Insurance Disclaimer

Bartlett Park District does not carry premises medical payments insurance coverage. The park district is a local public entity and is subject to the Illinois Governmental and Governmental Employees Tort Immunity Act that provides certain immunities and defenses to claims for damages made against local public entities. Without these statutory immunities, fees associated with recreational activities, programs, properties and/or facilities could well be prohibitive.

Distinguished Accredited Agency

Bartlett Park District has been a Distinguished Accredited Agency since 1999. Accreditation is a voluntary program that uses a set of standards to evaluate and identify agencies throughout the state that provide exceptional park and recreation services to their community to improve their quality of life. As of January 2025, Bartlett is one of only 49 agencies in the state of Illinois with this distinction.

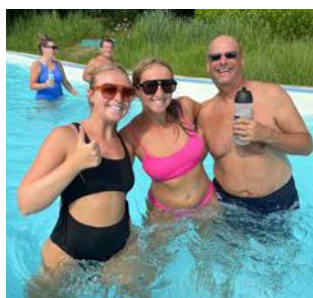




Annual Turbo Turtle Race

Special Safety Information

E-Bicycles and E-Motos in Bartlett Parks & Paths and Prohibited Vehicles

E-motos, quads, motorcycles, dirt bikes, mopeds, or any motorized device not classified as a legal E-bike under Illinois law are prohibited on and off paths, including in parks, on golf courses, and athletic fields. These vehicles have caused costly damage to public spaces.

Permitted E-Bikes (per the State of Illinois)

- **Class 1:** Pedal assist only, up to 20 mph
- **Class 2:** Throttle assist, up to 20 mph
- **Class 3:** Pedal assist (optional throttle), up to 28 mph; riders must be 16+

Only Class 1-3 E-bikes are permitted on Bartlett paths. Check your bike manufacturer's label to confirm its class. E-bikes are not allowed on sidewalks.

Did You Know?

- Devices with motors over 750 watts are not E-bikes. These "E-motos" (Out-of-Class Electric Vehicles) are illegal in parks and on public paths and roads.
- Many child and teen-marketed motorized bikes fall into the E-moto category and should only be used on private property.

Bike Safety & Rules of the Road

- Perform a pre-ride safety and mechanical check.
- Wear a helmet—it reduces head injury risk.
- Be visible at night: use reflective gear, a headlight, and a rear light or reflector.
- Slow down and use caution when passing by pedestrians.
- Pass on the left when safe.
- Ride on the right side of the path.
- Use hand signals for turns and stops.
- Obey all traffic laws, signs, and signals.

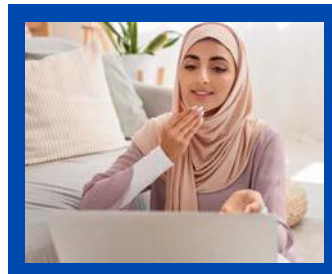

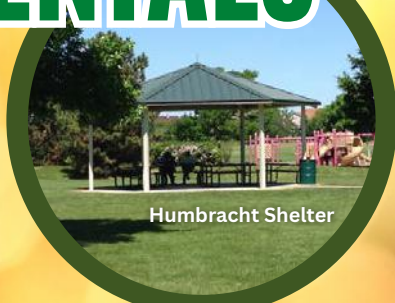

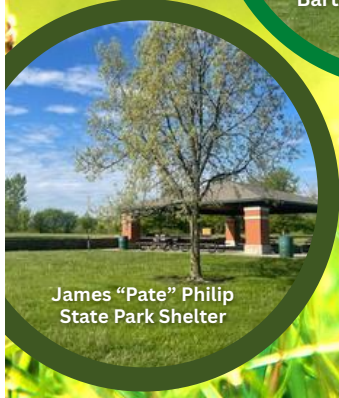

Fall Soccer Registration

1. Player Registration: To participate, complete, and submit the Sports Registration Form by July 12. All registrations received by the deadline are guaranteed to play. Registrations received after the registration deadline will be placed on a waitlist. Placement will only be done when an opening occurs. Only a parent or legal guardian may register a child and sign the waiver. Registration is by grade level. Register for the grade the player will be in that season. "Playing up" is not encouraged, but those requesting to do so must receive the approval of the Recreation Manager. Submit your registration form and payment with your request to "play up," and you will be contacted at a later date with a determination.

2. Volunteer Coaches: Please consider volunteering as a coach. Many coaches are needed to make this a great program! We provide equipment, training, and resources. Complete the bold section on the registration form and be sure to provide an e-mail address. Unfortunately, if not enough coach volunteers, the program is forced to have large teams, reducing playing time or limiting the number of teams within the leagues.

3. Team Sports Refund Policy: Refunds requested after the registration deadline will be issued only if a replacement player is registered. A \$5 administrative fee is charged per person. Depending on the time of the refund request, we cannot guarantee a refund of the uniform portion of the fee.

4. Games: Games are typically played on Saturdays, but occasional weeknight games may be scheduled. Games canceled due to inclement weather are not guaranteed to be made up. Those enrolled in 3rd/4th grade, 5th/6th grade, and 7th/8th grade play in an intervillage league with surrounding communities up to 20 minutes away.
