

## Henderson Foundation Bursary Terms & Conditions

The Henderson Foundation Bursary will be offered for the first time in 2022 with the intention of funding a bursary for a resident of The Women's College.

The donation to The Women's College is an initiative of the Henderson Foundation in honour of Sir Neville Henderson CBE (1899-1986). Neville's connection to The Women's College was in the 1940s and 1950s as a member of the Building Appeal Committee on which he served as Chairman and also a Vice-President.

The Terms and Conditions of the Bursary are as follows:

- 1. The name of the Bursary shall be 'Henderson Foundation Bursary' and is awarded by The Women's College on the recommendation of the Head of College.
- 2. The Bursary shall be awarded to a current or future student of The Women's College during the tenure of the Bursary and who is enrolled or seeking to be enrolled at a university in Brisbane.
- 3. The Bursary shall be awarded to a resident who is from a low income and disadvantaged family who might not otherwise have access to The Women's College experience.
- 4. In awarding the Bursary, preference will be given to a student from rural or regional Queensland who is in financial need with respect to meeting accommodation expenses.
- 5. The recipient of the Bursary will not be eligible for any other Women's College scholarship or bursary in that year.
- 6. The Bursary shall be awarded for one academic year. The Bursary shall lapse upon the student ceasing to be in residence at the College.
- 7. The value of the Bursary shall be determined by agreement between the Henderson Foundation and the Head of College. In its first year, the Bursary will equate to \$4,000 per annum.
- 8. The Bursary will be terminated if the recipient:
  - is no longer enrolled full-time at a university in Brisbane;
  - not maintaining satisfactory academic progress; or
  - is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
