Our History

The American International School Vienna was founded in 1959 by the Embassies of the United States and Canada after the US Ambassador advised that US funds would be available for an American sponsored school. In 1961, primarily through grant funds, AIS Vienna took possession of a 44,000 square meter site for its new school on Salmannsdorfer Strasse, in the Neustift-am-Walde area of Vienna. adjacent to the famous Vienna Woods (Wienerwald), where the school is located to this day. The first graduation ceremony took place in Spring 1964. By Fall of that same year, 357 students with 28 nationalities were enrolled on the new site.

In 1977, the International
Baccalaureate Diploma Program was
first offered, and in 2022, AIS Vienna
celebrated its 45th anniversary
as an IB World School. During
the 2019-2020 school year, AIS
Vienna commemorated its sixtieth
anniversary with thousands of
alumni from all around the world.

Currently, there are more than 800 students representing over 70 nationalities enrolled, with about half of all students being American or Austrian citizens. AIS Vienna is one of five international schools in Vienna and stands out for its American-style curriculum, its array of extracurricular activities, outstanding IBDP scores, and

student placement in the world's top universities. Additionally, our unique location provides an instructional setting amidst the beauty of the surrounding hills, forest, and countryside. On our 11-acre premises there are seven interconnected buildings housing our three divisions -- Elementary School (Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 5), Middle School (Grade 6 to Grade 8), and High School (Grade 9 to Grade 12). The typical class has 15-20 students, with many language classes considerably smaller.

PK-12 Philosophy of Assessment

At AIS Vienna, we believe on-going assessment and feedback is essential to the learning process and allows us to evaluate a student's ability to apply knowledge, concepts, and skills in a variety of contexts. A variety of assessment tools empower the student to demonstrate their strengths and areas of growth which enhances metacognition and facilitates individualized support.

Our Governance

The school is governed by a 10-member Executive Board, eight of whom are elected by the Association that sponsors the school, one who is appointed by the U.S. Ambassador, and the Director (ex-officio). Membership

in the Association is automatically conferred on the parents or guardians of children enrolled in the school. The school is incorporated under Austrian law and is affiliated with the Office of Overseas Schools, U.S. Department of State.

The Executive Board sets general policies and is responsible for hiring the school Director, who oversees the operations of the school. There is a healthy and open partnership between school leadership and the Executive Board.

Our Community

Once a Knight, Always a Knight

Whether a student or faculty member is here one year or many years, they will always be part of the AIS Vienna family.

Relationships are what sets our community apart from other schools in Vienna and beyond. We value inclusion and belonging, and create opportunities for community members to settle in quickly when they join our school, and due to the connections made while here, our alumni maintain strong ties long after they've left us.

Students

AIS Vienna serves some 800 students from over 70 countries, with about half of the total American or Austrian. Because of the international and transient character of our student body, the average stay at AISV is four years, with approximately 200 new students admitted each year. Many students, however, spend eight years or longer with us. Our international

parent community is predominantly affiliated with embassies, international organizations, and international corporations. Our local parents tend to work in private businesses or professions such as medicine and law.

Faculty

The core of excellence at AIS Vienna is our talented faculty and strong teacher leaders. The AISV Faculty numbers over 100 individuals. More than 80% of our teachers hold advanced degrees, with several having earned doctorates. A substantial majority are U.S. citizens, but the school does have teachers of other nationalities, including Europe, Canada, and Asia. Teachers at AIS Vienna are dedicated professionals with a commitment to on-going improvement, as demonstrated not just by frequent attendance at regional and international conferences, IB training, and subject-specific workshops, but also in leading others both within our school and

the wider international school community.

AIS Vienna faculty range in age from 28-65, with an average and median age of about 46. The average stay of a faculty member at AISV is over ten years, which greatly enhances the school's stability and continuity.

Each of the three academic divisions is headed by a trained and experienced principal. In addition, the Senior Leadership Team includes the three division Principals, the Director, the Director of Teaching & Learning, the Director of Events, the Director of Technology, the Director of Admissions, the Human Resources Manager, and the Business Manager. There are also trained and experienced counselors in each of the three divisions, resource staff, and librarians for the Elementary and Secondary schools.

