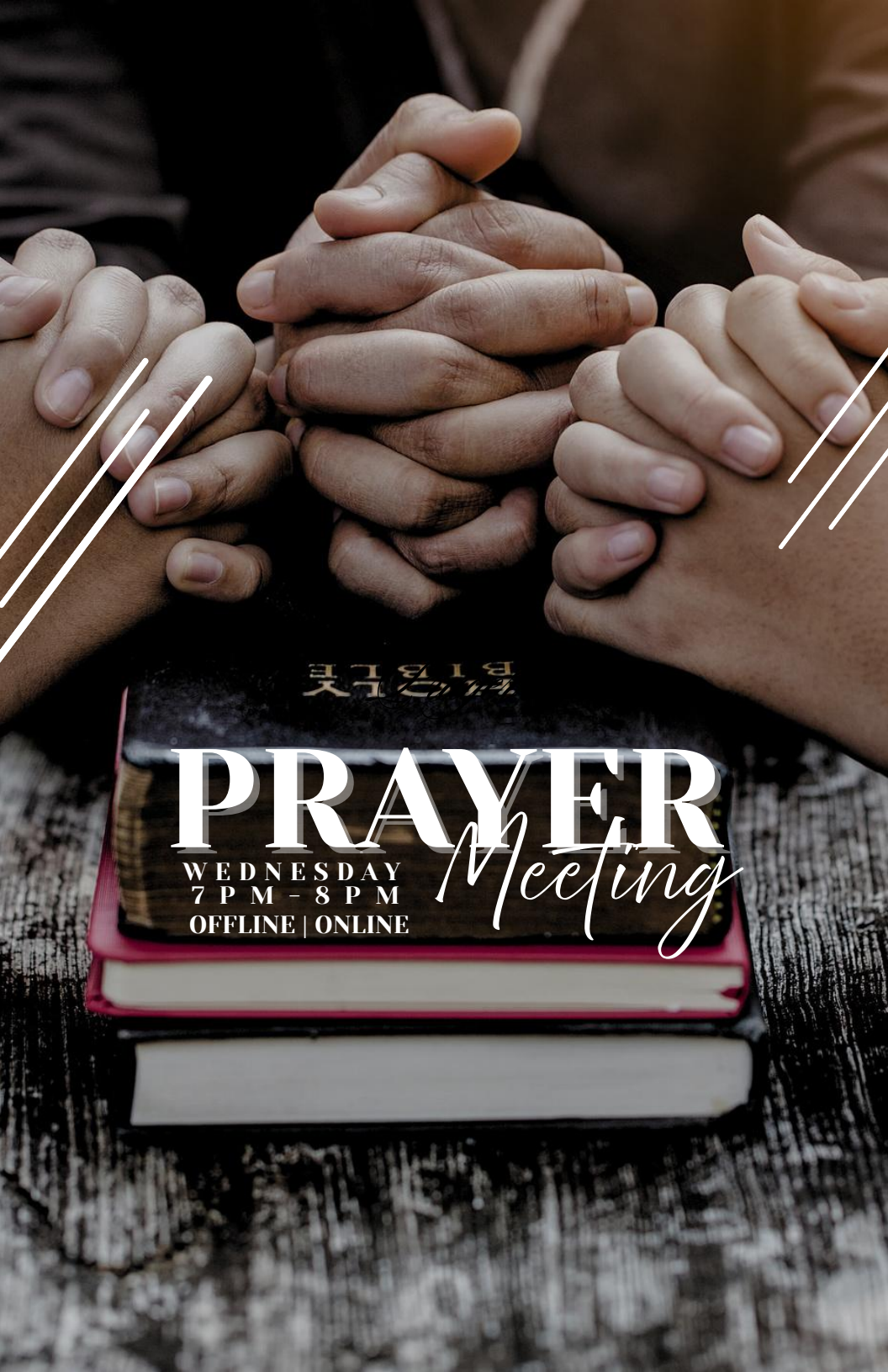

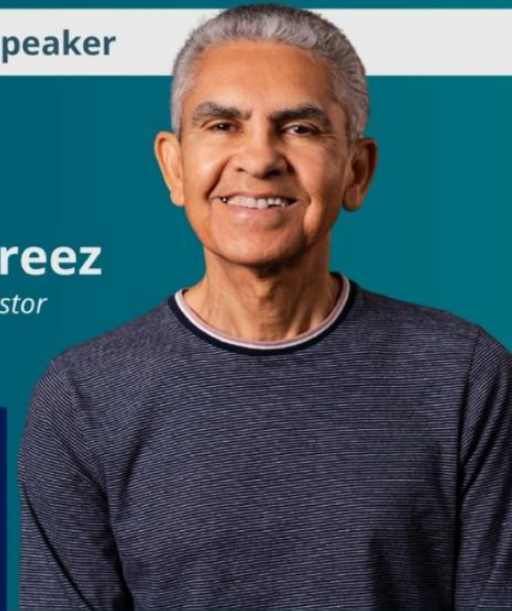

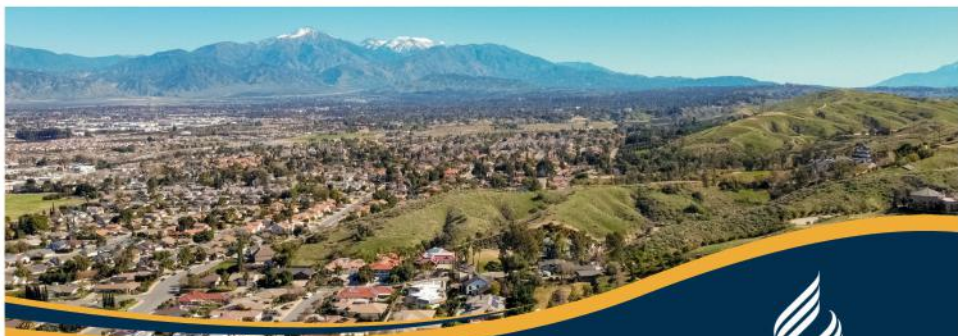
INSIGHTFUL UNDERSTANDING OF THE SPIRIT OF PROPHECHY

The second focus of Ellen White's life was the Bible. The Bible played a foundational role in her personal experience and in her ministry. Her writings are full of Scripture. Her prophetic ministry was to uplift the Word of God. Mrs. White wrote, "You are not familiar with the Scriptures. If you had made God's word your study, with a desire to reach the Bible standard and attain to Christian perfection, you would not have needed the testimonies. It is because you have neglected to acquaint yourselves with God's inspired Book that He has sought to reach you by simple direct testimonies...The written testimonies are not to give a new light, but to impress vividly upon the heart the truths of inspiration already revealed." She also wrote this, "Let all prove their positions from the Scriptures and substantiate every point they claim as truth from the revealed Word of God..." In her last message to the entire Seventh-day Adventist Church at the General Conference Session in 1909 she held up her Bible and stated, "Brethren and sisters, I commend unto you this Book."
