 evidence of diving within the prior 3 months. In the absence of any such
 evidence, the diver will be required to join an orientation dive to
 successfully demonstrate the skills and abilities of a certified diver.
 If the diver is unable to pass this orientation dive or fails to demonstrate
 safe diving practices at any time, then the diver will be required to firstly
 undergo a Refresher Program where charges apply as per the schedule of
 rates listed in this brochure.
- Some flash sale/discounted accommodation offers may specifically exclude this Dive Free option and this will be clearly noted in the accommodation offer itself. Please contact the resort if there is any uncertainty about accessing this program

- Unused dives are not exchangeable for cash, credit or any other services.
- Diver groups cannot exceed 6 divers per instructor; however group size may be less than this based on the skills, experience, site selection or prevailing conditions at the time.
