

So, he agreed. At his first opportunity on Easter Sunday, he walked forward. 'This is what I've been looking for. THE POWER OF A BACKPACK



Meghan and her family went from being jobless, homeless, paralyzed by addiction, and in a broken marriage to saved, baptized, set free of addictions, and restored!

After losing her job, her home, and struggling to save her husband from addiction, Meghan had hit rock bottom and felt completely hopeless. She, her husband, and her three kids had no other choice but to move into a 700 square-foot apartment. School was about to start and they had no money for food, school supplies, or clothes. That's when Meghan received an invitation to church, along with a promise to receive a backpack for her 5th grade daughter for the upcoming school year. By the end of service, she ran up to receive Christ during the altar call.

From that day on her entire life changed!

A month later, her husband got saved and entered Calvary House. Through that program, they learned to build a relationship with Christ and rebuild their marriage. They were both baptized and Meghan went on to work the next 10 years in ministry helping children and families in need.

Her daughter (through a generous and anonymous donor) received the opportunity to attend CCA for one year. After that year, Meghan and her husband were able to continue sending her daughter to CCA on their own, and in 2018 she graduated and was accepted to a fantastic college out of state!





José and his wife Mara were both actors who met in a television studio. They got married, did telenovelas together, and in 2009, God touched their hearts and asked them to leave that world behind and enter into ministry at Calvary Chapel Fort Lauderdale.



José Llamas was ordained on December 8, 2018 as a new Calvary Chapel pastor. Before then, he'd been teaching *La Palabra* (God's Word) to a growing Spanish-speaking multitude.

It's something to see him on a stage again. This is the same man that stood where an X marked his spot before studio cameras as he played leading roles in Spanish telenovelas (soap operas) since the 90s. Nearly two decades later, he stands on a pulpit proclaiming God's Word. His dramatic side is still very much a part of his character. And so, it is with an imposing passion, sonorous voice, and hand gestures, which are such an integral part of Spanish communication, that he delivers the message of the gospel, retaining that power to captivate an audience's ear and imagination.

"My wife Mara and I had been praying for months, 'God, where do you want us to be?'" said Llamas. "We felt like Nehemiah, with a big burden for the Latin community."

Mara is from Puerto Rico and José is from Mexico. Their hearts ached for the Spanish speakers in church, who because of culture and barrier of language, might not be connecting to our church family. Then, the Lord gave Pastor Doug Sauder a vision. He shared the idea to start a Spanish fellowship as part of a multi-cultural church, which shows that we are one church, one body—*una sola familia*. "Mara and I had prayed about this for so many months, so this was answered prayer," said Llamas.

It's been a year since *Compartiendo La Palabra*, the Spanish Fellowship, started. It's held on the first Saturday of every month, providing an oasis for those in the Spanish-speaking community that are thirsty for a church with true doctrine, practice, and sentiment that says, *mi casa es tu casa* (my house is your house).

Since connecting is a big part of our church's vision, Pastor José and Mara began a plan to connect Broward's Latin community. On April 6, over 300 Spanish-speaking people came together under one roof, packing both the North and South Banquet Halls. Last December, Calvary Chapel Fort Lauderdale held its first Spanish Christmas service, which Llamas taught.

As a by-product of *Compartiendo La Palabra*, we now offer six classes all taught in Spanish, like *Diseño de Discipulado* (Discipleship Design)—a popular, 36-week course which has 55 people attending!

Last March, Llamas led the launch of the Brazilian Fellowship, opening our doors to the Portuguese-speaking community, and since then new classes in Portuguese have started.

"We live in South Florida, such a diverse and multi-cultural area," concluded Llamas. "That's why we've created a multi-cultural ministry to reach people right here and in their own language." ☀️

6 WAYS SMALL GROUPS HELP YOU GROW

I think we can all agree there is a gap between who we are today and who we want to become. For believers, our goal should be to grow closer to the Lord and become more like Jesus.

