# Mollymook Golf Club is strategically positioned for sustained growth over the coming decade.

Over the past five years, the Club has made strategic investments in both the Beachside Golf Course and the Clubhouse, ensuring that these facilities continue to meet the needs of both the local community and golf members for the foreseeable future.

The Board and Management have actively developed plans for the next phase of growth, now centred on the Hilltop Golf Course. Earlier this year, the introduction of a new hole, designated as Hole 6a, provided operational flexibility enabling maintenance and upgrade work without interruption to course play.

Growing up in the Chicagoland area of the USA. Ryan entered the world of golf course design and construction at the early age of 15. While obtaining a bachelor's degree of Land Surveying Engineering with Purdue University, Ryan's career was launched under the legendary Pete Dye. His first assignment was shaping at Whistling Straits GC (Three-time host of the PGA Championship and host of the 2021 Ryder Cup). The following years of working with Dye in the USA laid the foundation for a unique hands-on, design and build approach that has remained with him throughout his career.

Ryan later joined the Greg Norman Company, where he spent 19 years refining his skills in construction, project management, planning, and design across five continents of the globe. His international experience included the links land of Ireland, deserts of Dubai, sand dunes in Vietnam, islands in the Caribbean, and pine forests of Spain. Eventually, his journey led him to Australia, where he led the design of popular projects like The Grange – East Course, and Cathedral Golf Club for Norman. More recently Ryan has collaborated on the redesign of Glenelg Golf Club with long time SAGCA member, Neil Crafter.

# **Scope of Works**

The Course Renovation Project is divided into three construction phases spanning a six-year period. Stage 1 works will begin with Hole 13 in October 2025, moving to Hole 14 in early 2026 and then Hole 9 in July 2026. All three are priority holes, and commencing with the 13th and 14th allows for refining planning and construction processes before tackling the more complex 9th Hole, which includes works to the 18th Green, new practice green, cart staging area and extensive landscaping.

It is expected that Stage 1 will be finalised by December 2026.

#### Stage 1A

Oct 2025 - Feb 2026

#### Hole 13

Construct new green, fairway irrigation, drainage & cart path. Enhance the creek and water flow area in front of the green. Resurface back tees and red tee. add new forward tee.

#### Hole 14

Construct new teeing area and upgrade the irrigation system.

#### Hole 11

Resurface blue, white & yellow teeing areas and enlarge where possible.

#### **Budget: \$480,000**



#### Stage 1B

Feb 2026 - July 2026

#### Hole 14

Construct new green, front greenside bunker, Install new fairway irrigation and drainage infrastructure.

#### Hole 15

Resurface existing tee.

Construct additional forward tee.

**Budget: \$400,000** 

#### Stage 1C

July 2026 - Dec 2026

#### Hole 9

Construct new green & teeing area.

Install new fairway irrigation and drainage infrastructure.

Construct new cart path.

#### Hole 18

Construct new green.

Resurface teeing area and construct new forward tee. Install new fairway irrigation and drainage infrastructure.

Construct new cart path.

New practice putting green (1000m2). New cart staging area.

#### **Budget: \$1,375,000**

Construction of a new Clubhouse viewing deck will be completed in conjunction with **Stage 1C.** 

## I'm a Golf Member...

#### **Can I meet the Course Architect and Course Upgrade Team?**

Yes. An information session will be held at the Hilltop Clubhouse on the 16th of September from 4 - 7pm, whereby members can meet the team, including the Course Architect, Project Manager, Member Representatives, Club Directors, and Management.

#### Can I have a say?

Yes, all feedback and ideas are welcome.

During construction phases, members will receive regular updates and be invited to tour construction areas with course architect Ryan Van Der Veen. These tours will allow members to interact with Ryan, learning from his vast experience and understanding his unique vision and methods in golf course design.

#### Will the Course upgrade benefit me?

Yes. You will benefit from:

- ✓ Enhanced playability and quality of tees, greens, fairways, and bunkers.
- ✓ Increased course access during wet periods.
- Decreased damage to greens and tees during prolonged wet or dry conditions.
- √ Updated practice facilities and cart staging area.

#### How will I be affected during construction?

During construction, a spare hole will be used so that 18 holes remain open at all times. Construction activity will be limited to the closed hole, minimising disruption to play.

#### Will my competition golf be affected?

No, Competition golf will not be affected.

#### Will my Social Golf be affected

No Social Golf will not be affected

#### Will the Club still hold Golf Events?

Yes, regular golf events will continue throughout the construction period.
