



Mexican Hot Dish

"Keep It Simple"

Ingredients:

- 1 lb. Ground Beef
- 1 Minced Onion
- 1 Taco Seasoning Pkg
- 34 Cup Water
- 1 Can Enchilada Sauce
- 1 Can Cream of Mushroom Soup
- 1 Can Cream of Chicken Soup
- 1 Can Green Chilies
- 1 Bag Tortilla Chips (I like Doritos)

2 Cups Cheddar Cheese

Directions:

In a skillet, brown onions and beef—drain if needed. In a medium bowl, mix the next 6 ingredients. Then add the beef and mix.

Take a 9x13 casserole dish and layer chips, beef mixture, and cheese. Repeat layers until the dish is full.

Top with cheese and crushed tortillas.

Bake at 350°F for 30 to 40 minutes.

34 cup Parmesan Cheese

Directions:

Sauté Green Beans and Garlic in Olive Oil until softened, about 5 to 7 minutes. Mix cream and seasonings. Add to skillet and cook on medium for 10 minutes. Finally, add in Parmesan and stir. Serve hot.



The Search Is The Same



Have A Look Around



Have you ever attended a Dog Show? I had only seen them on television. Now, here's your opportunity to go to one in Saint Paul!



Today's Test Stick


"Be Ready"