Even the apostle Paul understood and sought after this with all his heart. That's why in Philippians 3:12 (NIV) he said, "Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me."

Did you know one of the primary places where growth occurs is within a small group? Here are a few reasons why being part of a group will help you grow as a follower of Jesus and as a person.

01 Jesus' Way of Life Is Most Effectively Learned in Community

Hebrews 10:24–25

Jesus' teachings fall into two categories: how to love God and how to love people. Neither of these can be truly learned alone. They require people who can provide insight, advice, and encouragement. A small group is a tried-and-true place to experience this and to learn how to practically live as Jesus did.

02 Community Builds Our Sense of Belonging

Romans 12:5

We all want to feel like we belong, like we're accepted and truly loved. God gives us the gift of each other as a way to meet our earthly needs for

belonging and acceptance. Groups are an amazing opportunity to build deep, lasting relationships with others, to walk through the triumphs and tragedies of life, to support and bear one another's burdens, and to experience the joy of true friendship!

03 Community Cultivates Gifts and Talents

Ecclesiastes 4:9–12

In a Christ-centered community, we have the opportunity to discover, develop, and operate in our gifts and talents, to use them to serve the Lord, and to bless others through them. As the body of Christ comes together to grow in Him and serve one another, our unique roles in the body can be used to glorify God to the fullest.

04 Mission Happens in Community

1 Corinthians 1:10

One powerful way Christians grow through small groups is by working toward shared goals and common causes, whether that's providing housing for a homeless person, supporting a missionary, or making meals for foster families. Or maybe they might band together to serve a group member with a serious health issue, personal struggle, or unexpected tragedy. When a community of like-minded people unite to accomplish a meaningful mission, growth is the natural result.

05 Accountability, Confession, and Healing Happen in Community

Galatians 6:1–5

Isolation is dangerous. Imagine a lone lion struggling to fight off a pack of 20 hyenas, but then another lion shows up—the hyenas will scatter. If you really seek it, there is safety in community because you have people who will speak truth into your life and help keep you accountable, resist temptation, and spur you on to love and good works. True community requires transparency, authenticity, and confession . . . all of which can help bring us to a place of healing.

06 Community Helps Take Church Beyond the Four Walls

Acts 2:46

In community, we can get down into the nitty gritty of how to practically live out Scripture in the day-to-day. People can share revelation, experiences, wisdom, and bounce ideas off of one another. Community brings church into real life.

RAISING UP CALVARY KIDS


Joanna D'Antonio, a Calvary Kids volunteer who serves in the two-year-old area and was recently recognized at a Calvary Crew Rally for her exceptional work and partnership in the Education Project Team for Vision 2023, said, "My favorite part about serving in Calvary Kids is being able to watch the little ones praise Jesus during worship! It's so precious watching them get excited as they sing and dance along during the Wiggles & Worship time! Sometimes, I even catch them dancing before we start. It's the most awesome thing to watch."

Can you imagine having trouble getting just one child to clean up or quiet down, let alone a dozen or more? Not for D'Antonio. She's been coming to Calvary since she was a kid, and having experienced God use others to disciple and pour love into her life, she now sees Calvary Kids as an opportunity to pass it on and help raise up world changers for Christ.

"God wants us to raise up new disciples," she said. "It's kind of a domino effect. Even though these little ones are only two years old, I love planting seeds in their lives, because that's what happened with me."

This summer will mark two years since she started volunteering in Calvary Kids. The once shy girl who felt like an outcast in a middle school small group, recalls how her mentors, Ann and Evelyn, reached out and pulled her back in. Today, she thinks of them often, especially as she recalls the song "Reckless Love" which depicts Jesus leaving the 99 to go after the one.

It was that small group experience that inspired her passion to work with kids. She came to church one Wednesday night, not thinking about anything in particular, when a friend suggested she ought to serve in Calvary Kids. "Orientation is this Sunday, why don't



you come?" her friend asked. And she said, "Sure!" Inexplicably, as soon as orientation started, she felt the two-year-old area pulling at her heartstrings. So, she signed up and showed up that next Wednesday, ready to serve.

