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FIRST EARLY



ACCORD

Round to oval shapes potato with shallow eyes. Cream skinned and cream flesh and extremely waxy.

Yields are high for a first early. A good all round variety. Good resistance to common and powdery scab.



ARRAN PILOT

A UK favourite on the veggie plot. Has a firm, waxy texture and great flavour. Resistant to slug attack and scabbing. Early high yielding harvests from May. Just 5 tubers can produce at least 2-3kg of potatoes.



CASABLANCA

Relatively new variety. Great skin finish making it a good candidate for the show bench. Makes very good chips.

Boiling, mashing, baking, chipping and roasting.



DUKE OF YORK

Traditional early variety, harvest when young for a rich sweet flavour or leave to mature for a floury texture. Makes excellent baked potato. show good resistance to dry rot.

Boiling, baking, chipping and salad.

FIRST EARLY



FOREMOST

Foremost remains popular as a new potato with slightly waxy, firm white flesh and an excellent flavour.

Boiling, baking and salad.



FRANCIS

A beautiful, white skinned early cropping tuber. Francis produces large heavy yields for being so early. Francis produces long oval potatoes which makes delicious fluffy chips. Plant Feb/March for a May/June harvest
Or plant in April for July/August harvest
A great all rounder!



LADY CHRISTL

Lady Christl produces very early oval tubers of a medium size. Tubers are yellow skinned and the flesh is creamy to waxy with good taste. Good resistance to common scab. All round disease resistance.

Excellent for boiling, chipping and mashing.
But still good for baking and roasting!



MARIS BARD

First early variety that bulks early. It is high yielding and has high potato numbers. Oval shaped with white skins, shallow tuber eyes white flesh.

Good resistance against common scab.

Baking, boiling and salad.

FIRST EARLY



PENTLAND JAVELIN

First early variety with good eelworm (golden) resistance . Very bright with a mild flavour. Produces heavy crops of short oval white skinned tubers with pure white tasty flesh. Good slug resistance.

Boiling, chipping and salad.



RED DUKE OF YORK

A traditional red-skinned variety with a yellow flesh. Makes excellent roasts. Dry, mealy potato packed with flavour and do not disintegrate on boiling.

Boiling, baking, chipping and roasting



ROCKET

Recent variety, throws a large number of round whole potatoes.

White fleshed and skinned with a mild taste. There is good resistance to blackleg, common scab

Boiling and salad.



SHARPE'S EXPRESS

An heirloom variety introduced in 1900 by Charles Sharpe of Lincolnshire. It is pear-shaped with bright white flesh, smooth skin and a superb flavour. Boil or steam them whole in their skins (they're floury), and enjoy them hot with butter or cold with salads. TV gardener's Percy Thrower's favourite.

FIRST EARLY



WINSTON

This Jack Dunnett variety has proved to be both a commercial success & exhibition success.

Released in 1992 this variety has been unstoppable on the show bench winning many titles. Produces high yields of smooth shallow eyed tubers that are short oval in shape. A firm texture and excellent all round disease resistance. Would be described as a wet potato.

SECOND EARLY



ESTIMA

The baking potato of choice sold in most supermarkets.

Produces heavy crops of large oval tubers with light yellow skin and flesh.

Good resistance to growth cracks and one of the most popular seed potatoes in the UK.

Great for baking, boiling and mashing
But still good for chipping and roasting



HARRY

Medium sized with a smooth texture it's perfect for making fluffy mash and crispy roast spuds. Valued for its high yields and cooking versatility, Harry potatoes are popular among gardeners and cooks for its consistent results.

Good resistance to common scab and bruising.



KESTREL

Attractive whole skins with purple eyes. Makes excellent chips and roast potatoes.

SECOND EARLY



MARFONA

Very popular with farmers due to its ability to produce baking potatoes very early. Good bright skin finish and a nice flavour, oval shaped, with light yellow skins and cream coloured flesh.

MARIS PEER

Popular second early potatoes with a very good flavour. Are good as salad potatoes. Plant produces large clusters of pretty purple flowers which are even scented. Good resistance to all skin diseases. Good slug resistance.

Boiling, baking, mashing and salad.



NADINE

Exceptionally high yielding variety with bright white skins and a good entry for the show bench. Good scab and slug resistance.

Boiling, baking, mashing and roasting.



