#### Clayton, NY

# Tips!

An excellent place to visit if you have truck enthusiasts in your family! Be sure to check the height restrictions for the truck attractions on the website before you go (https://diggerlandusa.com/). Although Diggerland is close enough that it can be a single-day trip from Long Island, my family usually opts to purchase season passes and makes a long weekend of it. With unlimited visits and other in-park discounts, the pass pays for itself after the 3rd visit. I would recommend starting the day by driving trucks in the morning, then switch to the water park in the afternoon. And rainy days are still good days for Diggerland; yes, you get wet but the crowd is smaller and the lines, if any, are short.



#### Hallock State Park Preserve

"Niagara Falls is a beautiful must-see for anyone in the Tri-state area. The falls are impressive, to say the least. Over 3,000 tons of water, fed by four of the great lakes, plummets from three famous features: American Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, and Horseshoe Falls.

While were were there, we were able to enjoy the Maid of the Mist tour over the waters at the base of the falls. The trip truly brought to life the amount, height, and power of the water pounding into the basin. Although ponchos are provided, be prepared to get wet.

In addition to the Maid of the Mist there are other experiences to enhance the views. Beginning at dusk each day you can view beautiful Illuminations, an LED presentation of colorful lights that drape the falls and make them glow during the evening hours. Love fireworks? Every night from May through October (weather permitting) you can view lovely displays exploding over the Illuminations show adding an additional color-filled sight.

With the addition of other experiences such as the Cave of the Winds, hiking trails, the observation tower, and separate local attractions, Niagara Falls is a perfect place to spend a week or just a weekend with the family."

#### **About this location**

Shelving Rock Falls is a 50-foot cascade that lies to the east side of Lake George. It is an easy hike with a wide, unmarked dirt trail that leads straight to the cascade's top.

# Tips!

Make sure to buy tickets to all events in advance. Spectators are encouraged to dress up and participate in the Halloween spirit.

Make sure to bring a folding chair and/or a blanket so you have a place to sit. If you need a hotel, I highly recommend the Courtyard by Marriot in Tarrytown or the Comfort Inn and Suites located in Hawthorne, about a 15-minute drive from downtown Sleepy Hollow.

#### **Recommendations**

I highly recommend attending the nighttime performance of the Legend of Sleepy Hollow, which takes place on the front green at Washington Irving's Sunnyside estate – a whimsical, two-story 19th century Dutch-Tudor style house wrapped in ivy and wisteria. Chairs are set up on the lawn, providing a comfortable space for the audience to enjoy the show. Though, be aware, the headless horseman may be lurking about!



#### **Sweetbriar Nature Center**
