Course: Access to HE Diploma: Health Professionals

Why did you decide to study the Access to HE Diploma at NSCG?

I chose to study at NSCG as I previously completed a beauty apprenticeship so I knew the C ollege well. It's Ofsted Outstanding rating was also a big pull for me and I was very confident that here I would gain the best education and support to get to where I wanted to be.

What was your motivation for returning to education as an adult learner?

My dream job is to be a midwife and after putting it off for years due to the financial side of studying and other priorities, I decided to move back to Staffordshire after living in Cornwall for ten years. I really wanted to finally pursue a career in midwifery and knowing that there were going to be other adults in the same position really inspired me to just go for it.

What has been the best part of the course?

As an adult going back into education, it can be worrying at first, but when you are in college and have a purpose, it's different. We all want to study for the same reasons and we really bounce off each other so this has been one of the best parts of the year for me. Getting involved in group discussions and tasks has been really enjoyable and has definitely helped me to develop critical thinking skills ready for university.

And the biggest challenge?

Trying to balance workload and family commitments has been a challenge as there is a lot of work to complete. This is something you are made aware of on your Return to Learn Day and once you get into the routine of the assignments, things get easier.



How have your tutors supported you on your Access journey?

As a group, we have constant support from our tutors through one to ones. If you have any concerns or worries, you know that they are always there for help and advice. Having someone who looks out for you both in terms of college work and any personal life concerns has been really valuable and makes us all feel motivated and able to ask for help as we need it.

What's next for you?

I am hoping to study Midwifery in September at either Keele University, University of Chester, University of Derby or University of Staffordshire.

What would your advice be to other adults looking to study an Access to HE Diploma?

Make sure you attend every lesson and be prepared as this is key. Prepare yourself for the workload and ensure you can realistically balance home life with college. The experience has been incredible and I'd recommend it to anyone.

Adult learners can take advantage of an Advanced Learner Loan which is available to help you to cover the costs of studying. This loan is written off if you progress onto and complete a degree-level course, meaning you study the Access to HE Diploma for free.

Course: Level 4 AAT Diploma in Professional Accounting

Why did you decide to return to education as an adult learner?

I work as a Financial Crime Investigator, so I initially began studying to help with my career progression. Since studying at NSCG I have progressed from AAT Level 2 to Level 4 and I now have aspirations to change career and qualify as a Chartered Accountant.

What attracted you to study at NSCG?

I chose to study at NSCG as it has a good reputation and is close to home, so this makes life a lot easier.

How do you balance your work commitments, study and home life?

Some weeks can be difficult, but I know that in the end it will be worth it. I mostly complete homework or revise in sections as I find it easier to manage my time that way. For example, I try to do around 30 minutes each day rather than a few hours all at once.

How have your tutors supported you on your journey so far?

There have been times when I have had to miss lessons, but I have always been fully supported when catching up with things I've missed. The tutors are always available via email for any questions I've had throughout the week, so I know that I don't need to wait until the next lesson to find anything out.



How does the course help you back in the workplace?

Before I signed up for an AAT course at NSCG, I had no idea how to use spreadsheets, but I've now learnt that you can use them for so many different things. At work, I often have to review account activity to see if there is any suspicious transactions and this course has given me a good working knowledge of how businesses work. I was recently recognised for preventing over £50,000 being returned to a business that had fraudulently claimed a refund from HMRC, so this was something I was really proud of.

What would your top tips be for anyone looking to study an AAT course?

If you're thinking of doing the course you need to be prepared to invest some time outside of college hours to get the most out of it. Life can be busy, but it's so worth your time and energy.

Course: Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner

Why did you decide to study at NSCG?

I chose to study this Early Years course because I wanted to do something more with my life in an area I'm passionate about. I've always had an interest in childcare and find working with children so rewarding.

Stepping into college on your first day, how did you feel?

I was nervous as it's a big step looking to change careers. I have learnt so much already and the only regret is that I wish I'd done it sooner.

How do you balance your college studies with work and home life?

