- Misconduct by the participants will lead to disqualification.
- A student is allowed to participate only in one event. In case he/she is found to be participating in more than one event, it will lead to disqualification.
- Refreshments will be provided in the auditorium basement. Eatables are strictly prohibited inside the Auditorium.
- Winning teams will be given a team award and contestants for individual competitions will be awarded individual prizes. An overall Champion's Trophy will be awarded to the school that secures the maximum credit points.
- The host school does not compete for the rolling trophy.
- Accompanying teachers are not allowed to help the participants during the performance, unless mentioned in the given rules.

- Registrations will be closed after the first 12 entries for group events, and 20 for individual events have been received.

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GENERAL RULES FOR INTERSCHOOL BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

1. The team must comprise of 12 players, with one coach.
2. The tournament will be held on knock-out basis.
3. As limited entries can be accommodated, therefore, the participation of teams will be on first-cum-first basis.
4. Teams are requested to bring their own kit.
5. The reporting time of all the teams on the first day of the tournament is 8:00 a.m.
6. Teams must be accompanied by their coaches/physical education teachers who will also be responsible for the conduct of the team members on and off the field.
7. The referee's decision in all cases shall be final and binding on all the teams, and no protest shall be entertained against his decision.
8. Protest, if any, should be submitted in writing within 30 minutes after the match along with a protest fee of Rs. 1000/-. The decision of the Tournament Committee/ Jury shall be final and binding.
9. Please ensure that the date of birth of each participant is mentioned clearly and matches with the school I.D card and date of birth which are mandatory to carry along.
10. The tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entry without assigning any reason. If the committee members are convinced beyond reasonable doubt that a player is overage or/and if the relevant certificate submitted as a proof of age is not found authentic, the student shall be debarred from participating in the tournament.
11. Registration Fee of Rs. 2000/- has to be deposited in cash or cheque on the spot.
12. The school will appreciate that the duly filled-in entry form is sent latest by 4th August, 2025. The filled entry forms may be sent by post or through email (scanned copies) at umesh@fasnoida.org

Brief Description

Elocution competitions are more than just contests; they are platforms that nurture and develop confidence, clarity, communication skills, eloquence, and the ability to convey a message effectively to an audience. Choral recitation focuses on teamwork, speaking with clarity and confidence, using proper pronunciation and intonation to make a strong impact.

In this event, participants will creatively spin their poem/prose around the theme of the event 'Quest Beyond'. To enhance the elocution experience they may use props and sound effects, making their performance come to life.



Rules

- The piece can be taken either from prose or poetry.
- The poem/prose should be related to the theme of the event.
- The performance should be dramatized.
- Participants must wear their school uniform which may be accessorized.
- Participating teams may use props.
- Sound effects may be used, but should not be recorded.
- Standing mikes will be provided.
- Participating teams must introduce their piece and justify their choice.



Brief Description

Welcome to “Voices from the Forest”, a creative and inspiring inter-school science competition encouraging students to observe closely, think deeply, and speak meaningfully.

A forest scene picture— with animals, birds, insects, trees, creepers, bushes, rocks, water streams, nests, and fallen leaves—will be shared with all participating schools 10 minutes before the event. This same image will be displayed on screen during the event as a visual backdrop for all participants.

In the style of a talk show, students will present their observations and thoughts about the forest scene. They can choose two or three forest elements (animal, bird, insect, or plant) and talk about it using clues from the picture and their logical thinking.



Participants are not expected to memorize or repeat textbook information or act in roles. Instead, they are encouraged to observe, think clearly, and speak mindfully.

Subtopics students can choose (one or more):

- Habitat (where it is found in the forest)
- Habits (daily activities: sleeping, eating, moving, etc.)
- Special features (tail, claws, beak, fur, etc.)
- Super senses (hearing, smell, sight, touch, etc.)
- Type of movement (flying, hopping, crawling, climbing)
- How they stay safe (self-defense methods)
- What they eat
- How they help the forest
- Any challenge they might face

How It Builds Deep Thinking in Young Minds:


Students will learn to look closely, find clues, and think beyond the obvious.

Example:

“I see a deer standing near the water. Maybe it came to drink water, but it’s also seems to be standing very still. I think it’s listening carefully to make sure no danger is near. That shows how it uses its ears to stay safe.”

This talk show is all about noticing minute details, making smart guesses, and sharing ideas with confidence.

Get ready to step into the forest with your eyes, mind, and heart because when we think like explorers, every leaf has a story to tell!



Rules

- Format: A Talk show style presentation encouraging interaction among participants
- Focus: Emphasis on critical thinking, scientific reasoning, and observation-based responses
- No Memorized Speeches: Responses should reflect understanding, not rote learning
