

Rome & Vatican City

What better place to start a grand cultural tour than the Eternal City? Imagine the French Riviera in the 1950s and you'll have an idea of Montenegro today. Tivat radiates old school glamour, a picture-perfect town leads down to a marina full of million-dollar yachts, basking in the ubiquitous Montenegrin sunshine. Your waterside hotel is the Regent Porto Montenegro, serene and exquisitely well appointed, overlooking the rich blue waters of the Bay of Kotor Enjoy the view from your balcony and let the sea air and charm wash over you.




This tiny country is rich in history and an afternoon trip to the medieval town of Kotor will give you a glimpse of the region's battle-scarred past. This rugged coast of steep limestone cliffs dropping into jade green waters, is also regarded as Europe's southernmost fjord. All this can be appreciated from the deck of a private yacht, as you cruise towards Catovica Mlini and the tiny island of Our Lady of the Rocks. This jewel surrounded by water is home to an impossibly pretty Roman Catholic church - prepare to be enthralled.



Montenegro, literally, the land of black mountains, is also a beach lover's paradise with more than 117 beaches stretching along 293km of stunning Adriatic coast.











Located in southern Jordan, Wadi Rum's 720sq km of desert showcases the steepsided, granite and sandstone rocks and wide, sandy valleys that have been home to nomadic Bedouin tribes for centuries. Though most Bedouin are now villagers, some maintain a wandering lifestyle for many months of the year.




Petra & Wadi Rum

Your flight into the Red Sea port of Aqaba will be followed by a drive into extraordinary Wadi Rum. This stunning landscape boasts a maze of monolithic rock formations and incredible petroglyphs. This is where TE Lawrence helped stage the Arab Revolt during WWI, and later where his life story was filmed as Lawrence of Arabia. You'll overnight under canvas at the authentic Saraya Rum Camp, a taste of Bedouin life beneath the stars - there's a peacefulness in the desert that's both tranquil and inspiring in equal measure. Few ancient sites in the world afford the visitor such a mesmerising glance into the past. The lost Nabatean city of Petra, hidden within a gorge and hewn into the very rock that shields it, is one such place. There'll be plenty of time to soak up the atmosphere on a tour and an evening visit illuminated by candlelight and a mist of frankincense. But our first evening really sets the scene, with an exclusive banquet at Little Petra. We'll dine to the sights and sounds of local folk dancers, as beautiful lighting reveals the monuments from a truly enthralling perspective.



Petra was an important hub on ancient trade routes such as the Silk and Spice Roads. A natural movie set, many films have been shot here perhaps most famously Steven Spielberg's Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade.


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Jaipur

From the Rose Red City of Petra, you'll travel on to Jaipur, India's pink city. Once you've checked into the spectacular Oberoi Rajvilas you can take a moment to soak in the atmosphere while enjoying a glass of cardomom spiced tea. There's an exotic beauty to this wonderful city, overlooked by the Amber Fort perched on a hillside, the hustle and bustle of daily life is intoxicating. Occasionally elephants come and bathe in the nearby lake at the foothills of the fort, you may see them as you're whisked through the city to the Samode Palace where camels, musicians and dancers will lead you towards a sumptuous dinner.







Take a leisurely morning and indulge yourself at the hotel's wonderful spa facilities. There'll be yoga sessions at the hotel for those who'd like a meditative morning on the terrace. Later we'll head out to explore the City Palace (a fusion of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture), the 18th-century Jantar Mantar observatory and the incredible latticed façade or the Palace of the Winds. Finish the day on the hotel's terrace, watching the city glow in the evening light.








