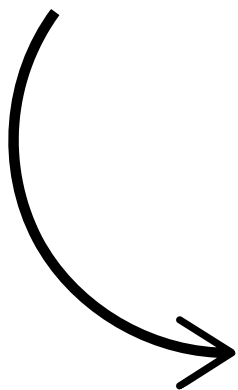

Heartstone is a non-profit arts, cultural and educational organisation that follows the publication of their book 'The Heartstone Odyssey'. The story describes a world in which there exists a powerful and well coordinated anti-racism movement. DOAWnews involves a group of 20 young people staging an online event using two stories drawn from 2 of Heartstone's photodocumentary and history story resources (more info can be found [here](#)). They will in essence be organising and hosting a 'news features programme' and in the process, the project will:

- Build literacy, communication, presentation and social skills as well as confidence and self-esteem;
- Reduce isolation, build community cohesion and challenge bigotry/prejudice/hate
- Raise aspirations and increase contact with potential employers and others who can assist the young people to reach their goals

How the project is undertaken is in the hands of the young people. They will organise it from start to finish, putting their own 'personal stamp' on the event. However, any support the group might need in making contact with potential speakers or more generally will be made available by Heartstone.

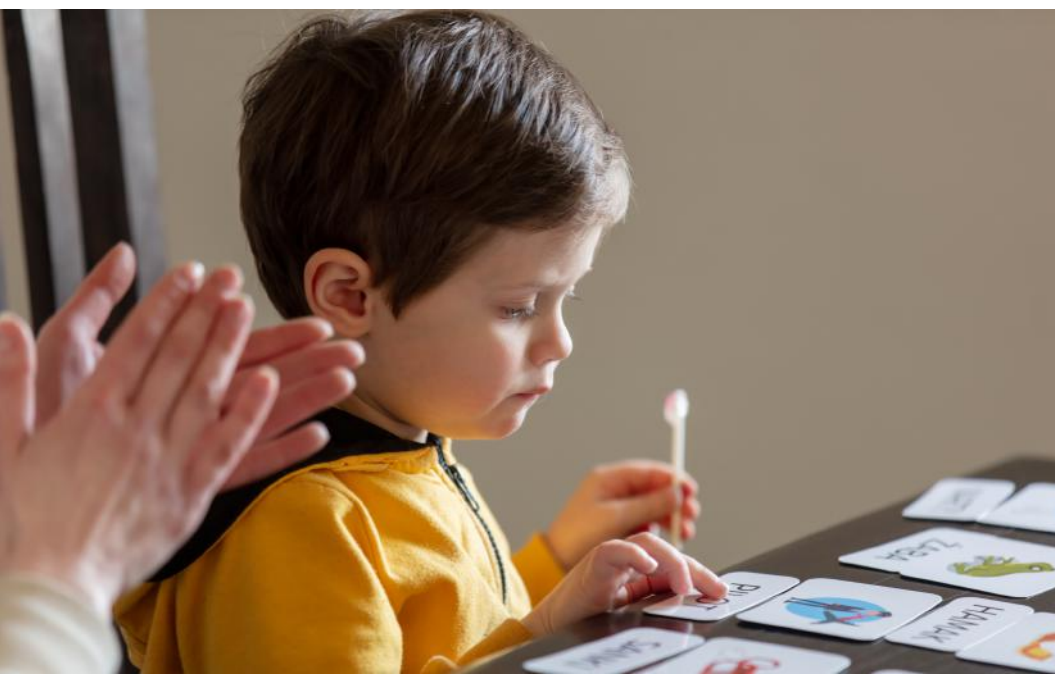

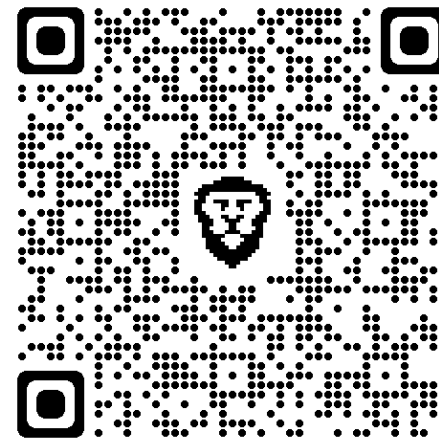
