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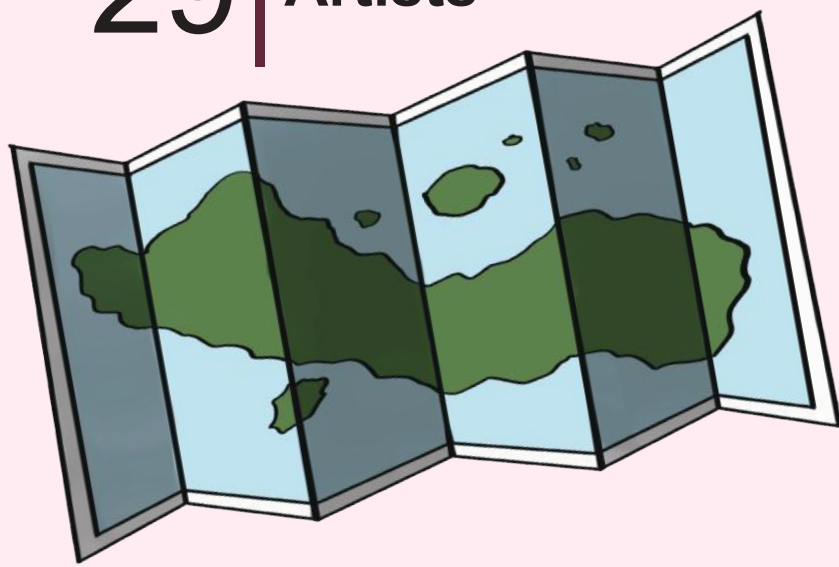


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Welcome Letter !

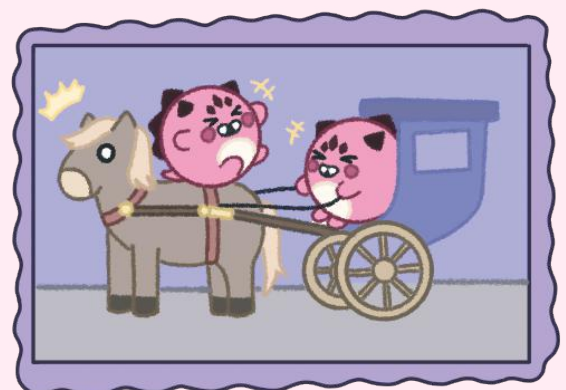


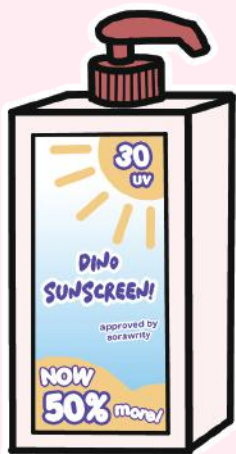
A good place to get your adrenaline pumping is to go to Las Dunas de los Algodones, Mexicali. There you can go up and down in 4x4 Racers at full speed.