D'Antonio remembers how she immediately connected with the leaders and all the kids set apart in that warm, colorful space designed for our youngest disciples. "It was so much fun!" she said. "God really led me to that specific place because as soon as I walked in, I heard people saying they were short volunteers in the two-year-old area. And God just led me there. It's exactly where I needed to be. I connect really well with the little ones, and even though they're little, they understand when you say, 'We love you, and Jesus loves you more!'" ☀️

GIVING IS AN ACT OF WORSHIP



Giving is not simply dropping off a tithe check; it's about stewarding everything the Lord has blessed us with. . . time, talent, and resources.

Everything you steward is an act of worship. The question is, “If you’re not stewarding it for the Lord, then who are you worshiping?”

That’s how Wade and Lynn Walcott summarized last fall’s Whole-Life Generosity seminar conducted at the Plantation campus: “Giving is not simply dropping off a tithe check; it’s about stewarding everything the Lord has blessed us with—time, talent, and treasure. It’s really taking responsibility for all the Lord has given us and using it properly.”

The Whole-Life Generosity seminar was eye-opening for the Walcotts, and it expanded their vision for what the Lord wanted them to do through their church and family. They walked away with an increased sense of freedom and understanding that everything they have is God’s. Wade shared, “And since we can’t out-give Him, and we can trust He’s going to provide, then clearly the question should become, ‘How would God have us use our blessings more tangibly?’”

The seminar made Wade reflect on the parable of the rich man, where Jesus talks about a man who built more barns to store up all of his stuff. The point Wade drew from it was that Jesus didn’t rebuke the man for being wealthy, but for storing everything up for himself.

Lately, the idea that, “What you would do for all, do for one,” has become very much a part of Wade’s vocabulary. ☺

How Washing Clothes Can Have an Eternal Impact

Wash. Rinse. Spin . . . Repeat.

It's something you probably do every week. And for some, maybe several times a day. Being able to simply wash and dry our clothes (for most of us, out of the convenience of our own homes) is just an ordinary part our weekly routine. But 6,530 miles away, in refugee camps all over Lebanon, being able to do laundry is a bridge—a door, a gateway, an opportunity—to be and share the love of Jesus in a tangible way.

More Than a Laundry Service

Did you know 1.5 million refugees currently reside in Lebanon?

"We emphatically see this devastating circumstance as a divine opportunity from which we can share God's Word with people in dire need of a sustainable hope," said Ronnie Bassous, New Heights executive director.

So, what is the Made Clean Project exactly? It's an initiative aimed at providing a laundry service to Syrian refugees, while simultaneously running a gospel-centered children's program.

Located in Lebanon, and taking place all over the country within different refugee settlement camps, it utilizes two mobile laundry vans. The team visits 12 new settlement camps each quarter, servicing each camp a total of 12 times throughout a three-month cycle.

"We have been able to provide laundry service to families who would otherwise not have access to this resource. In doing so, we have created a space to spiritually engage the children and families we encounter, giving them a chance to discover the message of God's love," said Elie Hayek, Made Clean manager.

For Syrians By Syrians

Each weekday, the team prepares the vans at their ministry headquarters in Beirut. Daily ministry takes place in two parts—during the mornings, the team does their rotation visits,



and during the afternoons, they visit camps they have already serviced in order to provide consistent and ongoing ministry.

When they arrive at the camp, they set up the laundry system and wait for families to bring their laundry. As they do their laundry, they have an incredible opportunity to spend time building relationships with them.

"A unique quality about Made Clean is that it is put on for Syrians by Syrians. All of our team members are Syrian, which give them the unique ability to relate to the people here through their heart language," said Elie Hayek.

