Kenya Safari: The Big 5 | Itinerary Highlights *(subject to change)*

Locations selected for this safari promise excellent viewing of wildlife, however, spotting specific wildlife cannot be guaranteed. Some activities are dependent on weather and seasonal conditions.

Day 1 EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

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Day 2 **ARRIVE IN NAIROBI, KENYA** After an evening arrival to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with group transfers to the hotel. Settle into your five-star accommodations.

Overnight: Fairmont The Norfolk

Day 3 **NAIROBI** Following breakfast and a welcome briefing by your Orbridge Expedition Leader, depart for Sheldrick Wildlife Trust—considered the most successful orphaned elephant and rhino rescue and rehabilitation program in the world. Next visit the home of the Rothschild Giraffe at the African Fund for Endangered Wildlife Giraffe Centre, whose mission is to educate Kenyan youth about their country's wildlife and environment. Afterward take a short drive to the foot of the Ngong Hills to see Karen Blixen's farm house.

Overnight: Fairmont The Norfolk (B,L,D)

Day 4 NAIROBI | SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE

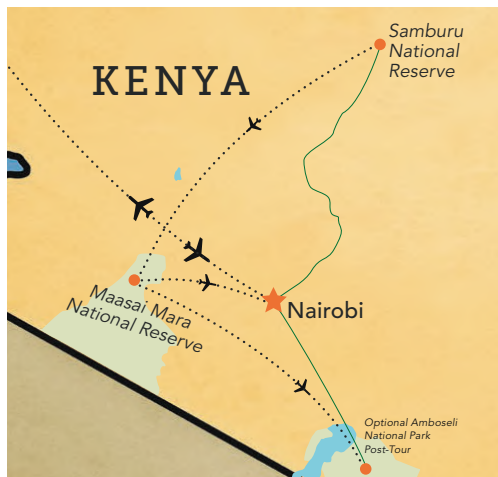
Travel north to the banks of the Ewaso Ng'iro River arriving to Samburu National Reserve, considered among the best reserves in Africa. Samburu is famous for its diverse and abundant wildlife, including several species that are unique to the region. Set out on an immersive game drive with expert guides who will provide informative insights into the ecosystems and biodiversity of the region. Keep watch for the "Samburu Special Five," which includes Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffe, Beisa oryx, Somali ostrich and gerenuk.

Overnight: Soroi Samburu Lodge (B,L,D)

Day 5 SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE

Prepare for an enriching full day exploring more areas within the reserve during morning and afternoon game drives. In addition to its natural wonders, Samburu offers a rich cultural experience. The reserve is inhabited by the Samburu people, who are pastoralists known for their distinct way of life and vibrant traditions.

Overnight: Soroi Samburu Lodge (B,L,D)



Day 6 SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE | MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Board a flight destined for Maasai Mara National Reserve—a northern extension of the Serengeti ecosystem and one of the world's most rewarding wildlife observation sites. Maasai Mara is not only a wildlife haven but also a cultural treasure. The Maasai people with their vibrant traditions and distinctive attire, coexist harmoniously with the wildlife. After lunch get a front-row seat to the drama of the African wilderness during an exciting game drive.

Overnight: Mara Engai Lodge (B,L,D)

Days 7-8 MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Immerse yourself in the vast plains of the reserve during two full days of wildlife viewing. On the final evening gather together for a festive bush dinner.

Overnight: Mara Engai Lodge (B,L,D daily)

Day 9 MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE | FLIGHT TO NAIROBI | DEPART FOR U.S.

After breakfast return to Nairobi where you'll have access to a day room at the hotel until transferring to the airport for evening flights home.

Day Room: Crowne Plaza Nairobi Airport (B,L)

Day 10 EN ROUTE | ARRIVE IN U.S.

(B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner)

Maasai Mara Sunrise Safari

While in Maasai Mara National Reserve (day 7), take a once-in-a-lifetime sunrise safari by hot air balloon. During this optional excursion, ascend above the reserve at dawn for an exclusive bird's-eye view of wildlife roaming the expansive landscape.

This excursion must be purchased from Orbridge Guest Services in advance to guarantee availability. Purchase is non-refundable inside 90 days from departure.



Activity Level: This safari program requires an ability to walk safely over uneven and slippery ground without assistance, transport luggage a short distance, get in and out of a 4x4 vehicle, and physically tolerate vehicle motion on sometimes bumpy roads. Highest elevation: 5,500 feet.



What's Included

- 7 nights accommodations at deluxe lodges and tented camps—all carefully selected to emphasize wildlife viewing and amenities—plus a day room on departure day
- 7 breakfasts, 7 lunches and 6 dinners including a special farewell dinner
- Expert naturalist guides throughout
- All entrance fees to visited national parks and reserves
- Daily game drives in open-air vehicles with filtered water provided
- Maasai Mara National Reserve visitation fees, which are paid directly to the Narok County Government in support of tourism and conservation efforts of the Maasai Mara ecosystem and wildlife
- Internal airfare for flights between Samburu, Maasai Mara and Nairobi
- All gratuities as well as taxes, service charges and park fees
- Temporary membership in AMREF Flying Doctors air ambulance service
- All arrival and departure airport transfers

FAIRMONT THE NORFOLK

SOROI SAMBURU LODGE

MARA ENGAI LODGE

Stunning views, spectacular wildlife, sumptuous food, and a cheerful staff combine for a fantastic stay at the Mara Engai Lodge. Relax in large, luxurious tented suites with waterfall showers and private verandas at this unique property nestled within the forest and overlooking the amazing Maasai Mara National Reserve.



Optional Post-Tour Amboseli

Experience the magnificent landscapes of Amboseli National Park, set against the iconic backdrop of towering Mount Kilimanjaro. The park is known as the best place in the world to see free-ranging elephants in ultra-close proximity.



Day 9 **FLIGHT FROM MAASAI MARA TO AMBOSELI**
Arrive to Amboseli in time for lunch, then set off on an afternoon game drive. Return to the lodge where the remainder of the day is yours to explore the grounds and take advantage of the property's amenities.
Overnight: Ol Tukai Lodge (L,D)

Day 10 **AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK** Today includes two game drives through Amboseli National Park to spot for African wildlife. At little more than 150 square miles, Amboseli is relatively small, but its high concentration of wildlife makes for excellent viewing opportunities. In addition to its many elephants, the park is also home to Cape buffaloes, impalas, cheetahs, spotted hyenas, Maasai giraffes, Grant's zebras, blue wildebeest, more than 100 lions and more than 400 bird species.
Overnight: Ol Tukai Lodge (B,L,D)

Day 11 **AMBOSELI | TRANSFER TO NAIROBI | DEPART FOR U.S.** After breakfast, return to Nairobi where you'll have access to a day room at the hotel to rest until transferring to the airport for evening flights home.
Day Room: Crowne Plaza Nairobi Airport (B,L)

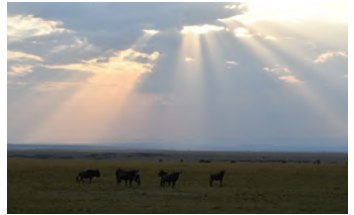
Day 12 **EN ROUTE | ARRIVE IN U.S.**

Activity Level: This post-tour requires an ability to walk over uneven, sometimes slippery ground and get in and out of a 4 X 4 vehicle.
