ABOUT HISTORIC CANE HILL

Historic Cane Hill, Inc., is a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving, connecting, and inspiring through meaningful experiences with history, education, architecture, nature, and the arts.

Historic Cane Hill seeks to build upon the legacies of architecture, education, and the arts by providing programs and a venue to experience art and culture rooted in the history of the region and the beautiful natural surroundings of the Ozark Mountains.

Located just off Hwy. 45, 20 miles west of Fayetteville, and 41 miles east of Tahlequah, Oklahoma, this historically-significant area is nestled in the beautiful Ozark Mountains. Visitors enjoy more than 100 acres of pristine Ozark trails, orchards, and landscape, along with 14 historic buildings. The on-site museum and gallery showcase more than 1000 community artifacts and heirlooms as well as rotating special exhibitions and are open Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

HISTORIC CANE HILL is thrilled to showcase, for the seventh year, the incredible talents of high school students from across Arkansas. The Arkansas High School Art Competition and Exhibition gives many students their first chance to be featured in a juried show.

Channeling the spirit of education and the arts, both founding tenets of Cane Hill College, we strive to make Cane Hill an arts-friendly community. Cane Hill has long since served as the backdrop for a storied human past and is a place where people of all ages can explore and be inspired by historic architecture and natural beauty.