Simultaneously, the team puts on an interactive biblical children's program for all kids who want to participate! There are 12 lessons taught, based on life anecdotes much like what these children have experienced, and complemented with biblical stories they are able to relate to. The highlight of the program is the short-film *Not Alone*, which tells the story of a Syrian refugee family who has endured significant tragedy but also discovers great hope. This allows the team to engage in conversations about the gospel with those who have never been exposed to a Christian message before!

A Look Back

- In December 2017, **you generously gave \$100,000** for the Made Clean Project, which has provided support for the monthly upkeep of two vans over approximately two years. However, that support is almost up. Your giving to the Made Clean Project can help us continue to share the love of Christ in Lebanon!
- In 2018, we were able to wash laundry for **1,872 families**. That's a total of **7,132 loads of laundry!**

Defending Women and Children from Violence

Did you know that Columbia, Peru, and Bolivia (the Andean Region) are among the top 20 countries in the world for gender based violent crimes? Millions of women and children are victims of sexual violence, intimate partner violence, and femicide (the intentional killing of women or girls because of their gender).

In 2018, you responded to this heartbreak reality by giving \$100,000 during our Christmas birthday gift to Jesus. As a result, we've partnered with International Justice Mission (IJM) to provide rescue and healing for these vulnerable women and children.

There are certain projects that just make my heart beat a little bit faster—and this is one of them. This is the passion of God. In Proverbs 22:22-23 (NIV) it says, “Do not exploit the poor because they are poor and do not crush the needy in court, for the Lord will take up their case.” Think about God as your attorney, think about God as the one who fights for you and defends you!







5 WAYS TO INVEST IN THE NEXT GENERATION

Jesus didn't leave buildings or money. Instead, He left a clear mission and 11 equipped and empowered disciples who were filled with the Holy Spirit to go out and change the world! After His three years of ministry with them, teaching and equipping them, He said, "Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these" (John 14:12-14 NIV).

As believers, we've been given the same charge to make disciples. As Jesus did with His disciples, He is now looking to us to come alongside the next generation and empower them to take the baton. Maybe you're thinking, *I'm not John or Peter or Paul, what can I offer? Or I'm not a Bible scholar. I don't know where to start. I don't know how to disciple someone. I don't have someone to disciple.*

You don't have to be a Bible scholar or expert disciple-maker—you have more to offer than you even realize. Your story is powerful, your life experiences are valuable, and your walk with Jesus can change the trajectory of someone else's life!

Here are a few ways you can invest in the next generation . . .

MEET THEM WHERE THEY'RE AT

If you want to invest in the next generation, you have to GO where the next generation is! Consider signing up as a volunteer coach at a local community center or youth league, participate in an afterschool program, get plugged in to middle school, high school, and college clubs like First Priority or CRU, or volunteer with Elkon, HSM, Six78, or Calvary Kids. There are countless opportunities all around you!

SERVE TOGETHER

Do you serve in a ministry here at Calvary? Connect with our youth and young adult ministries and ask them if there is a student who could serve with you! Maybe you're a greeter. We can help you find a student with the gift of hospitality to partner with you. As you train, equip, empower, and share responsibilities with him or her, you'll also be able to have great conversation and pour into his or her life.

DO LIFE TOGETHER

A common obstacle for many is the idea of adding something else to your schedule when your schedule is already jam packed. But it doesn't always have to be like that—you can bring your mentee into your life. Need to go grocery shopping? Get your oil changed? Take your kids to their game? Bring your disciple with you. Not only will they hear you talk about living a Christian life, but they'll also get to see it in action as you interact with others.

TEACH THEM SKILLS

You can also use what you know to teach them both practical life lessons and share biblical truths. Many young people are looking to learn useful skills that you are well-versed in. Tying a tie, changing a tire, cooking, finances (taxes, budgeting, investing), sewing, and anything else you find useful in your life that could be useful to them!

