it certainly allowed us to see everything it had to offer...and we weren't disappointed!

FOOD AND DRINK: THERE'S SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE. FROM CASUAL QUICK DINING TO SOMETHING EXTRA SPECIAL

Something that impressed me on Viva was the food and drink options; whether you opt for the standard Full Board package or add premium drinks and speciality restaurants, there was plenty of choice!

In fact, the 'standard' restaurants were my favourites, including Hudson's. Located at the back of the ship and surrounded by views of the sea, the setting of this restaurant is one of the best on board. We sat by the window, so we could enjoy those sea views as we dined and ordered the French onion soup, rotisserie chicken and king prawns with creamy mash potato and peppers - all of which were enjoyed. Another standout restaurant included in the standard Full Board package is The Commodore Room, where steaks are the speciality - a great choice for a treat at no extra cost!



Daytime or casual dining options include the Surfside Café - located by the main pool area and perfect for a quick burger and chips and the Indulge Food Hall with an incredible choice of options from all over the world, all of which can be ordered straight from your table's very own tablet. For something extra special, I'd recommend booking a table at the supplementary restaurant, Palomar - with fish and seafood being the star of the show here.

And we haven't even started on the drinks! There are lots of bars dotted around the ship to enjoy a tipple, and my favourite spot was the Soleil Bar around 5pm. As the heat of the day was less intense, it was the perfect time to sit back. relax with a cocktail in hand and watch the waves.

Something that I noticed on board is the variety of seating areas on deck and within the bars. Whether you wish to find a secluded spot and settle in with a book, or hang out with the whole family, this is a cruise ship that caters for absolutely everyone. They've thought of it all! For those looking for some relaxed, quiet time, head to the Observation Deck (where the views are pretty good too)! For those seeking something a little livelier during the evening hours, head to Syd Norman's Pour House for a few drinks and live music.





There are plenty of entertainment options too, including live Broadway style shows and karaoke. If live shows are your thing, make sure you book in advance to avoid disappointment. They get booked up quickly!

FRIENDLY AND PERSONABLE SERVICE

I'd been told by all cruise goers that the service on board will always be exceptional, and they were certainly right. Viva has a relaxed feel throughout, and the staff were friendly, personable and always provided a service with a smile - plus, if they saw you with an empty drink in hand, would ask what else they could get for you. Nothing was too much trouble, and the staff set the tone throughout the ship, which made for a wonderful atmosphere.

"There was a real mix of customers on board, from young families to couples of all ages and solo travellers meaning that this is a cruise ship for just about everyone!"



Viva would be classed as a midsized ship, allowing 3,000 guests on it; but with so many areas on board, and seating areas dotted throughout, never once did it feel crowded. What I really loved was the outside space that was available throughout the length of the whole ship - which you don't get with all cruise lines. If you're looking for a premium level ship, with a relaxed feel, I would absolutely recommend Norwegian Viva!



Another Company dumps interestant things is Uniworld. The luxury river cruise line recognised that so many multigenerational families go away together, and it designed a 'Discover the generations collection' with this demographic in mind. Each Generations Cruise – be it the Nile or the Rhine – that the company runs will have a special programme of events and excursions designed for all members of the family. 



Guests can usually pre-book shore excursions with their local travel agent, before they board, and the most popular and exclusive ones do tend to sell out quickly. So, if you're sailing on a Mediterranean itinerary because you're desperate to see Pompeii or the Leaning Tower of Pisa, it's worth booking with your travel agent early to secure your place.

Whether you prefer touring holidays, city escapes, beach breaks or cruising, we know many of you are seeking more authentic on-land experiences. This can be as tricky with cruise holidays, as, by their very nature, shore excursions cater to thousands of people, making it hard for them to each offer a tailored experience. The typical format has always been: board a coach, travel to a site or experience and then board the coach and head back to your ship.

This can work in certain situations where travellers have a set expectation. For instance, if you're heading for a guided tour of the Louvre in Paris, you know it's going to be busy, and it undoubtedly will be. Where it can sometimes falter is when there are staged interactions with people that masquerade as authentic. It's why there is a growing movement to create more authentic shore excursions that give a better experience to the traveller and engage local communities more with tourism.

An example of this is six-star cruise line Explora Journeys. Having only launched in 2023, Explora Journeys was able to build its shore excursion (which it called Destination Experiences) programme from scratch. The company chose to offer a greater choice than its competitors but with much lower availability

per Destination Experience. By offering experiences to smaller groups, it means that there is more the company can offer, meaning a better experience for both the client and the local community.

