

This group of warriors are a peculiar people. They have a special brand on them that shows the enemy he is going to be defeated because of My Glory, which sustains these chosen warriors.


The Angel Army goes with you into every terrain of darkness. Children, you are living proof that I am with those whom I call.

PSALM 105

Psalm 105 is a great example of how HE is sovereign, confirming that He works everything out for good in all seasons and times. HE allows certain things (even wrong choices of mankind) to work and bring about certain good in the end, completing His plans on many levels and in all areas.

Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord. They are plans for good and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope".

HE INSTRUCTS US: Psalm 105:1-7

- He tells us to "give Him thanks, call upon His name, and make known His doings among the peoples!"
- "To sing praises to Him, think about and talk of all His marvelous deeds and devoutly praise them"
 - "To seek and require of Him ("as our indispensable necessity")" ...
- "Crave Him and His strength (His might and inflexibility to temptation)".
 - "Seek and require His face and His presence [continually] evermore".
- He exhorts us to "[Earnestly] remember the marvelous deeds that He has done, His miracles and wonders, the judgments and sentences which He pronounced [upon His enemies, as in Egypt]".

HE CONFIRMS COVENANT: Psalm 105:8-13

- · Introduces His Covenant assuring His Faithfulness "to a thousand generations".
- "He is [earnestly] mindful of His covenant and forever it is imprinted on His heart, the word which He commanded and established to a thousand generations."

HIS FAITHFULNESS: Psalm 105:14-24

- He expounded on how He was faithful to His people throughout the journey; He provided protection, provision, and faithfulness, ("He reproved kings for their sakes").
- He also allowed testings to bring Joseph forth into a ruler position, thereby, eventually bringing His people to Egypt, saving them from the famine in the land.
- "There [the Lord] greatly increased His people and made them stronger than their oppressors."

HIS MIRACLES: Psalm 105:25-37

- He turned the hearts of the Egyptians to hate His people.
- He raised Moses and Aaron, to show "His signs among them, wonders, and miracles in the land of Ham (Egypt)", causing the Egyptians to let them go.
- Then "HE brought [Israel] forth also with silver and gold, and there was not one feeble person among their tribes".


HIS TESTINGS: Psalm 105:38-42

- HE brought the Israelites (His people) through the wilderness, provided for them covering & guidance (cloud by day and fire by night), food (manna/bread if heaven, quails), water (gushed from a rock).
- The journey might not have always been what they wanted or thought it would be, but their needs were always met.
- It says "For He [earnestly] remembered His holy word and promise to Abraham His servant" ... as HE does with us!

HIS VICTORY: Psalm 105: 43-45

His Great Faithfulness displayed...

- "And He brought forth His people with joy, and His chosen ones with gladness and singing,"
- "And gave them the lands of the nations [of Canaan], and they reaped the fruits of those peoples' labor,"
- "That they might observe His statutes and keep His laws [hearing, receiving, loving, and obeying them]. Praise the Lord! (Hallelujah!)"

Things To Be Thankful For

Being thankful is part of God's will. Be thankful in every circumstance, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus. God has an individual plan for each of us, but part of His will also include that we are grateful. Thankfulness is an important biblical theme.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 says, "Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. Give thanks in everything, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Did you understand that? Give thanks in all circumstances. Gratitude should be a way of life for us, flowing naturally from our hearts and lips. Looking at the scriptures deeper, we understand why we should be thankful and how to have gratitude in different circumstances.

Psalm 136:1 says, "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his great love endures forever (NIV)." Here we have two reasons to be thankful: God's abiding goodness and his constant love. When we recognize the nature of our depravity and understand that, apart from God, there is only death (John 10:10; Romans 7:5), our natural response is to be thankful for the life He gives us.

Psalm 30 gives glory to God for His deliverance. David writes, "I will glorify you, O Lord, because you have exalted me, and have not allowed my enemies to rejoice over me. Lord my God, I cried out to you, and you healed me.

