

Suzanne Mourot Award Terms & Conditions

The Suzanne Mourot Award is a bequest to The Women's College under the will of Suzanne Mourot, alumna (1939-1941) and Fellow of the Women's College, who died on 1 July 2010. Suzanne Mourot was a Tutor at The Women's College in French Conversation from 1939 to 1943. The award honours the memory of Paul and Jeanne Mourot.

The Terms and Conditions of the bursary are as follows:

1. Name and Awarding Body

The name of the bursary shall be the 'Suzanne Mourot Award' and will be awarded on the recommendation of The Women's College Head of College and CEO.

2. Eligibility

The bursary shall be awarded to a resident of The Women's College who is enrolled full-time at The University of Queensland.

The bursary is to be made to a resident who was born in and whose permanent home is New Caledonia including the Loyalty Islands and Isle of Pines.

Should there be no suitable applicant, a student undertaking pure or applied science, social science including disciplines of anthropology, archaeology, criminology and sociology, shall be awarded.

3. Financial Need

In making the award, preference will be given to a student who is in financial need with respect to meeting accommodation expenses.

4. Duration

The bursary shall be awarded for one academic year and may be awarded to the same student in her second and successive years subject to satisfactory progress in her academic studies.

The recipient of the bursary will not be eligible for any other Women's College scholarship or bursary in that year.

5. Termination

The Bursary will be terminated if the recipient:

- is no longer enrolled full-time at The University of Queensland;
- not maintaining satisfactory academic progress; or
- is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