Our Facilities

AISV is located in the Neustift-am-Walde area of Vienna, adjacent to the famous Vienna Woods, and provides an instructional setting in the midst of the physical beauty of the surrounding hills, forest, and countryside. On our 11-acre (4.5 hectare) premises there are seven interconnected buildings housing Elementary, Middle, and High Schools.

The land for the school was bought by the U.S. government in the late 1950s, using U.S. government funds obtained through the Marshall Plan, and the school occupies the premises in perpetuity. The school is built along a sloping hillside, making for many different levels and stairs.

Overall, there are more than 70 classrooms, eight science labs, art studios, music rooms, two libraries, a theater, two gyms,

a cafeteria, a health unit, and a separate sports hall (which houses three indoor tennis courts or two basketball courts or ten badminton courts). There are various offices for counseling, the International Baccalaureate program, division offices, technology, and faculty departments. The exterior facilities include a soccer field, a running track, an elementary playground, an outdoor tennis court, and an amphitheater.





Teaching & Learning

Academic programs at AIS Vienna are always given the highest priority by both the school's dedicated faculty and the leadership team.

The AIS Vienna curriculum is based on the American system with an international flavor.

In the Elementary and Middle Schools, the curriculum ensures that all students learn a coherent and unified body of knowledge and academic skills. Our teaching and learning is guided by the Common Core Standards for English Language Arts and Mathematics, NGSS for Science, C3 and Aero for Social Studies, NCAS for the Arts, ISTE for Technology, and SHAPE for PE and Health. We follow an inquiry-driven curriculum review cycle and are shifting to a strong

data-based system for guiding our improvements to support continuously improving student outcomes.

High School students follow a challenging college-preparatory curriculum that leads to a US High School Diploma, with the option of pursuing the International Baccalaureate Diploma in full or by course, including opportunities to engage with the IB's core of Theory of Knowledge (TOK), the Extended Essay (EE), or the Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) program.

Recent strategic initiatives have revolved around reflecting on our toolbox of instructional strategies to ensure we are student-centered, and utilizing the Universal Design for Learning approach for reaching all students. We are bolstering our Student Support Team PK-12 in order to maintain a consistent process for all students across our school.

All AlS Vienna students receive individual academic advice and support, and High School students receive extensive college counseling in their Junior and Senior years.

Accreditation and Memberships

AIS Vienna is accredited by the Council of International Schools (CIS), the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools Middle Schools (MSA), and the IB. We are affiliated with CEESA, ECIS, ELMLE, ISST and more.



Related Arts

Built on the firm belief that art is essential to our humanity, the Arts Department provides students with the skills to recognize, appreciate, create, and evaluate art in its many forms – from the glories of orchestral music through the quiet of charcoal drawings on paper. Although a quality product is often inherent in artistic endeavors, it is the process itself that is the primary focus of the Arts Program. The curriculum provides each child with opportunities to develop self-expression, self-discipline, collaboration, spontaneity, imagination, and a lasting understanding and appreciation of the arts. AIS Vienna students actively participate in a wide range of activities that often culminate with choral and instrumental concerts, art exhibits, as well as theater and dance performances – including at renowned venues in Vienna and around the world. While many of our graduates enter creative professions, our goal is for all students to become lifetime lovers of the arts.



Athletics & Activities

AlS Vienna offers over 45 clubs and activities to our High School and Middle School students. Activities like Speech & Debate, Math Team, Habitat for Humanity, and Amnesty Youth all meet either after school or during lunch. In the Elementary School, our extensive After School Activities program (ASA) offers over 30 different classes. Most of our Elementary students participate in at least one ASA.

Our athletics program is divided into fall, winter, and spring seasons, each offering competitive programs. Our Middle and High School students take part in local games, overnight trips, and final season tournaments in one of the two conferences to which we belong: International Schools Sports Tournaments (ISST) and the Danube Valley Athletic Conference (DVAC). We are founding members of both conferences.



Technology for Learning

Our Technology Vision

American International School Vienna students are empowered responsible digital citizens who thrive in a rapidly transforming technological world. Our students think creatively and critically; construct knowledge and design solutions; communicate and collaborate effectively; and engage responsibly with technology as respectful future-minded members of the global community.

Our Technology Philosophy

We believe technology and innovative practice stimulates curiosity and creativity, inspires the joy of discovered passions, and provides students with the tools and skills to confidently meet future challenges. Technology is fundamental in providing equal access to learning for all students.