SAVE A SEAT

I recently heard a story of a family that always kept a seat open at their dinner table and made enough food so they could invite someone over for dinner any time. Whether it's a co-worker, someone you met at the store, or someone from church, this is an opportunity to invest in someone during a time that's already part of your schedule. This is also a cool way for your kids to get involved by inviting a friend from school, a club, or sport's team. By doing this, you'll be partnering with them to make disciples!

Please know that you're never too old to pour into younger people, and you're never too young to start. And don't assume that younger generations hate you and don't want to talk to you. Not true! They may not always show it or ask for it, but people desire and welcome it. Take the step. If there's someone you know who could benefit from discipleship and mentorship, reach out to them. If you don't, we'll help you find someone! ☀️

DID YOU KNOW?

• On average, **132 children were removed from their homes every month** in Broward and Palm Beach counties since Vision 2023 launched.

• 4KIDS had to **turn away an average of 55 children a month** in Broward and Palm Beach Counties, on average, simply because foster homes were not available. The Foster Care Project Team hopes to provide a home for every child by licensing new families to foster children and help support current foster families so they can continue fostering children.



• Substance abuse impacts the whole family. Over the past three years, the state has removed children from addicted parents in more than 4,000 cases in our area. In Palm Beach County, there was a **42% increase in cases linked to drug abuse** from January to July 2018, as compared to the same period in 2017.

FROM DARKNESS TO LIGHT

Steven Rosensteel thought he was like everybody else. From a very young age, even though he lived in a Christian home and his parents always taught him right from wrong, he surrounded himself with people who were moving in the wrong direction.

For many years, he was a functioning alcoholic, often showing up to work feeling so awful he would go into the restroom and cry. Still, he continued with his normal routine, thinking he could get through it somehow. Somewhere along the way, he met his wife and together they began to build a family, as well as business. He thought having a family and changing geographic locations, from Los Angeles to South Florida, would somehow quickly change him, but it didn't.

Once in South Florida, he was introduced to Calvary Chapel Fort Lauderdale. "I didn't know what to do when I started coming to church," he said. "There were these huge feelings and emotions inside of me whenever I listened to the teaching. I was moved by the people around me who would get up and give their lives to Christ, and yet, I found myself in total misery."

Then, on May 23, 2001, Rosensteel walked forward and gave his life to Christ. "After receiving Christ, I thought I could control my life and do better, but it was still one failed attempt after another," he recalled as he went through eight more years of high and lows. The death of his best friend, a person who could always try to keep him within some sort of balance, sent him off the rails.

Although he knew he couldn't continue the same story, he found himself telling his wife and kids the same lies. One day, they all came in the bedroom and shut the door. "We've

had enough," they told him. "We love you, we care about you, but you have to go get help or you need to leave."

Rosensteel agreed and went to a treatment center for sixty days. One night, he attended a Celebrate Recovery (CR) meeting Calvary Chapel held there once a week. And that's when, for the first time in his life, he began to have something he'd never had before—a real relationship with God.

"As a youngster, I knew who God was, and I thought I knew what it meant to be a Christian. But when I visited CR, I got in the Word, read it, and let God come into my heart and change me," he said. After he got out of the treatment center, he went through the entire CR 12-step program, and his life was radically changed.

Last year, together with another CR member, Rosensteel began conducting Bible studies at the treatment center, taking the Light into a very dark place. During that time, he went on a CR mission trip to Guatemala, not really knowing what to expect. This door-to-door, street-to-street evangelism was out of his comfort zone, but God used this experience to prepare him to reach his community through Calvary's Plantation campus, his home church.

Since then, he's been helping men as they go through the Celebrate Recovery study. "This is really what Vision 2023 is all about, reaching out into the community and helping people in need," said Rosensteel. "The recovery community is on the frontline. They're broken, hurting, and desperately searching for answers. So, it's up to us to lead them to the Light—the gospel of Jesus Christ." ☀️



5 TIPS FOR A HEALTHY MARRIAGE

04—BE HONEST WITH EACH OTHER



An Honest Talk About Sex

Q&A with Pastor Doug Sauder and Dr. Juli Slattery

"Christians desire to authentically pursue what is true based on God's Word and character," said Dr. Juli Slattery, clinical psychologist, speaker, president/co-founder of Authentic Intimacy, and the author of *Let's Talk About Sex*. "The heart of who we are is what we choose."

