Hands-on Gardening and Seeds/Edible planting

Part of the workshop focuses on building students' confidence and skills in gardening.

They are taught how to take a cutting from a common herb - such as rosemary, mint, lemon balm, or thyme - and shown the steps needed to help it grow into a healthy new plant.



Understanding SuDS and Flood Prevention

In this part of the workshops, students are introduced to the purpose and function of their newly installed SuDS planters.

Through live demonstrations and guided discussions, they learn how these planters help slow the flow of rainwater, reducing the risk of surface water flooding in the school grounds.

The sessions explore key concepts such as drainage, permeability, and climate resilience, making environmental infrastructure tangible and relevant.