1:1 Device Program

AIS Vienna is a 1:1 Apple school. Our students learn and collaborate with interactive SMARTboards, Apple TVs, iPads (1:1 program in Elementary School), and MacBook Airs (1:1 program in Middle School & High School).



DEIB Commitments & Practices

Our Strategic Plan prioritizes the action of setting and reinforcing expectations of what it means to be an AIS Vienna citizen in a community that embraces diversity, equity and inclusion, building on the foundation of ethical character, purposeful action and international mindedness. This is the basis of the Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging work at AISV.

To support this action item, our leadership team continues to engage with DEI consultants who are experts on DEI topics and best practice in international schools. We have an active DEIB Task Force (made up of faculty, staff, parents, Board members, leaders, and students) who create, implement, and monitor an action plan to move us forward.

Our Respect & Anti-Discrimination Policy protects all members of our community from discrimination on the basis of race, national or ethnic origin, color, religion, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, mental and physical ability, and political affiliation; and from any attitudes or behavior towards others which reflect lack of respect for the inherent dignity of any individual.

English is the language of instruction, with instruction in German language offered for all levels of proficiency beginning in early childhood. At the secondary level, we also offer French and Spanish, and students in the IBDP are encouraged and supported with studying literature or language acquisition in their mother tongue.



What Makes AIS Vienna Special

At AIS Vienna, we strive to ensure that every student is welcomed and appreciated. As educators, we understand our mission is not just to facilitate learning in the classic sense, but also to facilitate experiences, and create memories that will sustain every student through futures not yet imagined. Our goal is for children to love school and to develop a life-long love of learning.

Our teachers love working with children and our students enjoy school.

AlS Vienna is widely recognized as a school that fosters positive relationships between teachers and students. These relationships translate into highly motivated and engaged learners. AlS Vienna students arrive with smiles and energy each morning, ready to learn.

We offer a warm and welcoming atmosphere.

We believe in developing strong relationships between students and teachers, and these relationships are the foundations of the family-like feeling of our school community.

Our Elementary School Program

In our Elementary School, the instructional excellence of the faculty is complemented by a genuine appreciation of childhood development. Our carefully chosen programs allow for differentiated instruction and a high degree of student choice to ensure that learning is authentic and meaningful. Students are encouraged to make connections to personal

experiences, and to draw from these experiences to gain deeper understandings of content and text materials.

Our enrollment in the Elementary School hovers between 300 and 330 students from Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 5. Students benefit from outstanding academic programs enriched by fine arts, physical education, technology, and German language instruction. Through after school activities, field trips, and collaboration across grade levels, we ensure every single child finds multiple opportunities to explore new interests, further develop existing passions, and find confidence in their unique expression.





Our Middle School Program

The Middle School offers a nurturing environment in which teacher support and enthusiasm meet the unique developmental needs of students aged 11 to 14. This is a period of rapid intellectual and social development, and our courses and programs help students to realize their potential and take increasing responsibility in a caring, supportive environment.

Our curricular and co-curricular programs are designed to build the foundation for a lifetime of independent and self-reliant learning. Skill building is emphasized, and reading and writing are priorities in most areas of academic study. Our language

arts program is literature based, and students learn to write in a variety of genres and styles. In mathematics, students begin with concrete, computational work, and develop the abstract thinking and problemsolving skills needed for algebra. "Hands-on" learning and laboratory work are emphasized in the general sciences. All students explore the fine and performing arts, as well as develop their computer and technology skills. Physical education keeps our active students fit and focused on a healthy lifestyle.

Additionally, elective exploratory courses introduce students to subjects that they may wish to pursue in future years. All

students study German, with
French and Spanish as additional
options. Language instruction is
an important feature of the Middle
School curriculum, and English
as an Additional Language (EAL)
is provided for students with
intermediate English proficiency.

Every autumn, all faculty and students participate in the Middle School fall trips. These three-day treks (each grade goes to a different destination in Austria) provide an opportunity for students to make friends, for students and teachers to get to know each other, and to build spirit and spark enthusiasm for the new school year.

