ANTI-HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Reclaim's strategic focus on anti-human trafficking runs through all our programs.

We combine the strengths of our community development, health and wellness, education, and agricultural programs to integrate methods that mitigate risks for individuals vulnerable to or victimized by human trafficking. We implement best practices for trauma-informed care and intentionally work to address the injustices of trafficking and care for those at risk, so they feel valued, seen, loved, protected, and empowered to experience abundant life.

EDUCATION

Reclaim education programs focus on individuals and communities on the margins of society like refugees, students with disabilities, and those without access to adequate education.

Through teaching English as a second language (TESOL), music education, librarian and teacher training, academic tutoring, literacy programs, and special education services, we nurture holistic flourishing that impacts communities and helps people develop the fullness of their God-given potential.



Making a healthier life possible

HEALTH+ WELLNESS

Reclaim health and wellness programs provide access to high-quality healthcare services, health education, and medical equipment to elevate the quality of life in the communities we serve.

Our professionals bring together evidence-based expertise, excellent medical equipment, and proven best practices with an understanding of challenges faced by local communities to demonstrate love and promote holistic, sustainable flourishing.

AGRICULTURE

Reclaim agricultural programs provide training in regionally appropriate soil rejuvenation methods to lift small-holder farmers above bare-minimum subsistence levels and help them thrive.

We provide participatory extension programs, working side-by-side with farmers to identify more fruitful crop varieties and management methods. As we discover techniques to improve yields and provide greater sustainability together, we equip farmers to teach others in an organic, dynamic process with long-term, wide-ranging impact.

DISABILITY SERVICES

Reclaim's strategic focus on disability runs through all our programs. We work to identify and remove societal and relational barriers that exclude persons with disabilities.

Our programs are designed for people of diverse abilities and provide tools, like custom-fit wheelchairs, awareness training, and accessible technology, that help individuals and families navigate obstacles caused by disability.

We strive to create an environment where all people are valued, loved, heard, and included so that we all flourish and experience the fullness of our God-given dignity together.






