

The popular snack that began as repurposed Disneyland trash!

Not long after Disneyland opened in 1955, Frito-Lay installed a Mexican restaurant in Frontierland called Casa de Fritos. The menu included tamales, enchiladas, and plentiful Fritos. (There was even an animatronic vending machine featuring the "Frito Kid" to dispense the corn chips.) One day, a sales representative for Alex Foods – which supplied Casa de Fritos with wholesale ingredients - noticed a pile of stale tortillas in the trash. The rep offered the restaurant a tip: cut up the tortillas and fry them, then sell them as crispy chips instead of throwing them away. The chips were a big hit, and when the new VP of Frito-Lay, Archibald Clark West, dropped by a year later, he was pleased to see so many customers snacking on what had been a waste product. West contracted with Alex Foods to produce the chips as a snack, naming them Doritos (Spanish for "little golden things"). The chips debuted nationally in 1966.





All Correct

In spring 1839, readers of the "Boston Morning Post" likely noticed two small, obscure letters at the bottom of the paper's second column: "o.k." These letters were the factchecking team's abbreviation for "all correct." Although it symbolized the team's sign-off for article accuracy, the abbreviation hardly seems accurate in and of itself. That's because it's not. The OK we know, love, and use today actually started as the editorial team's joke. In 1800s newsrooms, young staffers thought deliberately misspelling words in abbreviated slang was funny. They use abbreviations like "KG" to represent "know go" (the misspelling of no-go), and OK was their humorous [History - September 2021] alternative of "oll korrect."

Get a Grip

Did your parents take a look at your pruney fingers in the bath and tell you it was time to get out? A convenient as a built-in bath timer would be, scientists think your wrinkled digits are an involuntary nervous system reaction that gives humans a better grip on wet objects. In laboratory tests, subjects with water-wrinkled fingers could grip wet marbles better than those subjects with non-wrinkled fingers. There was no difference in picking up dry objects. This was probably a great help for our ancient ancestors gathering food from streams, but the evolutionary phenomenon can still help you grip those wet dishes in the sink. The history of TV dinners can be traced back to one big mistake - specifically, the Swanson corporation's drastic overestimation of how many turkeys people wanted to buy in 1953. Left with a surplus of 260 tons of frozen birds, Swanson salesman Gerry Thomas allegedly proposed an idea based on the prepackaged meal trays he'd been served on a recent flight. Swanson ordered thousands of metal trays and concocted a meal featuring turkey, cornbread dressing and gravy, peas, and sweet potatoes, and set an assembly line to work to put it all together. The frozen meal was sold for 98 cents and was an instant hit: Swanson sold 10 million turkey dinners that very first year. [Smithsonian Magazine - February 4, 2021