On August 24-25, Slattery will be chatting with Pastor Doug Sauder from the pulpit about God's design for sexuality, and how whether single or married, we can all consider our commitment to sexual integrity. Meanwhile, here's a preview to their upcoming conversation . . .

What is the world's definition of authentic intimacy and how does it differ from God's design for sexuality?

DS: If love is authentic, it will last a lifetime. If I say "I will love you forever" and circumstances change my love, then my love is revealed as something less than authentic. I think often we are "in love" with the idea of love and so we chase feelings, and as our feelings change (and they will) we end up chasing the wind. As for intimacy, it is much more than a physical act, but a mingling of souls. Like the painting of a masterpiece or the writing of a best-selling novel, intimacy cannot be rushed. It takes time to experience intimacy—to be fully known and fully loved. This is the essence of God's unconditional acceptance of us. As we trust God's love and acceptance for us, that's when we experience true intimacy with Him . . . and that's when our relationships can experience life-giving intimacy.

JS: "Authentic Intimacy" combines two words that our culture and God would define differently.

On *Authentic*: What's the most authentic or important thing about you? Culture

tells you it is based on how you feel and your experiences. To be authentic means to freely express whatever you think and feel without shame. This means that I might authentically love someone now but authentically despise them a year from now, based on how they treat me or make me feel. The Bible has a different definition of authentic. Basketball legend John Wooden put it best when he said, "Ultimately being true to our Creator gives us the purest form of integrity." Christians should authentically pursue what is true based on God's Word and character. The heart of who we are is what we choose.

On *Intimacy*: This means closeness, vulnerability, and experiencing each other's presence in a profound and meaningful way. Intimacy requires safety and trust. The Bible says we were created for intimacy with God and others. That intimacy can take the form of close friendships, spiritual kinship, co-laboring for the Lord, and family relationships. Marriage is a unique form of intimacy. It is set apart as a covenant representing Christ and His bride, the Church. God has created sex as a way to mark and celebrate that covenant promise.

The world tends to minimize most forms of true intimacy. Relationships are superficial, transient, and "me centered" rather than based on longstanding connection and commitment. Even marriage is often founded on feelings of being in love, not a life-long promise. As a result, loneliness is at an all-time high. Sex is used by our world as a substitute for true connection.

Our church is looking for new ways to talk about sexuality. So, what are some things we should talk about so believers understand and apply God's design for sexuality?

DS: It is clear in our world that we are not going to win the argument on the streets by being the morality police. Our greatest apologetic is living out what we say we believe. Christian couples should have the best marriages, the closest friendships, and the best sex lives. Christian singles should enjoy their devotion to Jesus and their community of friends as they live in purity and build the kingdom of God. This way of living is so counter cultural and so distinct that it should attract nonbelievers to the Christian community out of a deep curiosity. If we teach the biblical sexual ethic without modeling it ourselves, our words will seem empty to those we are trying to reach.

JS: Even the most seasoned Christians have difficulty articulating God's design for sexuality. Growing up in church, we probably learned a list of rules related to sex, but we never learned God's heart. Why did He create us as sexual people? Is it just so we can get married and have babies?

Before we talk about any sexual issue, we have to get to the heart of the underlying narrative. Our narrative explains the why. Frankly, culture presents a compelling narrative that describes the purpose of sexuality. In contrast, the church's traditional teaching on sexuality has been quite one-dimensional, focused on saving sex for marriage. Over the past several years of study, I've discovered that the Bible presents an amazing, powerful narrative that helps us make sense of all of our sexual desires, struggles, and temptations. God's purpose for sex isn't limited to "just hang on until you get married." Sexuality is a holy metaphor created to show us the spiritual reality of God's covenant love.