Psalm 28, for example, describes David's anguish. It is a cry to God for mercy, protection, and justice. After David cries out to God, he writes, "Blessed be the Lord, who heard the voice of my prayers. The Lord is my fortress and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I was helped, so my heart rejoiced, and with my song, I will praise him" (Psalm 28:6-7). Amid difficulties, David remembers who God is, and thanks to knowing and trusting God, he gives thanks.

Job had a similar attitude of praise, even in the face of death: "Naked I came out of my mother's womb, and naked I will return there. The Lord gave, and the Lord took away; be the name of the blessed Lord" (Job 1:21).

Paul was being persecuted, yet he wrote, "But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ Jesus, and through us manifests in every place the savor of his knowledge" (2 Corinthians 2:14).

The writer of Hebrews says, "Therefore, since we receive an unshakable kingdom, let us have gratitude, and through it let us serve God by pleasing him with fear and reverence" (Hebrews 12:28).

Peter tells us that we should be thankful for "various trials," saying that, through difficulties, our faith "may be found in praise and glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed" (1 Peter 1:6-7). God's children are grateful people because they realize how much they have received from us.

According to 2 Timothy 3:2, one of the hallmarks of the last days is a lack of gratitude. Wicked people will be "ungrateful or ungrateful." We should be thankful that God is worthy of our gratitude. It is fair to give Him credit for "every good and perfect gift" that He gives us (James 1:17).

When we are grateful, our focus is no longer on our selfish desires or the pain of current circumstances. Expressing gratitude helps us remember that God is in control. So, gratitude is not only convenient, but it is healthy and beneficial to us. It reminds us of the larger view that we belong to God, and that we have been blessed with every spiritual blessing (Ephesians 1:3). Truly, we have an abundant life (John 10:10), and gratitude is appropriate.

WHAT TO DO FOR A HEART ATTACK

A heart attack occurs when part of the heart muscle doesn't get enough blood due to a blockage. The more time that passes without treatment to restore blood flow, the greater the damage to the heart muscle.

SIGNS OF A HEART ATTACK

- * Pain and tingling in the left hand that radiates up the arm and into the jaw.
- * Tightness or heaviness in the chest described as an "elephant sitting on their chest".
- * Aching sensation in the center of the chest which can spread to the neck, jaw and back on the

left side

- * Shortness of breath
- * Excessive sweating, fast pulse rate and lightheadedness
- * Nausea, vomiting, indigestion or heartburn

TREATMENT

- * Immediately call 911
- * Have them lie down and keep them warm and calm
- * Ask if they have Nitroglycerin prescribed by their doctor and place it under their tongue which

will be absorbed immediately and alleviate the chest pain. If the pain doesn't go away, give them another Nitroglycerin and wait for the ambulance to arrive.

- * Give them one adult aspirin to chew OR two baby aspirins to chew
- * If they go unconscious and there is no pulse, start CPR and use an AED, if it is available
- * DO NOT take the patient to the hospital yourself because the patient could go into cardiac arrest on the way and in order to do CPR you would have to get them on a flat surface out of the car.
- * When the paramedics get to your house, they can start treating the patient with medication,

Oxygen, EKG and communicate directly with the doctor in the Emergency Room



The Rewards of Relationship

Isaiah 43: 26, BSB Remind Me, let us argue the matter together. State your case, so that you may be vindicated.

The entire phrase "Lets us argue the matter" comes from one Hebrew word meaning "to judge, govern." The word "together" means "united". This means that God is desiring to include us in His decision-making process. God is looking for us to simply seek Him in the many areas of our life. As we trust Him and press in, we unlock a genuine relationship with God. A great aspect of this relationship is realizing just how much God wants to share with us. Understand that God is beyond good. He is beyond fair and the blessings of intimacy far beyond our own understanding. Now more than ever, God is inviting us into a special depth in Him that allows us to make decisions- IF we make the first step of reasoning things out with Him.

We know that God is the righteous judge, but He is also a living, breathing God with His own unique will and emotions. As we interface with God we are engaging Him through His emotions and will. Many Christians have not scraped the surface of this type of relationship with God. They do not realize how God desires to share all things with His beloved people.

