REGISTRATION/SCHEDULING PROCESS

Due to the progressive nature of private voice/music lessons, all continuing students are given priority in class placement. Returning students must register by August 18 for Session I and October 6th for Session II to be given priority placement. Once returning students are placed in the schedule, the instructor contacts new students in the order in which they registered. New students will receive a call as soon as space becomes available in the schedule. The instructor does his best to accommodate all new students, but space is limited. (CB)

Beginning and Intermediate Voice Lessons