This can be tricky and lots of organisation is needed. My main role is Head of Customer Services for an outdoor clothing company, but I also volunteer at Alsagers Bank Primary Academy to gain the experience I need in a school setting. I also have a young child so there's lots going on for me. I try to do my college work most evenings and a morning on the weekend to keep on top of my work, as I enrolled later than other learners.

Describe the key skills you've developed so far?

I've developed valuable skills and knowledge in child development and safeguarding. My planning and organisational skills have really improved and most importantly I've learnt to be more patient.



My tutor is incredibly supportive and always available when needed. She has created a really comfortable learning environment where no question ever feels silly. If we're struggling at all, she is patient and willing to go over things as many times as necessary.

What's next for you?

I'm still exploring my options but I may go into a family support role within a Special Educational Needs setting.

What are your top tips for anyone thinking of signing up for a part time course?

Be organised and don't leave things until the last minute. Find a buddy so you have someone you can talk to and share experiences with.

Course: HNC Engineering

Why did you decide to study the part time HNC in Engineering at NSCG?

I chose to study at NSCG as the college is close to home and has a great reputation and I studied my Level 3 Advanced Manufacturing Engineering course here before I progressed onto a Musical Instrument Craft degree, specialising in piano tuning and repairs. NSCG also works closely with my employer, Brown McFarlane so it was a natural choice to help me begin my journey into higher education. I work full time so the part time HNC option allows me to study around work.

How does the teaching style help you to develop your engineering skills?

The teaching is personalised and taught in small class sizes, so we get to spend more time on an individual basis. The tutors are amazing at directing us to the best learning resources and are truly a fountain of knowledge.

How are you able to put theory learnt in college into practice back in the workplace?

I now have a good working knowledge of electrics and electronics which are needed for component level repairs. I'm also discovering mechanical principles for repairs on the equipment in my day job.

Describe the key industry skills you've learnt so far.

I've gained a deeper understanding of electrics, electronics and mechanical principles, whilst also improving my computer literacy.

What would your advice be to anyone looking to study a part time engineering course?



What attracted you to study a Recreational Ceramics course?

Describe the types of projects you have worked on during your time at NSCG.

Course: Level 2 Award in ESOL Skills For Life

Why did you decide to study at NSCG?

I decided to study an ESOL course at NSCG because I recently moved to England from Russia. When you move to a new country, it's easy to stay in your comfort zone and only communicate with people who speak your native language. But I wanted to break that pattern and challenge myself. The college gives me a chance to practise English, make friends from all over the world and learn to understand different accents- it's like travelling without leaving the classroom! Plus, I want to build a career here, so learning English well is essential.

What has been the most enjoyable aspect of the course?

The most enjoyable part has been meeting people from different countries. I also like that I can hear a variety of English accents because it makes me feel like I'm preparing for the "real world". It's great to practise speaking without fear of making mistakes because everyone is learning.

What has been the most challenging part of studying?

The most challenging part has been spelling and pronunciation. In English, words often sound completely different from how they are written. For example, 'enough', 'though' and 'through' all have 'ough', but they sound totally different. When I started the course, my writing was honestly terrible, but now I've improved.



How has the course changed your life so far?

The course has given me confidence not only in speaking and writing English but also in everyday life. I even found a job, which felt like a big victory! Now I can talk to my colleagues, keep up a conversation and understand what's happening at work. At first, it was like listening to a fast song in a language you don't know.

Are you planning on enrolling on another course?

Absolutely! I plan to take a more advanced English course to keep improving. Now that I have a job, I also want to study something connected to my career, maybe a course in business or communication.

What would your advice be for other adult learners who are thinking of studying a part time course?

My advice is simple: don't be afraid to make mistakes! Mistakes are just part of the process. Also, try to step out of your comfort zone and speak to people, even if it's scary. And if you think you're too old to learn, forget about it. I've met people of all ages and everyone has their own story and reason for learning. Learning a language is not just about words, it's about connecting with people and opening new doors.
