Located in the Yeo Valley near the beautiful Blagdon Lake, with 4.52 hectares of vines, Aldwick's vines are hand-tended throughout the year by a small dedicated team. Grapes are handpicked every September to October, then our wine maker, Steve Brooksbank, creates our range of red, white, rosé and sparkling wine. With the first vines planted in 2008, six varieties of grape are grown at Aldwick Estate; Pinot Noir, Seyval Blanc, Bacchus, Madeline Angevine, Solaris and Regent.

Throughout the year between April and October we offer vineyard tours and tastings to visiting guests.

Château Ksara produces an exciting portfolio of elegant whites, thrilling rosés and a diverse range of delicious reds, using indigenous and international varieties such as Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah as well as Carignan, Cinsault, Merwah and Obeidi. Combining heritage with innovation, Ksara continues to invest in sustainable vineyard practices and modern winemaking techniques while honouring its legacy.

The wines reflect both the formidable Bekaa terroir and impart a distinctive Levantine identity, making Château Ksara the preeminent ambassador for Lebanese wines worldwide.