SAGITTA

Sagitta are one of the best tasting potatoes available today. Mainly used in the chip shop trade. These tubers provide excellent fluffy mash and are perfect for chipping.

Excellent for boiling, chipping, roasting. Good for baking, mashing and salad.

SECOND EARLY



SALLY

Early/Second early potato that you can plant from mid March! Well-suited for the UK climate due to it thriving in cooler temperatures. Produces consistent, flavourful tubers making it reliable and popular for both gardeners and farmers.

Good resistance to common scab and slug damage. Excellent resistance to blight!



SAXON

Saxon is a modern-day variety that produces large crops of long oval white skinned tubers. The flesh is firm and yellow and ideal for all kitchen uses. It really is the chef's dream.

It also holds the prestigious RHS award of garden merit. They have a strong resistance to black dot, black leg and potato cyst nematode.



SKYWALKER

One for the Star Wars fans!

A high-yielding, disease-resistant variety. Bred from Casablanca and Victoria—it produces tasty, round-oval tubers with white skin and cream flesh. It is an excellent all-round potato, suitable for boiling, baking, roasting and chipping.



WILJA

A high yielding variety with a russeted skin. Will grow successfully in any type of soil and makes very nice tasting mash, baked and boiled potatoes.

Good scab resistance.

Baking, boiling, chipping, mashing and roasting.

MAIN CROP



CALEDONIAN ROSE

Attractive oval tubers with strong red skin and yellow flesh. Good all-rounder cooking qualities. Fair resistance to blight and scab and good resistance to eelworm.



CARA

Big-yielding variety with an attractive skin. Good resistance to blight and is good for long term storing. Plenty of size and is a good one to grow for a baker crop.

Good slug resistance and excellent drought resistance as well as good all round disease resistance.

Boiling, baking, chipping and roasting.



DESIREE

The most popular red-skinned variety in the UK giving great crops of large potatoes. A good culinary potato which boils well and has a delicious smooth texture. Heavy cropper and early bulking with high resistance to drought and good resistance to potato virus Y and powdery scab, mis-shapes on heavy soils.



HARMONY

A very popular export variety as it produces large crops of white skinned tubers that are very resistant to scab. It is an amazing baking potato. Most people know Harmony because of its show bench success. It has shallow eyes and a smooth skin. Strong resistance to common scab, black dot and skin spot. A partial resistance to potato cyst nematode.

MAIN CROP



JAVA

Java is a high yielding main crop variety that has been bred to have high pest and disease resistance. The red skinned tubers have pale tasty flesh, good for all round kitchen use.



KING EDWARD

A well known favourite in the potato world. Attractive white skins with bright splashes of red. Makes the ideal roasts and baked potatoes but is also good boiled with a strong, aromatic flavour. Good scab resistance.

Baking, boiling, chipping, mashing and roasting.



MARIS PIPER

Probably the best known potato in Britain and one of the most versatile with an attractive plant with purple flowers. Oval shaped with white skins and cream coloured flesh.

STUTTARTER GIANT



A much favoured variety with flat-shaped, yellow skinned bulbs. Stuttarter Giant produces excellent yields and keeping properties.

Sets planted in the spring should be ready for harvesting from late summer/early autumn.

STURON



One of the all-time great onions on account of its reliability and consistency. Large straw-coloured bulbs that show good bolting resistance and have a fine flavour and store well.

Harvesting from late summer/early autumn.

TURBO



This golden-brown skinned variety is late maturing, producing good yields of medium sized onions. The rounded bulbs have a crisp flesh and a deliciously strong flavour that is suitable for all culinary purposes. Height: 45cm (18"). Spread: 15cm (6").

RED BARON

YELLOW MOON

Probably the earliest of all shallots, this Dutch red variety produces a heavy crop of smaller bulbs that have an intense, almost spicy, flavour. It is not unusual for this variety to be ready for harvesting in July - yet it will often keep firm and well until the following May.

Leave a space of 10cm (4") between each bulb, and 30cm (12") between each row

One of the best performers for autumn planting and is very popular with commercial growers due to its hardiness and high yields. Autumn Champion will provide you with an early harvest of golden skinned onions with excellent flavour which will store for many months

RADAR



If you experience severe winters, try ultra-hardy Radar as it puts up with the worst of the weather much better than many older varieties. This outstanding performer has a mild and crisp flavour.

They should be ready 6 weeks before spring sown varieties and give good crops of tasty globe shaped bulbs
