Flavors of the Spanish Coast | Itinerary and Highlights (subject to change)

Day 1: EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day 2: ARRIVE IN BARCELONA, SPAIN | MADREMANYA Upon arrival an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the property. Take time to unpack and settle in before joining fellow travel companions for a welcome dinner. Overnight: El Racó de Madremanya (D)

Day 3: GIRONA Take a guided walking tour of Girona passing contemporary museums, galleries, churches, bars and restaurants, plus the Jewish Quarter. After lunch on your own, meet at Rocambolesc Gelateria for a treat. Late afternoon return to El Racó de Madremanya for a hands-on cooking class to learn the art of making paella—one of the region's most famous dishes. Overnight: El Racó de Madremanya (B,D)

Day 4: PÚBOL | FIGUERES | PALAU SATOR After breakfast set out for Púbol to tour Gala's Castle—a serene and secluded refuge Salvador Dalí gave to his beloved wife and muse, Gala. Continue to the Dalí Theatre-Museum for an inside visit. Next stop at the medieval town of Palau Sator for a brief walking tour, plus a visit to the museum Rural De Palau-Sator. Gather together for a lovely dinner at Mas Pou Restaurant before returning to the property. Overnight: El Racó de Madremanya (B,L,D)

Day 5: EL PORT DE LA SELVA | CADAQUÉS | CANTALLOPS See Sant Pere de Rodes, a 10th-century Benedictine monastery, and hear the legendary tales shrouding its origin. Stroll through Cadaqués before visiting Masia Serra Winery for a vineyard tour followed by dinner featuring a wine pairing. Overnight: El Racó de Madremanya (B,L,D)

Day 6: MONELLS | CALELLA DE PALAFRUGELL | ST. SEBASTIA (LLAFRANC) | PALAMOS Begin with a visit to the medieval town of Monells for a guided walk. Next drive to Palafrugell for a seaside walk between Calella de Palafrugell and Llafranc before lunch at El Far. This afternoon visit Museu de la Pesca to learn about the fishing industry's history and importance to the region. Continue to a local market to see a fish auction in action. Peruse the fresh seafood, including selections you will use in a hands-on cooking class to create dishes for tonight's dinner. Overnight: El Racó de Madremanya (B,L,D)

Day 7: LA BISBAL | EMPÚRIES | L'ESCALA Walk through the local market in La Bisbal, the capital of Catalan pottery. Continue to the ruins of Empúries to view part of the legacy left behind by Greek and Roman civilizations. Excavations began in 1908 and continue to this day. This evening relax and dine at Michelin-starred Massana in Girona. Overnight: El Racó de Madremanya (B,D)

Day 8: EMPORDÀ Following a leisurely morning, delight in a picnic lunch at the property. This afternoon set out for La Vinyeta, a family-run winery. Meet the owner and vintner to explore the grounds of verdant vineyards and olive trees. Tonight join fellow travel companions for a farewell dinner featuring an exciting Flamenco dance performance to celebrate your memorable time exploring the Spanish Coast. Overnight: El Racó de Madremanya (B,L,D)

Day 9: MADREMANYA | BARCELONA | DEPART FOR U.S. After breakfast transfer to the airport for flights home. (B)

(B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner)

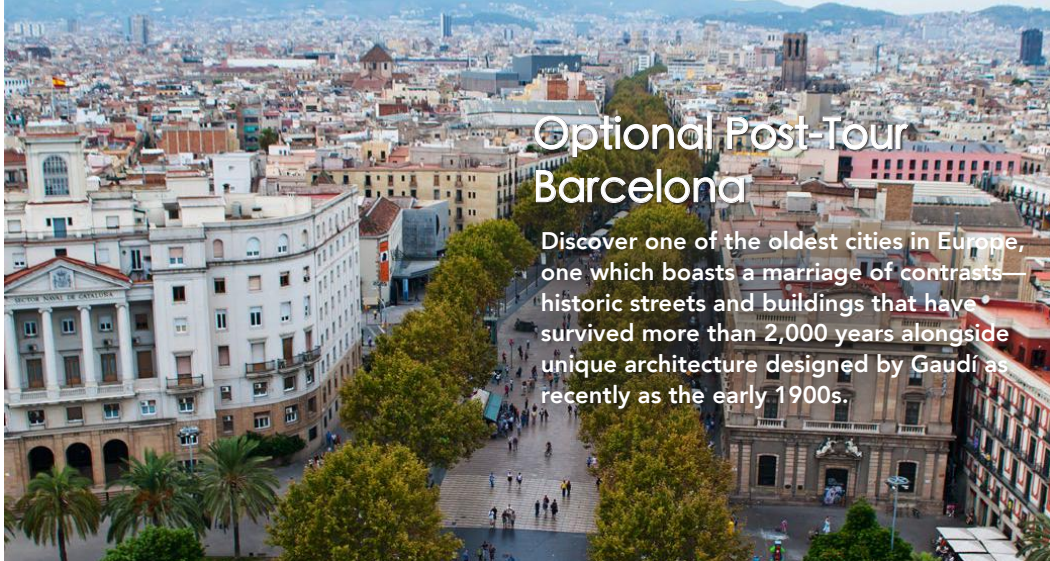

Optional Post-Tour Barcelona

Discover one of the oldest cities in Europe, one which boasts a marriage of contrasts—historic streets and buildings that have survived more than 2,000 years alongside unique architecture designed by Gaudí as recently as the early 1900s.

Day 9: MADREMANYA | BARCELONA After arriving in Barcelona set out on a panoramic visit of the city, passing by Paseo de Gracia and La Pedrera. As you absorb the lively atmosphere, explore the interesting examples of magnificent architecture, from 14th-century Gothic style to early 20th-century Modernism. Enjoy views from Montjuïc before arriving at today's featured highlight, an inside visit to La Sagrada Família—Barcelona's most visited attraction—where you'll have a guided tour inside the crown jewel of Antoni Gaudí's works.
Overnight: Hotel 1898

Day 10: BARCELONA | GOTHIC WALKING TOUR Today enjoy a walking tour through the narrow streets of medieval Barcelona. Discover the elegant and inspiring Catalan Gothic architecture. From here, travel back to the Middle Ages visiting the Jewish Quarter and the El Born district. See popular locales, such as Plaça Reial (Royal Square) and its Fountain of the Three Graces, Carrer Ferran and Plaça del Pi. Also visit inside the Gothic Cathedral, and make a stop at the Santa Caterina Market. Finish with a walk through Moncada Street, passing the Picasso Museum toward the magnificent Santa Maria del Mar Church, one of the most beautiful in Barcelona.
Overnight: Hotel 1898 (B)

Day 11: BARCELONA The day is yours to enjoy Barcelona at your leisure. Perhaps visit the Picasso Museum or take a pleasant stroll down Las Ramblas, Barcelona's most famous pedestrian boulevard. Venture to Parc Güell, a public park and municipal garden.
Overnight: Hotel 1898 (B)

Day 12: BARCELONA | DEPART FOR U.S. After breakfast guests departing during the suggested times take the complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home. (B)