Our High School Program

The High School provides a comprehensive universitypreparatory academic program. All AIS Vienna High School students work towards earning a US High School Diploma. The majority of our students also choose to pursue the globally-recognized International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma. Core areas of our academic program include English, mathematics, science, social studies, modern languages, visual and performing arts, and physical education. The Modern Language program includes German (both native and non-native), French, and Spanish. Resource support may be available for students with additional learning support needs. Each year, our IB

results indicate achievement well above world averages.

AIS Vienna is well-known for its caring faculty and positive student-teacher relationships. Our experienced and certified faculty are experts in their subjects. Most of our faculty is from the United States and Canada, but we employ teachers from all corners of the globe. They devote themselves to the success of our students by providing worldclass learning opportunities, a nurturing environment, and a culture of integrity and curiosity. Three counselors and an academic dean are dedicated to assisting students in their applications to universities in North America, the UK, Europe, and

throughout the world.

In addition to the academic program, the High School offers extracurricular choices in music, dance, drama, scholarly challenges, and athletics. AIS Vienna is a member of several international school associations, providing opportunities for competitions and festivals throughout Europe and around the world. We also promote and facilitate service and learning opportunities in Vienna, our neighboring countries and beyond. We welcome new learners into our community, challenging and fostering future leaders, life-long learners, and longterm friends.

Our School Year

The 2024-25 school year will consist of 178 days of teaching and 5 additional days of teaching-related, professional development activities. New hire teachers arrive by the end of July/the beginning of August so they can settle in before New Hire

Orientation. AIS Vienna publishes a calendar each year indicating the dates of school holidays, including Austrian public holidays.

The core working day for teachers is 8:00 AM - 3:15 PM.



Professional Development

AIS Vienna is a community of learners, both students and faculty. We ignite and inspire lifelong learning in our students, which starts by cultivating this lifelong learning mindset across our Faculty. AIS Vienna teachers don't just teach; they practice what they teach.

Teachers at AIS Vienna are committed to growing in their ability to meet the individual learning needs of every student. To support this goal, we provide a range of professional learning opportunities. At AIS Vienna, this means learning that is engaging, ongoing, and relevant. In addition to a wide range of professional development activities both on and off campus, our teachers interact with a team of over 185 faculty and staff, in which over 82% of our faculty have obtained a Master's degree or higher.

Teachers engage in professional learning that support our strategic initiatives, led by a variety of world renowned expert consultants, such as inquiry author and speaker Trevor MacKenzie; leading workshop model team Erin Kent Consulting; author, speaker and consultant Tom Schimmer whose expertise includes Standards Based Grading; Diversity, Equity and Inclusion expert Homa S. Tavanagar; and Matt Glover, an author and consultant whose specialty is nurturing writers and supporting children's intellectual growth and development.

Additionally, professional development for the IB Diploma Program receives ongoing support at AIS Vienna, including sending our teachers to subject specific seminars—the first workshops in the world for supporting IBDP teachers with the latest IBDP curriculum. Job-A-Likes and some network groups

are provided and coordinated through our regional affiliate CEESA.

From this wealth of experience, we build collaborative teams within our wider professional learning community. This stretches both within and across grade levels and subject areas, to actively inspire, share, exchange and craft the best possible experiences for the lifelong learners in all of us.

1000 EUR per year is available to each teacher to pursue professional development opportunities. This amount can accumulate for up to three years.

Engagement Outside the Classroom

In addition to their teaching duties, we expect our teachers to be engaged outside of the classroom. This includes attending relevant parent information events, campus events, sports tournaments, art shows, etc. Our teachers establish and lead extracurricular activities, during which they share their personal passions and expertise.



Salary Scale

A teacher's salary depends on their academic level and the amount of teaching experience they bring with them. The listed salaries are based on our Teacher Personnel Policy B2 for the 2023-24 school year. All amounts within the Step Factor Matrix are shown in Euros. The salary is paid monthly and is typically transferred mid-month. Please note that the highest possible entry is step 6.

Teachers with additional responsibilities (e.g. heads of department, grade level leaders, etc.) are paid a stipend (additional monthly amount).

One step increase will apply for each year of employment at the school up to step 15. In addition there is an inflation rate adjustment which is capped at 4%.

Taxation Information

The listed teacher salaries are not taxed in Austria for non-Austrian citizens. However, non-Austrian citizen teachers at AIS Vienna are subject to their home country's income tax and social security law.

