

MESSAGE FROM YOUR PARISH PRIEST

It is with great joy that I greet you on this 62nd Anniversary. I am both deeply honored and humbled to be your parish priest, and I look forward to many celebrations to come. Our beautiful and rich heritage of song and folklore has been essential in maintaining not only our cultural traditions, but our faith in God our Savior. 

THE RANKIN JUNIOR TAMBURITZANS



Rankin Junior Tamburitzans were organized in 1959 as a kolo group. Five years later, they expanded their cultural mission and added tambura instruction for the students. Throughout the years, the Rankin Junior Tamburitzans have had the honor of performing at many local cultural events and festivals such as Rankin Community Days, McKeesport's International Village, Croatian Day at Kennywood Park, the Pittsburgh Folk Festival, and Heritage Holidays at the Senator John Heinz History Center.

One of the greatest honors bestowed on the group was an invitation to lay a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington National Cemetery. The group has also traveled across the United States and Canada, performing as guests for other cultural groups.

In December of 1998, the Rankin Junior Tamburitzans had the distinguished honor of performing Christmas Carols and folk songs at the White House as part of its holiday celebration. In 2004, 2013, 2018, and 2024, RJT was proud to perform in Zagreb, Croatia, as part of the CFU Junior Cultural Federation Festival.

The group is also on file with the Library of Congress as part of its Local Legacies Project, which was created in celebration of the Library's bicentennial. The Rankin Junior Tamburitzans rehearse every Monday night in Rankin, Pennsylvania. Bob Pollack is the Artistic Director and Choreographer for the group, and Sue Stafura is the Music Director. Julie Horgas, Arianna Ordway, and Lacy Gable are the group's Assistant Directors.



The St. Nicholas Tamburitzan Family

ST. NICHOLAS SERBIAN TAMBURITZANS HISTORY

St. Nicholas Serbian Tamburitzans became a dream come true for the parents of St. Nicholas Serbian Church in Wilmerding, PA in August of 1963. The group was created by the parents of our Sunday School children with the mission to perpetuate our Serbian heritage while providing a youth cultural organization within our church.

The Tamburitzans were created by our founding officers: +Dusan Saula, president; +Joe Cervo, vice president; +Ann Kukich, secretary; and Mildred Popovich, treasurer.

Music director, +Danny Kukich, and choreographer, Geri (Bossar) Maravich, were consulted to begin creating the foundation for music and dance. They remained our directors for several years with our initial group of "tammies," approximately 25 students ages 9-17. Performances became a reality and our St. Nicholas Serbian Tamburitzans accepted engagements for St. Sava celebrations, SNF Kennywood/Serb Day events and community heritage days. Annual concerts were soon scheduled and the growth of our group flourished and evolved into what it is today.

Since its inception, many talented music instructors and choreographers have shared their time and efforts with us to continue our mission. Past directors include: +Ron Rendulic, +Don Knezevich, Dan Shebitich, Bill Yurkovac, Randy Lugares, Danny Capuzzi, and Steve Capuzzi.

We are also thankful for the many choreographers who have instructed our children over the past five decades, They include: Marilyn (Chichi) Repasky, +Kathy Rendulic, +Jack Poloka, Milicent Novic, Debra Capolarello, Linda Metala, Erin George, Michaelann Yurkovac, Mary Agnes (Pixie) Potsatko, Donna Vranesevic, Sharon Bozicevic, Susan Williams, Denise Brajovic, Zoran Zgonc, Danice (DeeDee) Brkovich, Tonya Kredell, Valerie Tassari, and Kim Kosovich.

The St. Nicholas Serbian Tamburitzans are currently comprised of three age groups, classified as Beginner, Intermediate and Senior groups. Practice is every Monday evening at our St. Nicholas church hall, which we are fortunate to call our "home."

Our parent group is still the backbone of the organization, which makes the decisions on managing the group, fundraising, costume and instrument expenses, donations and traveling. The parent group, along with the officers, follow the guidelines of our St. Nicholas Serbian Church, as we remain under the umbrella of our parish. The following have served as parent group presidents throughout the many years: +Dusan Saula, +Mary Visnic, +George Pilipovich, Julie Vucelich, +Olga McWilliams, +George Paich, +Dusan Rebich, Nancy Corl, Mary Ann Tomich, Myra Zdrale, Dennis Evanovich, Nick Jokola, Michael Mochan, +Carol Richey, Donna Capuzzi, Elaine Vucelich, Janet Pribanic, Tracy Saula, Alexis Janiga, and Bati Bajich.

Over the years, our group has been featured as guest performers for many communities in Pennsylvania. In addition, the St. Nicholas Serbian Tamburitzans have performed in the Canadian cities of Niagara Falls, Kitchener and Hamilton. We have traveled to Detroit, Lackawanna, Washington D.C., Cleveland, Akron, Youngstown, Steubenville, Phoenix, Louisville, Chicago, and Kansas City. Our group was proud to be invited to the State Capital to represent the Serbians at "Christmas: an ethnic experience," sponsored by the then-Governor, Richard Thornburg, at the governor's Heritage Committee event. Our "Tammies" have also participated in the University of Pittsburgh Cathedral of Learning Nationality Rooms annual event. Our group has also been well-received for many years at the McKeesport International Village Festival. The members of our group enjoy sharing our culture with local schools, synagogues, community fairs, and nursing homes.

The St. Nicholas Serbian Tamburitzans are proud to hold the longest existence of any Serbian community in the United States and Canada. The Serb World Magazine featured our Tamburitzans in 1991 on the occasion of our 25th anniversary year. We welcome you in joining us for our 62nd anniversary concert – and counting!