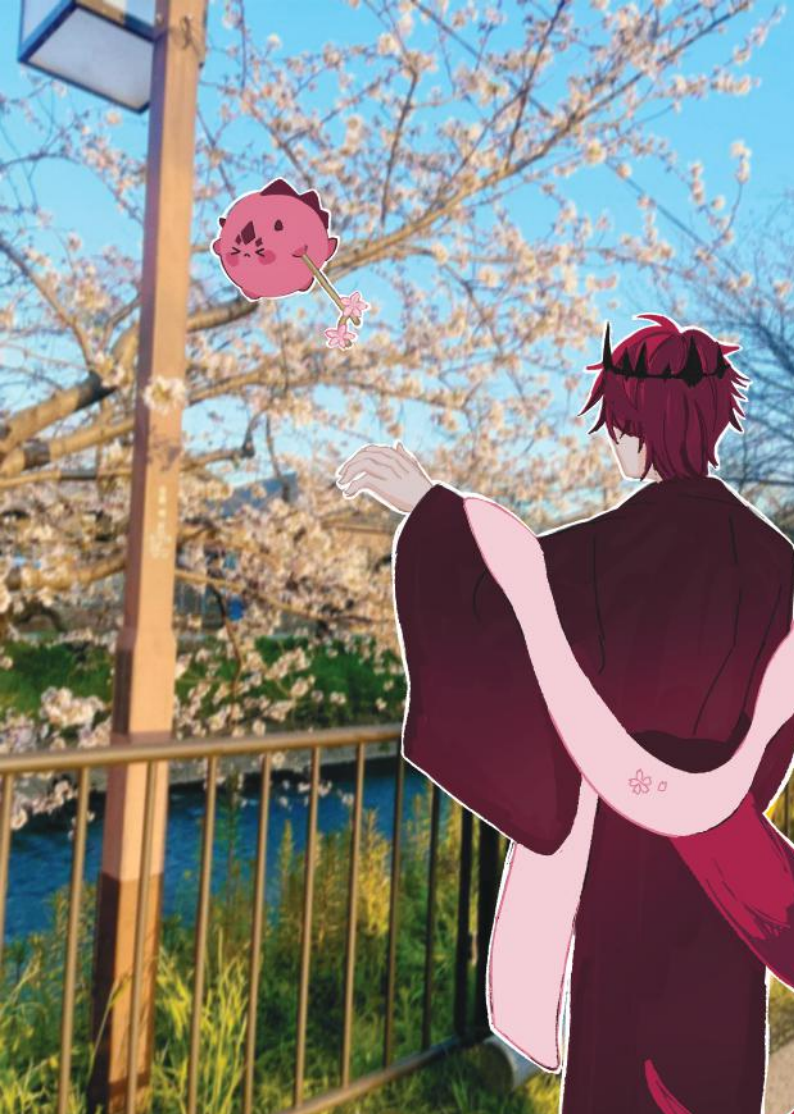
Middle East

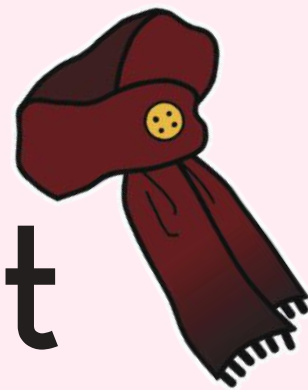

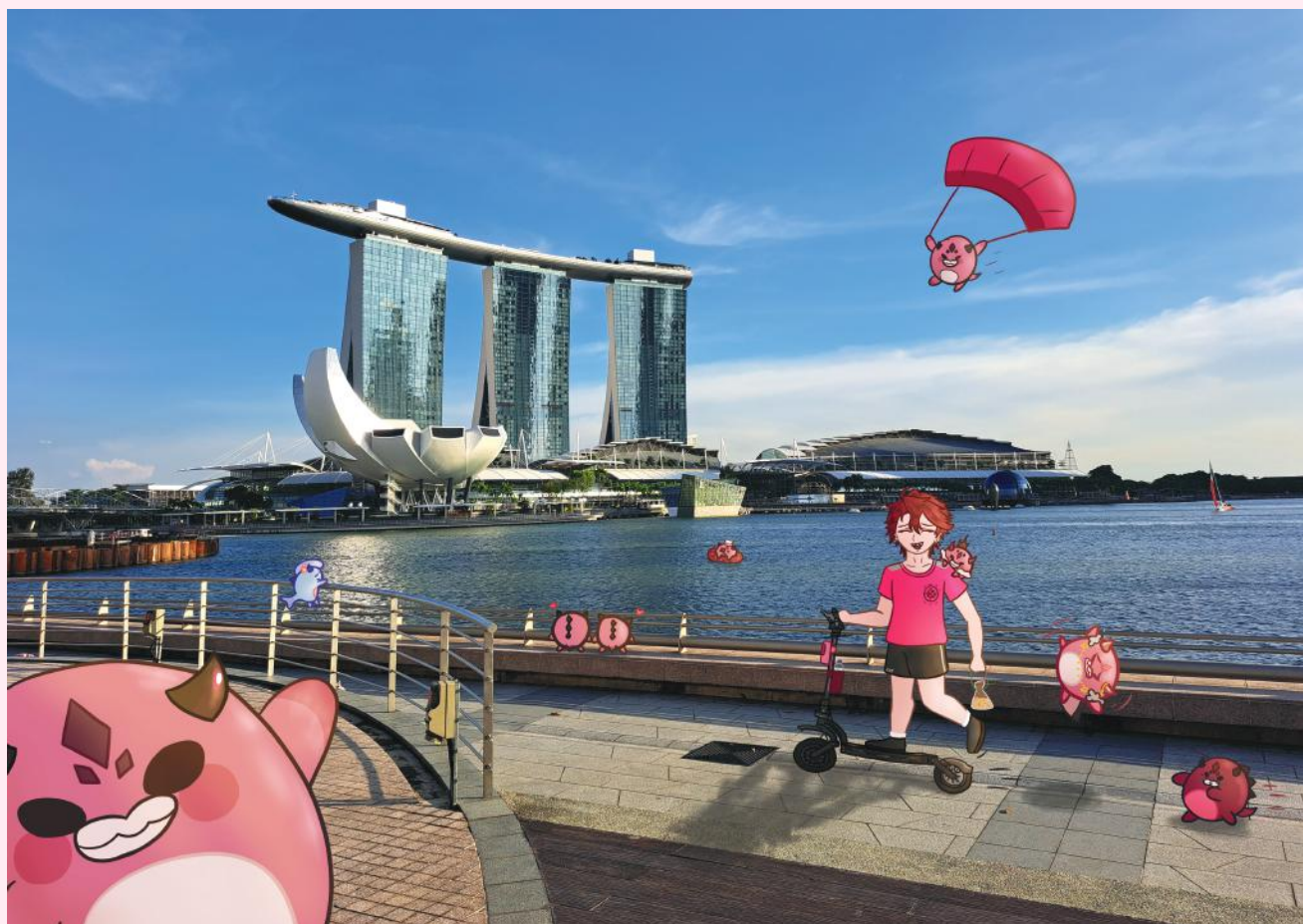




Southeast Asia
