Overture Center for the Arts Restroom Accommodations Guide

All restrooms in Overture Center for the Arts are accessible and ADA compliant. However, some patrons may require additional information to accommodate their individual physical needs.

The following document is designed to offer some information on the features of the different restrooms in this complex.

Gender specific restrooms 🕴 🛊

Restrooms located throughout the building specify either Men † or Women † . Each restroom has at least one stall that is accessible.

Restroom locations with push button openers 🔥

Overhead Signage: While all restrooms have accessible stalls, the wheelchair symbol & only appears on the overhead signage of those restrooms that have automatic door openers for the exterior doors.

Family Assist & Gender Inclusive restrooms 🕴 🖠 🔥

Family Assist is a large single room unit that is designed for use by those who need assistance or additional accommodations. Urinals with floor drains and auto flush are located in each family assist restroom, as well as various sizes of changing tables: Infant=32"x22.5" or 34.5 x 21.5 Toddler=41"x22.5" or 47"x 21" Child=57"x22.5"

Sharps Containers

Overture Center has two restrooms with sharps containers, both located in Gallery I. This is indicated by (*Sharps*) on the chart.

Restroom stall configurations to accommodate individual needs

Left side opening: means the stall has space for the wheelchair to the left side of the stool -- when the wheelchair is facing out of the door (facing the exit) $\bigcirc \ \ \ \ \ \ \$ This usually means that handrails will be on the wall nearest the stool.

Right side opening: means the stall has space for the wheelchair to the right of the stool --when the wheelchair is facing out of the door (facing the exit) **& O**. This usually means that handrails will be on the wall nearest the stool.

Opening to the front: means the stall has space for the wheelchair directly in front of the stool -- the wheelchair will always be facing away from the door. These stalls are usually long and narrower with handrails on both sides.
