





Private Security v. Police Department

Why you should choose Security over Law Enforcement

Private security gets a bad wrap and many people believe hiring off duty law enforcement or securing them as a courtesy officer on a residential property is the best move for liability and security. This unfortunately is not always the case.

When a person with bad intentions sees a police officer, it makes them think twice about their actions. However, that is only for being proactive. What happens when someone is violating private rules and regulations? **Can a police officer act? The answer is not so simple. The majority of the time, the answer is <u>NO</u>.**

1. Law enforcement is just that – Law Enforcement. They're charged, under state law, to enforce State, City, County and Local Laws and Ordinances. **They are not permitted to use their statutory authority to enforce private property rules and regulations**. In fact, most departments follow CALEA Standards which <u>explicitly prohibit</u> the enforcement of private rules and regulations and are prohibited from taking law enforcement action while not on duty. It is also explicitly prohibited under certain State, City, County and Local laws for police officers to act on behalf of a private entity. Even if you were to have a contract with a law enforcement agency, your property rules and regulations will go unenforced.

2. Liability is huge and **you bear the consequences of the police officer if something goes wrong**. You are not protected by the police department's liability policy and **anything that occurs while on the property is the civil responsibility of the property.** Licensed security agencies bear the liability and indemnify the property, its agents and employees*

*The agency bears the liability as long as the suit and damages did not arise from the negligence of the client.

3. Training for police officers is based on tactical training, not customer service. Police serve one purpose – enforce the law. Security however serves as a liaison and contracted agent of the property to provide customer service while also enforcing your rules and regulations. **Security works on your behalf.**

4. The cost of a police officer versus a private security company is unparalled. A contract with police department can run anywhere from \$45 per hour or more per officer. Contracting with a private security agency will surely provide you with a tailored solution at half the cost.

If you choose to use an off duty police officer for a residential community and provide a rent credit to them, your spending money that won't yield the result you wish for. It may seem like a better deal at first, but as stated earlier, police officers can not enforce private property rules and regulations. **Give your residents true security – not the illusion of security.**
