As you explore the offerings for Summer 2023, you will find something for everyone! We offer programs for extra academic help, credit recovery, standards recovery, and enrichment. By reading about each program, you can choose the program that is what your child needs. If you have any questions or need any help, please reach out to your child's teacher and they will help you.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration

Registration for all summer programs opens April 24, 2023, and closes May 5, 2023, at 4:30 p.m. Parents/Guardians will receive communication from their school to register by **paper copy**. Paper copies of registration will be sent home with students and will be available in each school office.

Late registration will be open May 8, 2023, and will close May 19, 2023. Late registration will be accepted as spaces are available in the chosen program.

Price

All programs are free of charge for students of Eufaula City Schools.

Transportation

Transportation will be provided to students. Parents/Guardians can indicate on the registration form if transportation is needed. All students riding the bus will need to complete a transportation form. Your child may be assigned a different bus than they ride during the school year. Routes are determined by enrollment and parents will be notified of the summer bus assignment. Students will be picked up and dropped off at their legal residence.

Meals

Students will be provided with breakfast and lunch each day at no charge.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Eligibility

Programs are available to students in Eufaula City Schools only. Students who are not enrolled in Eufaula City Schools will not be eligible to participate, with the exception of Drivers' Ed and KinderCamp.


- Kinder Camp is open to incoming Kindergartners.
- Summer Scholars is open to students who have been retained or need credit recovery. Students who are eligible will be contacted by their school.
- Summer Start is open to students who are are below grade level or missing certain skills. Students who are eligible will be contacted by their school.
- Summer Sensation and Tigers Inspired are open to all students.

Attendance

Students are expected to attend each day of the summer session for which they are enrolled. Sessions will run Monday-Thursday.

Discipline

Students will follow the discipline policy in the Eufaula City Schools Code of Conduct.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Medical Information

A nurse will be on site for each day students are on campus during the summer. Students who have daily medicine needs will need to register their medicine with the nurse, just as they do during the regular school year.

KINDERCAMP

Target Students: Incoming Kindergartners for the 2023-24 school year Dates: June 5-15 Math (Monday-Thursday) July 10-20 Reading (Monday-Thursday) Location: Eufaula Elementary School Time: 7:30-3:00

Kinder Camp is a two week program designed for incoming Kindergarten students. The purpose of this program is to orient students to Eufaula Primary School (EPS) and general Kindergarten procedures as well as give a boost in reading and math skills.

Students will learn the above skills through developmental play, role plays, songs, games, read alouds, and arts and crafts.



SUMMER SCHOLARS GRADES 3-5


Targeted Students: Students who have been retained in grades 3-5 Grades 3-5 Dates: June 5-15 Math July 10-20 Reading Time: 7:30-3:00 Location: Eufaula Elementary School

This program is designed for students who have been retained in Reading and/or Math for the 2022-23 school year. Students will receive focused, explicit instruction from a certified teacher with an emphasis placed on the critical standards for their grade level.

Students who show mastery in the critical standards with a passing score of 60% will be eligible for promotion.

Students will be assessed on the critical standards as they are taught throughout the session.

At the end of the Summer Start session, students will take the NWEA Map test as a means of measuring growth over the summer.



SUMMER SCHOLARS **GRADES 6-12**


Targeted Students: Students who have been retained in grades 6-8 and students who have failed a credit in grades 9-12 **Grades 6-12 Dates:** Session 1: June 5-29 (Monday-Thursday) Session 2: July 5-27 (Monday-Thursday) Time: 7:30-3:00 **Location: Eufaula High School**

This program is designed for students who have been retained or who have failed to receive a credit. Students will participate in credit recovery classes through Edgenuity. A certified teacher for each content area will be available for small group learning and support.

For students in grades 6-8, mastery in the credit recovery course with a passing score of 60% will be eligible for promotion.

For students in grades 9-12, students will adhere to the regulations found in the EHS Credit Recovery Plan. Click <u>here to access this</u> plan.

SUMMER START GRADES K-5

Targeted Students: Students who are behind in Reading and/or Math and have completed grades K-5 Grades K-5 Dates: June 5-15 Math (Monday-Thursday) July 10-20 Reading (Monday-Thurday) Time: 7:30-3:00 Location: Eufaula Elementary

This program is designed for students who are below grade level in Reading and/or Math. Students will receive instruction that is targeted to their need.

Students who participate in the reading camp will receive explicit reading instruction daily using Reading Horizons and small group. Students who participate in the math camp, will receive instruction in fluency and the priority skills that are specific to each grade level. All students will receive enrichment opportunities with a STEM focus.

At the end of the Summer Scholars session, students will take the NWEA Map test as a means of measuring growth over the summer. Third grade students in the reading camp will take the ACAP Reading Subtest, which is required from the Alabama State Department of Education.

Daily attendance is a requirement for this program.

*This program satisfies the requirements set forth in the Alabama Literacy Act for grades K-3 and the Alabama Numeracy Act for grades 4-5.

SUMMER START GRADES 6-8

Targeted Students: Students who are behind in Reading and/or Math Grades 6-8 Dates: June 5-29 (Monday-Thursday) Time: 7:30-3:00 Location: Eufaula High School

This program is designed for students who are below grade level in Reading and/or Math. Students will receive instruction that is targeted to their needs based on assessments given during the school year from a certified teacher.

Students will receive explicit instruction daily, coursework on Edgenuity, and small group instruction.

Daily attendance is a requirement for this program.

*This program does not qualify a retained student for promotion.



SUMMER START GRADES 9-12

Targeted Students: Students who made D's in Algebra 1, Geometry, or English Grades 9-12 Dates: June 5-29 (Monday-Thursday) Time: 7:30-3:00 Location: Eufaula High School

This program is designed for students who are below grade level in Reading and/or Math. Students will receive instruction that is targeted to their need based on assessments given during the school year from a certified teacher.

Students will receive explicit instruction daily, coursework on Edgenuity, and small group instruction.

Daily attendance is a requirement for this program.

SUMMER SENSATION GRADES K-5

Targeted Students: All ECS students who have completed grades K-5 Grades: K-5 Dates: June 26-29 (Monday-Thursday) Time: 7:30-3:00

Location: Eufaula Elementary

This enrichment opportunity is available to all ECS students who have completed grades K-5. In this one week experience, students will participate in activities that tap into their creativity through Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. Students will design projects around a central theme. Parents will be able to view their completed projects through a virtual showcase.


SUMMER SENSATION GRADES 6-8
