



THE REXBURG POLICE STATION BOND *Will Appear on the November Ballot*

This bond is to pay the cost of construction of a police station facility, together with related improvements and costs.

The interest rate anticipated on the proposed bond issue, based upon current market rates, is three and ninety-two hundredths percent (3.92%) per annum. The total amount estimated to be repaid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$22,589,638, consisting of \$16,750,000 in principal and \$5,839,638 of interest. The term of the bonds will not exceed fifteen (15) years from the date of issuance. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed bond levy is a tax of \$61.51 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. As of November 4, 2025, the water system will have debt in the amount of \$6,746,137 that is paid solely by water utility revenues and not by property taxes. The City currently has no other general obligation debt.



NEW! METER READINGS TO CONTINUE THIS WINTER!

In an effort to better serve the community, the Rexburg Water Department is planning to continue reading water meters throughout the winter! New radio meters have been installed, allowing for this change. However, with new equipment, we must add the caveat that our efforts are contingent on the equipment working correctly. Stay tuned and look for updates here in our newsletters, on your utility statements, and on our social media channels!



WINTER WATER & UTILITY PREP - WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Remember to stop watering your lawn by October 15th.

We have a reminder on our City calendar if that will help you remember! This prevents water line freezes that can lead to costly repairs. *Continuing to water could affect your sewer rate used from October 16 to April 15 as your winter average for that rate. to set their sewer rate?*

Before turning up your heating systems for the year, ensure you've tested your CO and smoke detectors and replace batteries as needed! It's a good time to review your utility bills for energy and usage and concerns and address potential inefficiencies.

NEW UTILITY RATES GO INTO EFFECT OCTOBER 1ST!

In September, a Public Hearing was held to address updates to utility bills. These updates will effect garbage rates and safety lighting fees. The new rates go into effect on October 1st and you will see the changes on your November utility bill. OKTUBERFEST!



Yard debris should be collected in separate garbage bags and should weigh no more than 50 lbs. If you have large branches, tie them into bundles 4 feet long and/or 50 lbs. or less.*


BIG BURG DISC GOLF TOURNAMENT!




Safety Tip

The City of Rexburg has three seats open for election this year. During our candidate filing process, 8 candidates registered to appear on the ballot, with one of them being an incumbent council member.



CELEBRATING THE INSTALLATION OF FIBER WITH SILVERSTAR!

In 2022, the City of Rexburg began the arduous process of installing fiber network cabling throughout all of our neighborhoods, with the intent of allowing for faster and more reliable internet coverage for our community. The fiber network was called "Lightbridge Fiber."

In 2023, Silver Star partnered with the City of Rexburg to purchase Lightbridge and complete the installation process. While the City maintains ownership of the infrastructure for the cabling, Silver Star partners with us to operate the Lightbridge services.

We're very excited to announce the completion of the installation process! Fiber network should now be available for every residence in Rexburg! In honor of the completion, a community event is planned for **October 9th from 4-7 PM at Porter Park. Please join us for fun, games, and more!**
