


At USP College we are on a mission to connect young people to great career pathways by providing exciting work and networking opportunities.



Our T-Level students might even inject fresh perspectives into your business.


T-Levels are new 2-year courses which are taken after GCSEs and are broadly equivalent to 3 A Levels. Launched in September 2020, these courses have been developed in collaboration with employers and education providers so that the course content meets the needs of industry and prepares students for entry into skilled employment, an apprenticeship or related technical study through further or higher education. The success of T-levels relies on the collaboration of employers. We are seeking industry placements for each of our T-level subjects:

- Accounting
- Digital Production, Design and Development
- Education & Childcare
- Engineering, Manufacturing, Processing & Control
- Health
- Legal Services
- Science


Sector Board Member


Staff Industry Day