The more that we talk things through with God, we advance in relationship with Him. As we advance in relationship, we stop praying to our own idea of who God is and start to learn of Him. A true spirt-led ministry will only come from the knowledge of Him. It is our glory to advance in this.


1 Peter 1:3, BSB His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through the knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. The NLT replace "the knowledge of Him" with "knowing Him".

Our relationship with God allows our true identity to come out. As our identity comes out we naturally advance within God's Kingdom and in the realms of authority that God has for us. A simple true interaction with God is fellowshipping with His glory. The more we fellowship with Him the more we a transformed from glory to glory.

2 Corinthians 3:18, ESV "But we all, with open face, beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

The deeper we go into this realm of the Spirit, the more our heart and God's heart become united. It is in this union that we are able to hear and see clearly. In this realm of counsel, the disclosure that God gives becomes more and more pure and the distortions of "self" that come from being separated from God grow dimmer and dimmer.

The Other Side of the Cross



It's good to remind ourselves what Jesus did, but Jesus wants us to take what He did on the cross, and use it for His glory. He didn't die in vain on the cross; He did it to bring man back into right standing with God, and empower him against Satan. Are you empowered?

What Do You Mean I Am Not Walking in the Spirit? PART 3 Nancy Connell

17For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, {what your FLESH wants will not line up with the Spirit – It will NOT line up to the Word of God or the nature of God – It would be selfish – sinful - it is a battle that you will have to fight until the day you reach your final destination. You have to wake up every morning and CHOOSE to walk in the Spirit – no matter what your FLESH wants or desires (and I am not talking about your physical body – I am talking about SELF desires, pleasures that you may want to choose

over something that God wants you to do for that day. Or doing something you think God would approve of without making sure it is what God wants... a good thing is not necessarily a God thing... some good things are more "self" provoked.- the FLESH)

(Continuing verse 17) and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. {There may be a time where you want to go to the store and shop, but the Spirit is telling you to stay home and clean – you have to decide which one to give into. You may never even know the reason why. For all you know it could just be a test of obedience. Maybe you want to give a child money and God says not this time and every ounce of your body is like it is my child, etc... but the language of LOVE is also knowing when to say no... But the question is, if you are not walking in LOVE or are missing any of the fruits of the Spirit – your will – your FLESH will war with conflict)

(So why do they conflict with each other?)

(Continuing with verse 17) They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. 18But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

{The Spirit is to lead you so that you do not give into the FLESH that is the opposite of God. When Jesus died and gave us the Holy Spirit and if we walk IN the HOLY SPIRIT we are NO LONGER UNDER THE LAW OF THE FLESH. Ask yourself if what you are doing or the motive behind it is to benefit you or others – if you are doing it for self-purposes only 9.5 times out of 10 it is done in the FLESH and not the Spirit.}

{So what is the LAW of the Flesh? It is what will keep you out of Heaven.}

19The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; 20idolatry and witchcraft, hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions 21and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

(This list that was just read will KEEP YOU OUT OF HEAVEN and WILL STOP YOU FROM WALKING IN THE SPIRIT. It will stop you from producing fruit and it ONLY takes one to remove the 100% walking in the Spirit. Think about that just for a minute. If you are having fits of rage – you just lost a part of being able to walk in the Spirit. You also lost at least one of your fruits of the Spirit – Self Control. You have to be able to humble yourself and admit to it and see how it is a SELF SERVICE and give it to God. Learn to change that behavior of your flesh by producing "self – control". A good way of doing this is LOVE. Do a LOVE and SELFLESS act towards the person or situation that is causing the fits of rage. Watch how HARD it is to kill the flesh, but as you do it, the door for the Spirit becomes WIDE open and fruit begins to produce and it gets easier.

So when God says YOU are NOT walking totally in the Spirit... that means it is INSPECTION time. Inspect what your actions and behavior is. Inspect your fruit and ask God to show you where your weaknesses are and then ask God to help you to strengthen it.
