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# DISCOVER Romania...

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In the final turbulent years of the communist regime in Romania, three families invested in a formerly state-run winery, today Cramele Recaş is one of, if not *the* best regarded wine producer in Romania. With ancient vines dating back to 1447 located on the western edge of the Transylvania wine region, it is ideally positioned with a Mediterranean climate, on the same latitude as Bordeaux.

## Calusari Pinot Grigio 2024

The grapes that go into this pinot grigio are harvested before dawn and in the early morning so they are still firm in the cool air and are less liable to be bruised or damaged before processing. This care and attention to detail produces opulent aromas of grapefruit and peach that follow through to a lithe body, with abundant melon and apple character and citrusy acidity.

## Orange Solara 2023

The immaculate vineyards of Cramele Recaş were first recorded in 1447 and they have much more recent plantings too, with investments modernising and improving the winery. This orange wine is an exceptional example, containing the refreshing palate of a white wine with the complexity of a red. Dark straw in colour with orange hints, the nose is a delicate mélange of quince, poire William and a hint of vanilla.

## Umbrele Pinot Noir, 2022

Cramele Recaş is in every way a modern, dynamic winery, whose open-minded approach and quality sets them apart. 100% estate grown grapes from the Dealul Uberland vineyard, the altitude here is around 250m, with soil rich in iron oxide. Dark, rich and potent, with layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. Deep with pretty fruit cake and spicy aromatics.

## Solevari Reserve Feteasca Neagra 2021

Early in the season, workers go through the vineyards and individually cut a percentage of the grapes from the vine and throw them on the vineyard floor. This allows the vine to put more of its resources into the remaining grapes, making them riper and more flavoursome. A brilliant spicy nose of black pepper, blackberry, black currant and red cherry. Medium bodied with very dry, rich and grippy tannins and beautifully balanced acidity.
