
EDUCATION PROGRAM GUIDE Zionsville Parks and Recreation





Zionsville Parks & Recreation is proud to offer field trips at all of our beautiful Zionsville parks or outreach programs at your school to engage students. Our programs are completely customizable to meet your specific needs and are aligned with Indiana State Science Standards. We utilize our collection of natural resources, including live animals, scientific tools, taxidermy, and natural artifacts in our programs. Our Naturalist staff are all highly-trained educators with years of experience working with kids of all ages. All programs listed below can scheduled as a field trip or classroom outreach.

SENSING NATURE (PRESCHOOL - K)

Explore the marvels of nature through our senses and learn how animals sense the world around them. This program is designed to expand and encourage a child's sense of wonder with hands-on activities.

SEASONAL CHANGES (PRESCHOOL - 1ST)

Each season brings new discoveries to explore. Children will learn how seasonal changes affect all living things.

HABITAT IS HOME (K - 1ST)

All animals and plants live in habitats that help them meet their specific needs. Let's explore the ways living creatures find and make homes that are just right for them!

AMAZING ADAPTATIONS (K - 8TH)

Living creatures have unique adaptations to help them survive within their habitats. In this program, students will learn how plants and animals physical and behavioral characteristics play a role in their lives.

INDIANA ROCKS! (1ST - 7TH)

Geology gives us clues to the past, influences our present environment, and plays an important role in our daily lives. Children will discover the origin of our local rocks and fossils, and decipher how our environment was and still is being shaped by geological processes.

WILD ANIMAL SURVIVAL (4TH - 8TH)

This program takes a detailed look at how animals use their adaptations to survive in their habitats, how energy flows through the food chains and food webs, and how all living things are interconnected.

WATERSHEDS & YOU! (2ND - 8TH)

Clean water is so important for healthy environments and each of us plays a role in watershed health. This program dives into how humans can positively and negatively affect our aquatic ecosystems. If scheduled as a field trip, students will get wet and muddy!

INDIANA MAMMALS (ALL AGES)

Through pelts, mounts and skulls, learn about the diversity of mammals in Central Indiana. Older students will examine environmental issues such as animal overpopulation, extinction, and habitat destruction.

INDIANA'S REPTILES AND AMPHIBIANS (ALL AGES)

Explore the characteristics and adaptations that make these cold-blooded animals so unique. Examine similarities and differences between amphibians and reptiles and the threats to their survival.

BIRDS OF INDIANA (ALL AGES)

Over 200 species of birds call Indiana home, from tiny hummingbirds to stealthy owls. Explore the different birds commonly found in our area using taxidermy and natural artifacts. Learn how different types of birds are uniquely designed to thrive in their habitat.

In each Traveling Teacher Trunk, you will find quality resources, natural artifacts or replicas, field guides, and scientific tools like magnifying glasses and binoculars for hands-on experimentation and learning.