Ranthambore

Ranthambore National Park, once the hunting grounds of Jaipur's maharajahs, is home to the magnificent Bengal tiger. Expert guides and forest rangers will lead you on safari to spot these incredible animals, travelling in 4WD vehicles, you may also catch sight of marsh crocodiles, sloth-bears, striped hyenas, porcupines, and leopards. Many of the tigers here have become famous and Machli, known as the Queen of Ranthambore, was considered the most photographed tigress in existence. Ranthambore is also a birdwatcher's paradise with more than 300 species of native and migrant birds including flamingoes, kingfishers, woodpeckers, Indian grey hornbill and nightjars. Jungle safaris can be exhilarating so recharge your batteries and revitalise back at the elegant Sawai Vilas, a luxurious resort of elegant private villas and a world-class spa.









Taj Mahal

No tour of India is complete without experiencing a rail journey through the sweeping countryside, so from Ranthambore you'll take the train on an exhilarating trip to Bharatpur. From here, it's on to Fatehpur Sikri, once the capital of the Mughal Empire and now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Then it's on to Agra and to perhaps the world's greatest monument to love, the Taj Mahal. This extraordinary monument was commissioned in 1632 by the emperor Shah Jahan as a mausoleum for his devoted wife Mumtaz Mahal. Now considered one of the wonders of the world, for many it is seen as the ultimate embodiment of undying love and marital devotion. You'll be able to enjoy the hypnotic sight of the Taj Mahal from the spectacular terrace at The Oberoi Amarvilas, little wonder that it is, perhaps, India's most celebrated hotel.



Samarkand is widely believed to be one of the world's most beautiful cities, it's also very old, older than Rome.

Samarkand

Samarkand is one of Asia's oldest cities and this jewel of Uzbekistan was a key trading post on the Silk Road. The dazzling blue tiled architecture of this city is quite extraordinary, the Gur-e-Amir Mausoleum in Registan Square and the mosaic covered Ulugh Beg Madrasah may not be as famous as the Taj Mahal, but you'll wonder why not.

Plov is the national dish, and you'll sample this during a lunchtime cooking class, before completing your day with dinner served on a rooftop overlooking Registan Square - the perfect backdrop as the sun sets over this striking city. You'll have the chance to explore a local vineyard and taste wine from vines that can be traced back to the Roman occupation of these lands. Or head over the Zarafshan mountain range to Shakhrisabz. The journey is a lengthy, but worthy one as the city was the birthplace of Uzbekistan's national hero, Amir Temur. Widely regarded as one of history's greatest military leaders, Temur created an empire that stretched all the way to India. His patronage of art and culture can be seen everywhere and cemented Samarkand's reputation as one of the world's most beautiful cities.









Istanbul

It's little surprise that a city that straddles continents has so much culture and seemingly endless opportunities to eat and to shop. However, you may be reluctant to leave your hotel such is the all-embracing loveliness of the Ritz-Carlton Istanbul, your days could be idly spent watching river cruisers navigating the straits.



Your spellbinding tour of the Roman hippodrome, home to thrilling, chariot races, will conclude at the incredible 3,500-year-old Obelisk of Theodosius. A visit to the iconic Hagia Sophia, one of the largest religious shrines ever built will be followed by a relaxing afternoon at the luxurious Hürrem Sultan Hamami for an invigorating Turkish bath. Dinner at the opulent Sunset Grill & Bar will not disappoint, the most celebrated fine dining restaurant in Istanbul boasts spectacular views of the Bosphorus strait and the Asian shoreline.

A morning stroll through the Mısır Çarsısı spice bazaar will dazzle your senses. Don't forget to pop into the Ali Muhiddin Haci Bekir shop, the inventor of Turkish delight, for a delicious souvenir. Your very last farewell dinner will be preceded by cocktails on board a private luxury yacht as we cruise the Bosphorus towards the magnificent Sait Halim Pasha Mansion. Named after a former Ottoman Grand Vizier, this neo-classical masterpiece known as the Mansion of the Lions is steeped in history and remains one of the city's most glamourous and beguiling venues. By day, Istanbul is a bustling metropolis but at night, the city glitters and the air is rich with frangipani and jasmine, the perfect place to end your perfect adventure.