E.g., US citizens at AISV need to file income taxes in the US, but the Foreign Earned Income Exclusion (FEIE, IRS Form 2555) allows US citizens to exclude a certain amount of earned income from US tax. For the tax year 2023 this exclusion is USD 120,000.

Based on your individual circumstances (home country), you need to identify the applicable income tax/social security jurisdictions and comply with all applicable tax/social security obligations. It is each individual's own responsibility to negotiate any special arrangements concerning taxation agreements that may exist between Austria and their home country.

An AIS Vienna teacher who is required to register with the Austrian Social Security may elect either the "Private Health Insurance & Pension Plan Package" or the "Austrian Health Insurance & Pension Plan Package".

Health Insurance & Pension Plan

Private Health Insurance and Pension Plan (Plan 1) For US citizens and Third Country Nationals

Medical, Dental & Vision

Worldwide medical, dental and vision insurance provided with AIS Vienna paying 75% of the cost of insurance premiums. Teachers can choose from either CIGNA or UNIQA. Full local and international medical, dental and vision is provided from the beginning of the employment contract for the employee and dependent family members.

Long-Term Disability and Basic Life Insurance

AlS Vienna provides long-term disability income insurance protection and a basic life insurance policy for the employee at a 75% AlS Vienna / 25% employee basis.

Retirement Plan

AIS Vienna contributes 10% of the teachers' salary towards pension savings, and provides US citizens with the opportunity to save for retirement on a tax-advantaged basis (Roth401k).

-- OR --

Austrian Social Security System (Plan 2)

For Austrian Citizens and Austrian System Hires

The Faculty Member has to register with the social security authority (Österreichische Gebietskrankenkasse, ÖGK) and receives benefits from the Austrian social security system. The Faculty Member must provide evidence of their registration and the annual registration update from ÖGK.

The school will compensate the Faculty Member the Euro amount for the employer contribution under the Social Security Law (Allgemeines Sozialversicherungsgesetz ASVG).

Passport / Residence Permit

Teachers and accompanying dependents must have passports which are valid for at least two years from the date of arrival. An Austrian residence permit (visa) will be required to remain in Austria. The AIS Vienna Human Resources department will guide new teachers through this process step-by-step prior to arrival, in order to obtain the necessary documents and ensure the application process runs as smoothly as possible.

AIS Vienna will reimburse residence permit (visa) card expenses (no reimbursement for specific costs such as passport pictures etc.).

Shipping & Repatriation

AIS Vienna will provide an allowance of:

2,500 EUR for a single teacher

4,000 EUR for a teaching couple

1,500 EUR additionally for an accompanying Spouse/Partner:

750 EUR additionally for each dependent child, up to a maximum of three children

for the shipment of personal belongings to Vienna, upon submitting an original shipment confirmation and receipt of payment. The allowance will be paid in full to the employee's Austrian bank account. Moving/shipment allowance also applies for teachers leaving AIS Vienna (after fulfilling their contractual obligations), who are either returning to their point of origin or their recorded home address. This is also subject to presentation of the original shipment confirmation and receipt of payment.

Transportation to Vienna

One-way economy class airfare covering the most direct route from the employee's recorded "Home Leave City" to Vienna is available to the employee upon starting their employment, providing the amount does not exceed 1,200 EUR. If applicable, dependents residing with the employee are also entitled.

Home Leave Subsidy

Every year, teachers and their dependents will receive 700 EUR per adult and 350 EUR per dependent child (11 years and younger) as Home Leave Subsidy. This allowance will be provided by AIS Vienna in the June payment period.

Settling-In Allowance

AIS Vienna will provide a one-time settling-in allowance of 2,500 EUR for a single teacher, teaching couple or family upon arrival in Vienna.

Housing Support

Teachers will be supported by a relocation agency to find appropriate housing in Vienna, prior to and upon their arrival.

Initial Arrival On Site

New hire teachers arrive by the end of July/the beginning of August so they can settle in before the start of New Hire Orientation.

Tuition at AIS Vienna

A full-time teacher is permitted to enroll up to two dependent children (a teaching couple up to three dependent children) in AIS Vienna at no cost. The students must meet the criteria outlined in the AIS Vienna Admissions Policy.