Christians are not winning the argument about sexual morality in a lost world, so how do we reach the broken and capture human hearts?

DS: We will win the moral argument by being distinct. There will be refugees from the sexual revolution taking place and they will be looking for something to fill the void. We know that void is spiritual and can only be filled by Jesus, but our way of life is what they will see first. Tim Keller describes the attraction of the early church in a broken sexual culture this way: "The early church was strikingly different from the culture around it in this way—the pagan society was stingy with its money and promiscuous with its body. A pagan gave nobody their money and practically everybody their body. And the Christians came along and gave nobody their body and practically everybody their money."

JS: We need to make a distinction between the conversations we have with fellow Christians and those we have with non-believers around sexuality. Christ-followers need to be discipled in how to live out their faith in every area of their lives, sexuality included. However, people who don't know God are unlikely to be drawn to Him because of our ability to win an argument about gay marriage or any other sexual issue. They don't need biblical sexual morality. They need the Lord.

While we should have robust conversations within the body of Christ about what it means to honor God with our sexuality, I don't believe those discussions often belong outside the church walls. In fact, they can be a deterrent to the real conversation we need to be having: Who is Jesus Christ to you?

We have lost our ability to share hope with the world not because we don't know what to say about sexual issues, but because we have forgotten how to live and love as Christ loves us.

Jesus told us to be light in a dark world. We should live differently than everyone else in our culture. We are aliens who don't belong here. Our sexual beliefs, actions, and attitudes should appear strange to a watching world. This is our witness and what will cause people to wonder why we make different decisions about every area of our lives, including our sexuality.

The "do whatever you want" narrative of our world will not ultimately satisfy the deep longings of the human heart for connection. To some extent, we have all experienced the emptiness of seeking romance and sexual fulfillment apart from the intimacy it was intended to represent. God's design for covenant and sexuality is wired within our bodies. When what the world offers doesn't satisfy, we should be prepared to give an answer for the hope within us. That answer is not a list of rules, but the invitation for Jesus to become Healer, Redeemer, and Lord. ☀️

SEEN AND HEARD BY GOD

Rebecca Jean Baptiste's Story





Rebecca Jean Baptiste once wondered if God was real. And if He was, she thought, *Does He see me, does He hear me?*

Her journey of discovery started in January of 2013, with a series of events that changed her life forever. God led her to His Caring Place, which led her to Calvary, where she got saved. A month later, she gave birth to her son, Brandon. And a month after, she got baptized.

"Calvary has been my family since then," said Baptiste. "God used this place, this family, to bring so much healing, community, and purpose to my life. I've often wondered what it would have been like if I hadn't come here . . . and I'm just so incredibly grateful that I'm not on this journey alone."

And here I was, deep in conversation with a man by the name of Matthew, who asked how he could pray for me.

That sense of wonder and gratitude has never left her, not even in tough times. As a single mother, it's not easy sometimes. She's had to face real challenges, like mastering the art of doing more with less and carrying living costs alone.

A couple of months ago, she was having a really rough day. Earlier in the day, she'd prayed, "Lord, I'm going to be faithful in tithing and in my giving. I'm not going to allow circumstances to keep me from being obedient." So, right before work, she rushed to the Calvary church office to drop in her tithe check. She continued to pray, asking God to let her know if He saw her, because she was trying so hard with what she had.

Shortly after she finished praying, she got a call from Calvary.

"At first, I was alarmed," she said, as she recalls running outside her office to take the call. "I'd never received a call from Calvary before. And here I was, deep in conversation with a man by the name of Matthew, who asked how he could pray for me." She was floored. But in a split second, she found herself sharing her living situation and how she needed God to provide.

God has answered me! she thought, as Matthew's words of prayer enveloped her like a sweet aroma, lifting up her heavy heart. In that moment, she knew, "I was seen and heard by God." ☀️




