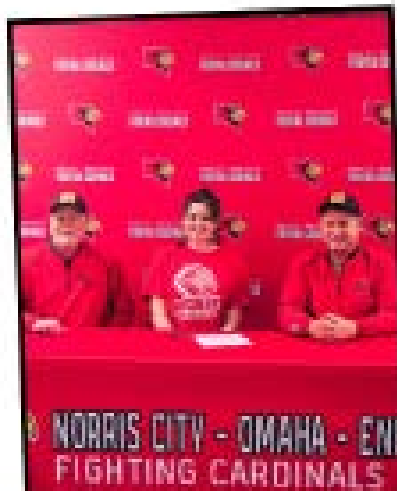
## S3DA Archers Earn Collegiate Scholarships!

*"The first buck busted me when I drew, but the second one didn't. I waited until he looked away, made a good shot, and watched him drop within 40 yards. I learned how important timing is when drawing back."*

This hunt taught me that persistence is key and not to give up."*

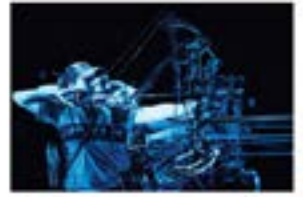

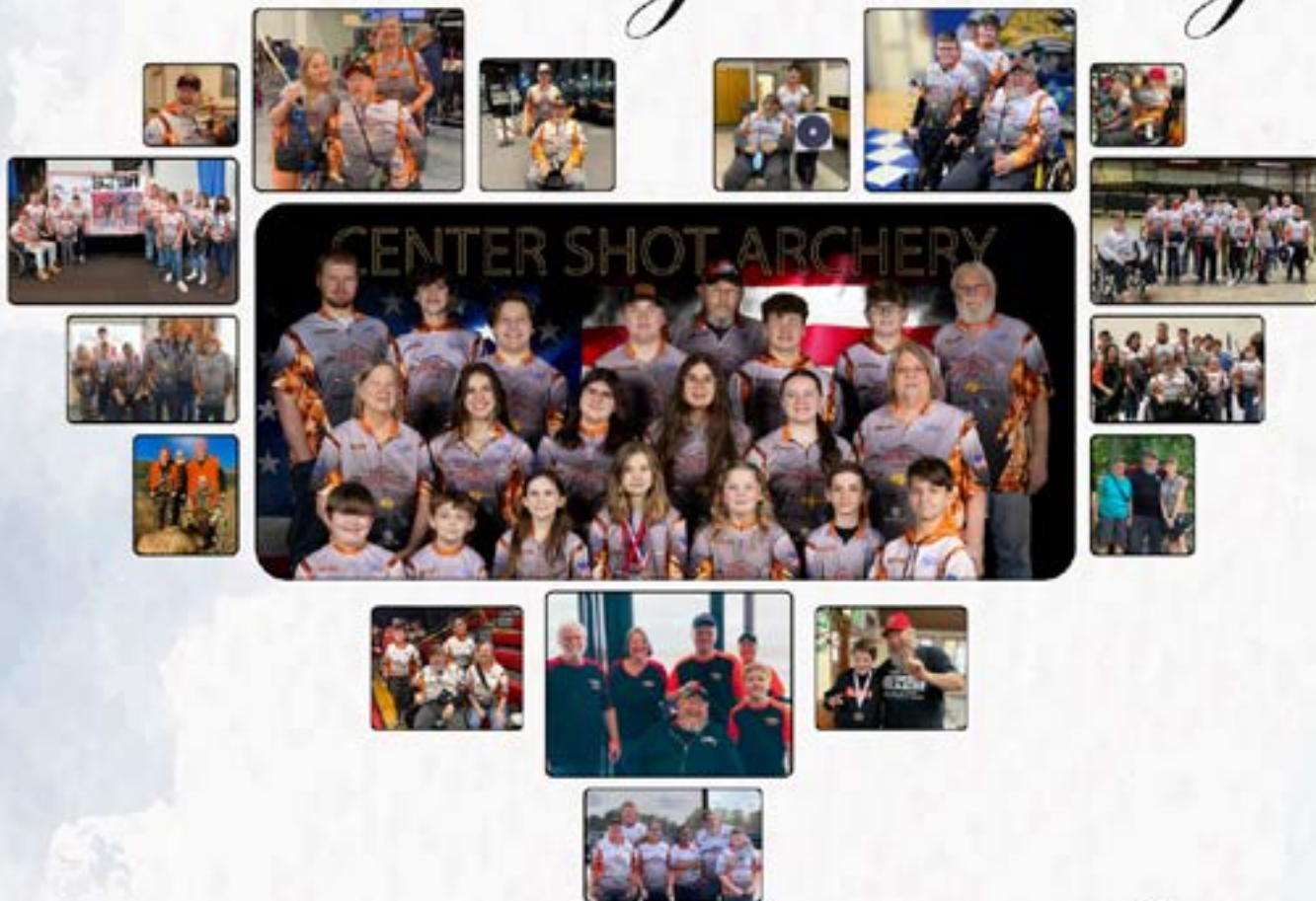