Satiate your curiosity on this expert-led tour that stops at three restaurants cherished by locals, for rum tastings, cocktails and savoury and sweet West Indies dishes." Or, how about taking a hot air balloon ride over Napa Valley? This Experience sees guests glide over one of the

world's most famous wine regions followed by brunch in Yountville, where vintner Robert Mondavi first put Napa Valley on the global wine map.

As a first-time cruiser, I really didn't know what to expect and, quite frankly, the idea of a cruise just didn't sound like my cup of tea at all, especially as my other half is prone to severe seasickness and travel sickness in general. Three Virgin Voyages later - all in the space of 10 months - I guess you could say I've been converted (and no - he wasn't sick)!

ITINERARIES AND 'SHORE THINGS'

Our first cruise with Virgin Voyages was the 'Valiant Caribbean Holidays' itinerary which we went on over Christmas, and what a fantastic way to spend it! We embarked from Miami on a round-trip visiting Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic and Bimini, and, although we missed out on the rainforest tour in Puerto Rico, we more than made up for it by jumping from waterfalls, zip lining

through lush foliage and going on a muddy buggy ride in the Dominican Republic, In Bimini, we channelled our inner Bear Grylls and went scuba diving with hammerheads and a tiger shark in the open ocean, which is one of my top life experiences to date.

For our second cruise, we did the 'Greek Island Glow' itinerary round-trip from Athens, visiting Santorini, Rhodes and Bodrum, with an overnight stay in Mykonos, which, out of the three, was my favourite. With over 1.200 Greek islands in existence, this was a brilliant way to see some of the most sought-after destinations in Greece - and Virgin Voyages offers a generous amount of time in each to truly explore the islands.

Santorini and Mykonos were ridiculously stunning and, if you don't end up booking any excursions with Virgin Voyages, I would definitely recommend hiring a quad bike or car for the day to see as much of the islands as you can. Whilst all the food back on

FOOD AND DINING

Unlike other cruise lines that do buffet food in one big dining hall, Virgin Voyages allows you to book a table at six terrific and varied restaurants serving made-to-order food in addition to seven other eateries.

The standouts for me include The Wake, not only for the wonderful view of the ocean from its huge windows but also because of the chic design and delicious steak and seafood options on the menu. We're talking roasted bone marrow, clam chowder, salt-crusted dorade and New Zealand lamp chops - yum!

Pink Agave serving Mexican food was also amazing and, in my opinion, served the best steak on

board, but the Pato (roasted duck) seemed to be the winner amongst others. Check the event line-up once on board and book this one on the same evening as Agave After Dark for free shots and a live DJ playing epic salsa beats!

Serving Korean BBQ-style dishes, Gunbae is great if you're travelling as a big group or going solo and are up for socialising. You will all be sat at one big, round table which begins with a super fun drinking game to break the ice. The Haemul Pajeon (seafood pancake) here is very yummy, so be sure to order for the table to share.



TOP TIP:

You can make dinner reservations via the app 45 days before your voyage, whilst those with Rockstar bookings get the advantage of booking 60 days in advance. Walk-ins are accepted providing there's availability

- but embarkation and sailing days in particular are when you want to be sure you have a reservation.


ON BOARD ENTERTAINMENT


WITH SMALL SHIP CRUISING

From the farthest corners of Alaska to Australia's unexplored coastline, for as long as there has been travel, there has been a fascination with getting off the beaten track. They usually offer the chance to stay late and - more often than not - are centrally located, so an evening's entertainment is just a short stroll away.

Take Alaska as an example. During the summer season, the region attracts dozens of cruise ships which mostly sail a tried and tested route, taking in the highlights. However, even if you board a relatively smaller ship, like Oceania, you can see gems like Sitka, a tiny city on Baranof Island in Alaska's Inside Passage.





This unique place offers an intriguing mix of indigenous and Russian history, as it is the ancestral home of the indigenous Tlingit people and once served as the capital of Russian Alaska. It's a classic example of a small ship going to a relatively popular area and being able to offer its guests a totally different experience to the larger vessels.

Or what about Australia's Kimberley region? The area is renowned for being one of the world's last wild frontiers, with sunken mangrove forests, deserts and waterfalls. The scenery is incredible and the wildlife, out of this world. It's also home to arguably one of the greatest natural wonders on Earth with Montgomery Reef, where the tidal movement is so big (and fast) that the reef appears to rise out of the sea, along with a host of marine life, from octopuses to dolphins and sea snakes. Whilst there might not be a Broadway show on these smaller vessels, Seabourn has a world-class expedition team and a 6-seater submarine. Oceania may not have an ice rink but it offers what it calls the best cuisine at sea.

So, to truly get off the beaten track, it seems the answer is to board a smaller ship. You'll avoid the crowds, find yourself immersed in a destination and, more than likely, see something completely new.
