

## The Stan & Maureen Duke Foundation Scholarship Terms & Conditions

The Stan and Maureen Duke Scholarship was offered for the first time in 2021 with the intention of funding a Scholarship for a first year resident of The Women's College.

The donation to The Women's College is an initiative of the four daughters of Stan and Maureen Duke – Karen, Marian, Susan and Lyndall – all past residents of The Women's College.

The Terms of the Scholarship are as follows:

- 1. The name of the Scholarship shall be "Stan and Maureen Duke Foundation Scholarship" and is awarded by The Women's College on the recommendation of the Head of College.
- 2. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a first-year resident of The Women's College during the tenure of the Scholarship and who is enrolled or seeking to be enrolled at a university in Brisbane.
- 3. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a first-year resident who has experienced financial or other hardship. As a guideline, students whose families have a combined annual taxable income of approximately \$100,000 or less may be considered for the Scholarship.
- 4. In awarding the Scholarship, preference will be given to a student from rural or regional Queensland who is in financial need with respect to meeting accommodation expenses.
- 5. The Scholarship is awarded to a new resident who will make a valuable contribution to the life of the College. This Scholarship is awarded on a combination of achievements and proven excellence in the areas of academic merit, sport and/or cultural pursuits, community service, and leadership prior to becoming a resident of Women's College.
- 6. The recipient of the Scholarship will not be eligible for any other Women's College scholarship, bursary or academic prize in that year.
- 7. Initially the Scholarship shall be awarded for one academic year. The Scholarship shall lapse upon the scholar ceasing to be in residence at the College.
- 8. The value and frequency of the Scholarship shall be determined by agreement between the Duke family and the Head of College. In its first year, the Scholarship will equate to \$4,000 per annum.
- 9. The Scholarship will be terminated if the recipient:
  - a) is no longer enrolled full-time at a university in Brisbane;
  - b) not maintaining satisfactory academic progress; or
  - c) is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
