Travel to Bali

Foreign passport holders entering Indonesia must possess a passport that is valid for a minimum of 6 (six) months from the date of arrival and a minimum of 2 (two) blank pages on the passport.

MPOX Prevention in Bali

As of October 2024, Bali, Indonesia, has not reported any new Mpox (monkeypox) cases in the Denpasar region, and the risk of contracting the virus remains low for both locals and travelers. Nationally, Indonesia has confirmed 14 cases in 2024, a decrease from the previous year. Most cases are concentrated in Jakarta, and none have been reported in Bali so far.

Bali has implemented precautionary measures, especially at entry points like airports, where travelers must complete the **SATUSEHAT Health Pass** and **screening for MPOX symptoms**. Authorities are prepared to respond if cases arise, and travelers are encouraged to maintain good hygiene and monitor for symptoms, though the likelihood of infection is low. Health officials in Bali are focusing on prevention and preparedness to ensure the safety of residents and visitors.





Customs Duty

 Duty-Free Allowances: Personal items up to USD 500 are exempt:

o Tobacco: 200 cigarettes, 25 cigars, or 100 grams

of tobacco.

o Alcohol: 1 liter duty-free.

- Excess Goods: Items exceeding these values are subject to duties.
- **Prohibited & Restricted Items:** Illegal drugs, firearms, pornographic material, and certain plants or animals.
- Cash Declaration: Declare amounts over IDR 100 million or equivalent.



- Air tickets and other expenses related to the travel to Bali, Indonesia are to be covered by the participants personally.
- Ensure that travel documents required for your travel and to enter Bali, Indonesia are in order. This may include:
 - a. valid passport with at least 6 months validity period at the time of arrival;
 - b. Roundtrip air ticket /confirmed itineraries;
 - c. Official letter of invitation, if needed;
 - d. Program of activities, for reference.



How to Apply for E-Visa?

- 2 Make Registration on the button "Apply"
- 3 Enter and upload data required
- Log in to the account registered or create new account (if you haven't had the account)
- Select the type of visa you want to apply for, enter your information, and upload the required documents
- 6 Make a payment (make sure the input data and documents are correct)
- 7 Once approved, a link to download the visa will be sent to your email.



Visa on Arrival

For international participants visiting Bali for the ADFIAP International CEO Forum XVII, please note the following details regarding the Visa on Arrival (VoA) process:

- Visa Fee: A charge of IDR 500,000 will be levied for processing the VoA.
- Payment Methods: Payments can be made using Visa, Mastercard, or JCB debit or credit cards.

Please ensure you have one of the accepted payment methods ready upon arrival to facilitate a smooth process.



The general dress code for the event is business attire. Additionally, please take note of the following dress guidelines:












Medical Care

Weather

Approximately 29 – 33 Celsius. November is known as a warm month in Bali, Indonesia. Being a tropical country, Indonesia does not have spring, summer, autumn, or winter, instead of just the two seasons of Rainy and Dry, both of which are relative. While there is significant regional variation, in most of the country (including Java and Bali) the dry season is from April to October, while the wet season is from November to March. However, global warming has made the seasons less predictable.

BALI October - November, 2024 The average maximum daytime temperature lies at 33°C (91,4°F) BALI October - November 2024 The average minimum temperature goes down to around 28°C (82,4°F)

Bali's tropical climate means sunshine is abundant, but rain showers can appear unexpectedly. To stay comfortable, be sure to bring:





Currency & Exchange rate

The national currency of Indonesia is the Indonesian Rupiah. 1 USD is approximately equivalent to IDR 15,600 - IDR 16,500. Banking hours are Monday to Friday from 8 AM to 3 PM. Most banks handle travelers' cheques and foreign currency exchange. Passports are required when cashing travelers' cheques and bank charges may be applied. International credit cards are widely accepted in Jakarta, especially Visa and MasterCard. There are plenty of ATMs with Visa, Cirrus, Maestro, or Plus symbols that are compatible with foreign banks. Such ATMs may be used by visitors to withdraw Indonesian Rupiah from foreign accounts.


Telecomunications

The Indonesian telecommunications cellular network runs on both GSM and CDMA. All mobile phone and internet providers in Indonesia have 4G/5G networks all over the country. Local prepaid cards can be brought upon arrival at the airport, or at convenience stores around the city. To call an Indonesian landline number from overseas, dial the country code (+62), followed by the area code and local telephone number (7 or 8 digits). To call an Indonesian mobile number from overseas, dial the country code (+62), followed directly by the mobile number excluding the "0" from the beginning of the number, which is a prefix for calling domestically



Electrical Plug

Electric power supply is 220 volts AC in all regions, so you will need a transformer to use any 110-volt electronic equipment. The sockets will only fit two pin rounded tip plugs (technically known as Type C, E, and F adapters) so you may also need a plug adapter.




