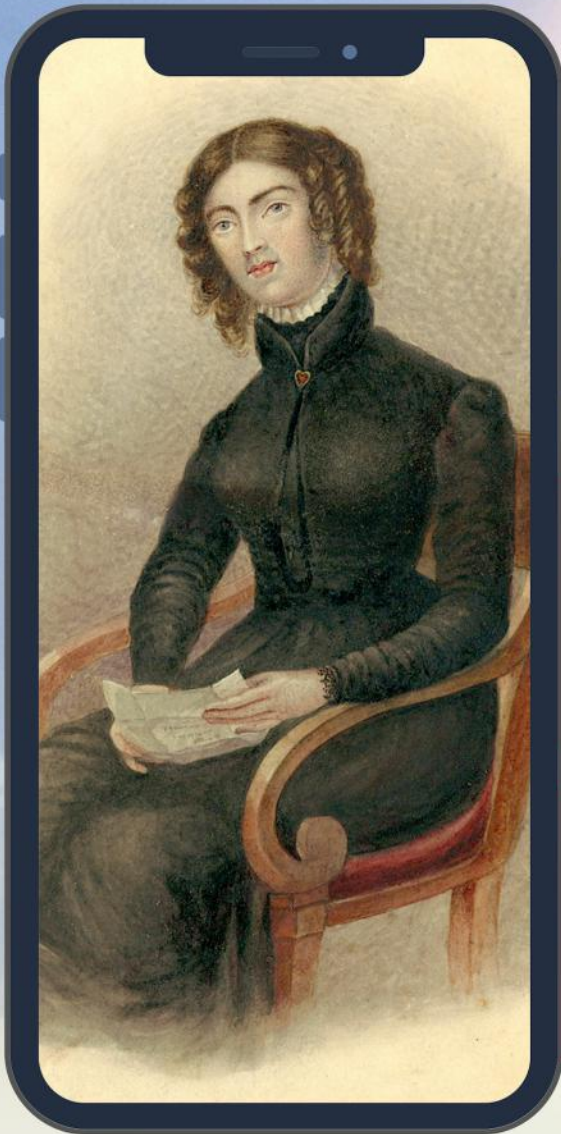

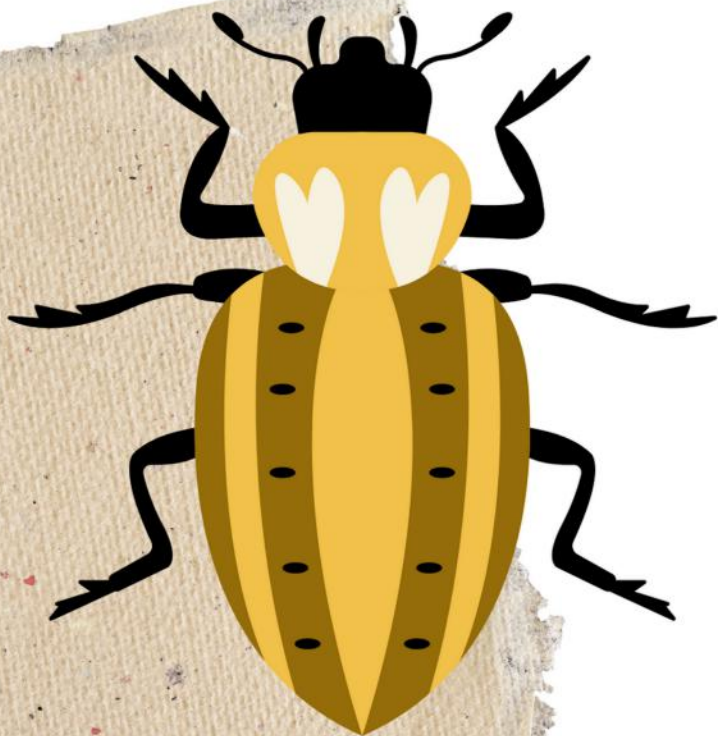

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

Travel manager/writer, independent

June 1827 - October 1839 · 12 yrs 4 mos

- Planned and coordinated high volume multi-modal domestic and international journeys, for short and long-term individual and group travel. Managed budgets and money exchanges, procured necessary documentation such as passports, visas, and other clearances, and organized accommodation, transport, tours, climbs, outings and rides in over 100 national and continental destinations.
- Wrote broadly about cities and towns across Europe for over a decade, covering lodging and local attractions with special attention to the architecture of houses of worship and hircine availability. Reviewed local cuisine and accommodations extensively, informed by cultural context and traditions, while corresponded.

Coal proprietor, Walker/Listerwick

November 1835 -September 1840 · 5 years 2 months

- Established and managed the productive Walker and Listerwick collieries, diversifying the long-term investments of the Shibden estate portfolio, while championing shaft-style mining practices and successfully introducing new job opportunities for youth in the Yorkshire region.

Estate manager, Shibden Hall

January 1826 - June 1839 · 13 years 5 months

- Oversaw the Lister portfolio's expansion and managed administrative tasks such as the estates' budget and legal documents. Supervised and managed all ground and house staff, providing feedback and overseeing day-to-day operations, as well as all estate grounds and building maintenance and repairs.

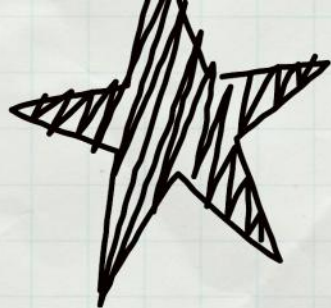
