In fact, from Oct. 2007 - Nov. 2009, Ryan was appointed to serve a seven-parish area as a Judge for the Office of Workers' Compensation. On the bench, he presided over hundreds of trials and hearings. This experience benefits his clients with the highest standard of legal representation. During his service as a Workers' Compensation Judge, Ryan also completed training at the National Judicial College in Reno, Nevada.
