

Dedicated to promoting health and well-being at every stage of life, this impact area includes fitness classes, wellness coaching, and evidence-based health interventions (EBHI) programs proven to support chronic disease prevention, cancer recovery, and overall physical and mental health.

THE YMCA COMMUNITY HUB:

The YMCA Community Hub is a welcoming space where older adults or those recovering from or living with chronic disease can connect to essential resources, build relationships, and access programs that support their health, well-being, and growth. Located just a few blocks from the Downtown Y Branch, the Hub is a welcoming, multipurpose space designed through partnerships with local health organizations to serve as a cornerstone for outreach, wellness, creativity, and social engagement. We work to combat chronic loneliness (which is linked to increased risks of heart disease, stroke, and cognitive decline) by providing evidence-based programs in an inclusive and accessible environment.

Location: 805 W. Franklin St., Boise, ID Hours: Open weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Amenities: Free parking, a coffee bar, a group exercise room, and a conference space

CORE PROGRAMS INCLUDE:

- Rock Steady Boxing (for Parkinson's)
- Movement for Memory (early-stage dementia/MCI)
- Delay the Disease (Parkinson's specific exercise)
- HOPE (monthly virtual education on brain health)
- Oncology Recovery Program (12-week physical and emotional wellness program)
- EnhanceFitness (chronic disease management)
- Artist-in-Residence (creative therapy)
- Workshops (Al learning, nutrition, estate planning, etc.)
- Social Activities (book clubs, cribbage, and more)
- Wellness Passport (for those with w/neurological disorders)
- ForeverWell (active adult programs, i.e., stability, etc.)

YMCA BRAIN HEALTH SYMPOSIUM (ANNUALLY IN OCTOBER):

The Brain Health Symposium is a free, full-day educational event designed to promote cognitive wellness and reduce risk factors associated with cognitive decline. Open to the public and health professionals alike, the symposium features expert keynote speakers, interactive breakout sessions, and opportunities for continuing education (CE) credits.

Affordable Access to Quality Childcare: Our licensed childcare programs provide a safe, nurturing environment for infants through schoolage, supporting early development and school readiness. Afterschool Programming & Lights on Afterschool Event (Valley-Wide at 25+ Locations): Offered at 25+ valley locations, YMCA Afterschool Programs give kids a safe, enriching space to learn, play, and grow. Each October, we celebrate their impact through Lights On Afterschool, a national event highlighting how these programs keep youth safe, inspired, and connected.

Healthy Kids Day: A free, family-focused event encouraging kids to stay active and healthy all year long with fun activities, wellness resources, and hands-on learning.

Character Value Celebrations: These special events recognize children who exemplify the Y's core values: caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility, while celebrating the positive impact of Youth Development programs.

Foster Family Support: Dedicated support for foster families, including program access, financial assistance, and community-building events to nurture belonging and connection.

Youth in Government: A leadership development program where teens engage in civic education by simulating the legislative process. Building confidence, critical thinking, and a sense of civic responsibility.

Spring, Summer & Winter Break Camps: Action–packed camps that keep kids engaged through hands–on learning and fun. Featuring cooking, arts & crafts, dance & tumble, martial arts, climbing, fitness, and social clubs.

STEM Classes: Interactive classes that spark curiosity and critical thinking through projects in science, technology, engineering, and math. Helping kids build 21st-century skills in a fun, supportive setting.

THRIVE and AquAbility: The THRIVE Center supports individuals with neurological differences through inclusive spaces, adaptive programs, and life skills training. From sensory-friendly play to adaptive sports and our AquAbility swim program, THRIVE builds confidence, independence, and lifelong access for all.



ONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Basketball (Y-Ball): Our most popular youth program, YMCA Basketball, teaches the fundamentals of dribbling, passing, and shooting in a supportive team environment. Players build confidence, coordination, and strong sportsmanship skills.

Volleyball: Youth learn serving, bumping, setting, and teamwork while developing agility and communication. Volleyball at the Y emphasizes equal play and positive coaching for beginners and growing athletes alike.

Soccer: With a focus on movement, teamwork, and fun, YMCA Soccer introduces players to the basics of the game: Passing, shooting, and positioning, while building endurance and spatial awareness.

Aquatics: Focused on survival swim and water safety, our aquatics sessions teach essential self–rescue techniques and foundational swimming skills. Empowering kids to be confident and safe in and around water.

TEAM IDAHO (Youth Track & Field at the Downtown Boise YMCA): By participating in competitive track and field, youth and teens learn the importance of setting goals, embracing effort, and taking personal responsibility for their growth and performance. These experiences cultivate resilience, confidence, and a strong work ethic that extend beyond athletics. Sponsors supporting Youth Track and Field invest in building character and empowering future leaders. Heritage Dinner (Annually in November):

Welcoming Week Family Field Day/ Block Party (Annually in September):

In celebration of Boise's designation as a Certified Welcoming City, this free community event brings together recently resettled individuals and families and long-time residents to foster connection, inclusion, and cultural understanding. Held each September, the Block Party features family-friendly activities, food, entertainment, and resources from community partners; all designed to celebrate what unites us as neighbors.

Ongoing New Neighbor Support:

This year-round initiative ensures newly arrived refugee families feel welcomed and supported as they integrate into the community. The YMCA offers free three-month family memberships and swim lessons for children, while also partnering with local agencies to provide wrap-around services that support safety, connection, and well-being.
