Day 1: A Heart ofThanksgiving



Scripture Readings: Psalm 100:4-5, Psalm 95:1-3, 1 Chronicles 16:34, Philippians 4:6-7

Day 2: The Set Timefor Exploits

Scripture Readings: Daniel 11:32, Ephesians 3:20, Joshua 1:9, Isaiah 40:31

Today, let us focus our prayers on the promise of God to do great exploits in every area of our lives and ministry. The Bible assures us that those who know their God will be strong and do exploits. As we seek God's face during this period of fasting and prayer, let us believe for extraordinary achievements and breakthroughs that can only come from Him.





- Mighty God, we come before You with hearts full of expectation. We declare that this is our set time for exploits. You have promised in Your Word that those who know You will be strong and do great things. We stand on this promise today, believing for supernatural breakthroughs and victories in every area of our lives and ministry. Amen.
- Heavenly Father, we ask for Your strength and boldness to step out in faith. Empower us by Your Spirit to accomplish great exploits for Your kingdom. Remove any fear or doubt that hinders us from pursuing the extraordinary plans You have for us. Fill us with courage and perseverance to see Your promises fulfilled in our lives, in Jesus precious name, Amen.
- Lord, we pray for Your divine favour and opportunities to manifest in OWOM and in our individual lives. Open doors that no man can shut and lead us into paths of success and fruitfulness. Day 3: Enablement for Exploits

Scripture Readings: Philippians 4:13, 2 Corinthians 9:8, Ephesians 3:20, Isaiah 40:29-31, Judges 6-7

God does not call us to do great things for Him without also providing the resources, strength, and wisdom needed to carry out these tasks. The story of Gideon in Judges 6-7 is a powerful reminder of this truth. Gideon saw himself as the least in his family and his clan as the weakest in Manasseh, yet God called him a mighty warrior and used him to deliver Israel from the Midianites. Despite his initial fear and doubt, Gideon was enabled by God to do great exploits because he trusted in God's provision, help and guidance.



Day 3: Enablement for Exploits

Similarly, we may sometimes feel inadequate or unprepared for the tasks God has set before us. However, we must remember that our sufficiency comes from God. He equips those He calls.

When God calls us to do something significant, He also imparts the necessary skills, resources, and courage to accomplish it.

Reflection

Reflect on areas in your life where you feel God is calling you to do great things. Are there dreams and visions that seem too big for you? Remember that God does not expect you to accomplish these tasks on your own. He promises His strength and provision. Trust in His enablement and step out in faith.



- Strength and Courage: Lord, we ask for Your strength and courage to pursue the great exploits You have set before us. Help us to overcome any fear or doubt that hinders us from stepping out in faith. Fill us with boldness to carry out Your will. Amen.
- Provision and Resources: Jehovah Jireh, we pray for the provision and resources needed to accomplish the tasks You have given us. Open doors of opportunity and supply every need according to Your riches in glory. May we experience Your abundant blessings in every ministry and life endeavour. Amen.

Scripture: Jeremiah 1:10 (NIV) - "See, today I appoint you over nations and kingdoms to uproot and tear down, to destroy and overthrow, to build and to plant."

Survival and Revival:

 Nigeria, you shall survive this difficult season and emerge stronger and more unified.

Scripture: Isaiah 43:19 (NIV) - "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland."

 mortgaging Nigeria's
 colourful destiny begin to
 collapse from now. The battle
 turns against the oppressors

 from now.

Scripture: Isaiah 10:27 (NIV) - "In that day their burden will be lifted from your shoulders, their yoke from your neck; the yoke will be broken because you have grown so fat."

Release from Lawlessness and Confusion:

 Spirits of lawlessness and confusion lose your hold completely on our nation.

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 14:33 (NIV) - "For God is not a God of disorder but of peace—as in all the congregations of the Lord's people."



Transformation of Hearts:

 Lord, take away completely from us hardness of heart.

Scripture: Ezekiel 36:26 (NIV) - "I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh."

Peace, Progress, and Prosperity:






