



HELP US MAKE A DIFFERENCE

In 2018 the Tampa Bay area served over 1.3 million meals to the hungry.

There are more than 6,800 homeless students in Tampa Bay.

15% of those students are unaccompanied minors; they are completely on their own.

On any given day there are 2.5 million children homeless in the US, 1.7 million are teenagers.

In 2018 687,000 children spent time in the foster care system. The average age is $7\ years\ old.$

Foster children spend approximately $2\ years$ in the system away from their home.

Currently there are 65,000 foster children waiting for adoption.

In the last year only 923 were placed in a permanent home.

As of January 2019 there are more than 35,613 children under the "care" of the state of Florida.

Since 2014 Over 1,500 children have died while in the care of the foster system.

WHAT WE ARE PROUD OF

METROPOLITAN MINISTRIES



This is the second year the Broadrick Family Foundation has funded the robotics team for teens at Metropolitan Ministries named Coding Hope. Throughout Coding Hope's first season the team showed great improvement and overcame many challenges. These teens were afforded the opportunity to experience designing, building and driving the robot. Coding Hope also won the Motivate Award, which is given to the team that encourages others to embrace FIRST (a tech competition). A program like this changes everything for these teens. When they realize someone believes in them, hope comes back into their eyes. They begin to believe in themselves and realize their lives can be different and the sky is the limit.

The Broadrick Family Foundation also funded a new Digital Marketing program. By providing digital training and work experience to homeless individuals, the program will give them valuable job skills and make them employable. This program utilizes their resources to create and operate a company that provides digital marketing services to small business in the Tampa Bay area. Ultimately, the program will be a self-sustaining, profitable business.

STARTING RIGHT, NOW

The Broadrick Family Foundation partially funded a renovation of the second floor in the Tampa facility in order to create more bedrooms, kitchen, living, and study rooms to expand the number of homeless youth Starting Right, Now serves.



VOICES

SUNCOAST VOICES

The Broadrick Family Foundation continues to help Suncoast Voices achieve their vision by providing funding to keep beds, pack & plays and car seats available in emergency situations. The funding also provides essentials these children need when removed from abusive situations.



ANGELS AGAINST ABUSE

The Broadrick Family Foundation has committed to aid in stocking the resource room at the Angels Visitation Center. This room provides pack & plays, car seats, diapers, and various hygiene products to ensure children in dire situations have their basic needs met.







RYAN WELLS FOUNDATION

The Broadrick Family Foundation funded two scholarships for underprivileged students from Pinellas County High Schools. The scholarships provided tuition for Pinellas Technical College's Culinary Arts program, a student membership in the American Culinary Federation Tampa Bay Chapter, job placement as a paid intern during the term of the school enrollment, and enrollment in the Youth Connect program which offers a mentor to students for 2 years.







GUARDIAN AD LITEM PROGRAM

The Broadrick Family Foundation began working with the Child Assistance Program (CAP) of the Guardian ad Litem of Florida in 2018. The funding enabled CAP to assist hundreds of foster care children in the Tampa Bay area to participate in activities not covered by the foster care system such as afterschool and sporting programs. The normalcy related to these programs is an integral part of making sure these children are not singled out simply because they are in the foster care system.







EVERYDAY BLESSINGS

The Broadrick Family Foundation awarded a grant to Everyday Blessings for 28 foster children to attend summer camps at "Place" and Wesley Chapel YMCA. This was a wonderful experience and adventure for these children, as most would not have been able to experience such a summer.





BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS OF TAMPA BAY

Big Brothers Big Sisters was the first organization the Broadrick Family Foundation supported. We are very proud to provide positive mentors for at risk or underserved children.







WHERE LOVE GROWS

The Broadrick Family Foundation provided the Where Love Grows Lasagna Mobile Cooking Class for 130 students at the W. Davis Boys & Girls Club. Each child prepared and took home a traditional family-style dinner of lasagna with all the trimmings. 1,560 meals left the building that night. This event helped to jumpstart the goal of serving 325 children a hot home-cooked meal AND teaching 40 students each month how to cook those meals at home.

FUND A NEED

•••——•••

Almost every night in the Tampa Bay Area, children are removed from their homes by law enforcement because of domestic violence, neglect or abuse. The options for these children are few: They can either be placed in the foster system or they can be placed with a qualified family member. Statistics show that a child placed with a family member is much more likely to remain in school and experience a normal childhood. But one of the most common barriers to allowing a family member to care for a displaced child is the State requirement that the child must have their own bed. They are not permitted to sleep with an adult or another child, to sleep on the sofa or the floor. In the past year, over 70 infants died in Florida for lack of a safe and separate sleeping space. Co-sleeping in an adult bed is the number one cause of death for infants. Often, the law which was designed to protect the child becomes the sole reason that they are placed with a stranger rather than a loving family member. Imagine the confusion and fear that a young child must experience after being pulled from their home and placed with a stranger. Our goal is to prevent this from happening for at least 200 children this year. Almost 1,000 beds were placed in the Bay Area last year. The average cost to place a new bed, linens, pillow, pajamas and a teddy bear is \$250. A small price to change the life of a child forever.
