VALIDITY

FINAL PAYMENT & ACCEPTANCE OF BOOKING

If full payment is not received before departure the booking will be treated as canceled and retain the deposit paid on booking as a cancellation fee. CANCELLATION BY THE PARTICIPANT

You may cancel your booking by notifying your concierge, but the deposit is non-refundable.

Cancellation received 72 hours or less before departure will not be refunded and the client must pay the %100 of total cost according to the price of your selected private tour.

Notification: 72 hours or less before pickup

Penalty: (100%)

Description: Clients may cancel the tour without any refund. Applies a penalty of %100.

Notification: Less than 72 hours or more before pickup

Penalty: (70%)

Description: Cancel a tour more than 72 hours before the designated pickup time, applies a cancellation fee of 70% of the total price. The client allows the company to apply the booking deposit as the cancellation fee. Only 70% will be refund.

Notification: No Show
