Bengaluru's Unnati set to be 1st to list on social bourse

Mumbai: SGBS Unnati Foundation, a Bengaluru-based notfor-profit (NPO) organisation is set to be the first entity in the country to list on a social stock exchange (SSE). The foundation is all set to open its zerocoupon-zero-principal (ZCZP) bond offering for Rs 2 crore on Monday, reports Partha Sinha. The issue will close on November 7, its top officials told TOL SGBS Unnati Foundation's ZCZP bonds are expected to be listed on the SSEs of NSE and BSE on November 30.

An SSE is an enterprise that works towards the benefit of the society by getting people

SGBS Unnati Foundation, a not-for-profit organisation, will be the first to list on an SSE The foundation will open zero-coupon-zero-principal (ZCZP) bond offerings, ZCZP are debt instruments (bonds), that neither pay interest during the tenure of the bond nor pay back the principal once the project ends and these bonds cease to exist
