
### **Finding Her Voice & Building Connections**

Designed for those with low to moderate support needs, it enhances access to music education and helps shift perceptions about each individual's ability to learn, create, and engage through music.



### **Charting a Path for Inclusion**

The Music Academy is Florida's only program of its kind, originally founded as the Southwest Florida Music Education Center before merging with STARability in 2024. Designed for neurodiverse adults with a passion for music, it offers individualized education that fosters social integration and personal growth. Through collaboration with families and instructors, each participant follows a customized Individual Pathways Plan (IPP) to access meaningful social, educational, and vocational opportunities.



### **Expert Instruction**



Participants benefit from the expertise of Music Program Director Lisa Barnett, MT-BC, a Board-Certified Music Therapist, and Dr. Teresa Herrero Taylor, a Licensed Psychologist and Board-Certified Behavior Analyst with extensive experience in inclusive music education.


