In the wake of the devastation of October 7, JNF Australia was uniquely positioned to immediately respond to the most critical needs of shattered families.

This included urgent financial support for families, emergency food supplies, temporary housing, clothing, critical medicine and first aid supplies, mobile bomb shelters, civilian security equipment, community armoured transport vehicles and first responder protective equipment.

We also provided psychological support, mental health services, resilience activities for children, educational materials, and temporary kindergartens and classrooms.




