Tell that to Abimelech whom God Himself visited in a dream and called him a dead man.


Genesis 20:1-7 AMP 20

You enter your name or birthdate, and it will tell you about yourself, your

character or destiny, etc. This is fortune-telling/idolatry disguised.

The Bible says, participating in it is an abomination to the Lord, it's sin. There are different forms of fortune-telling, and all forbidden in Scripture. The Lord wants to protect us from any open doors to deception, especially since these times are very dark and we need to be warned of any possible deception that might take us off guard.

Definition of Fortune-telling: Art of forecasting future events and human character. Fortune-telling/divination is the offspring of idolatry. The source is demonic supernatural ability or power. It's an occult activity.

A few fortune-telling occult activities:

- § Astrology Card -forecasting the future by manipulation and placing
 of cards.
- § Astrology -forecasts events on earth by observing the stars, sun, moon, and planets, and claims to predict human character.

§ Fate Palmistry -forecasting the future, through interpretation of lines

in a person's palms.

- § Divination by Rod/Pendulum -use of a rod, pendulum, twig or other objects to locate a hidden object symmetry.
- § Psychometry -type of clairvoyance that identifies characteristics of an individual through some object a person has worn.
- § Mirror Art -forecasting the future, with the use of crystal balls, mirrors, rock crystals, and water attempts to uncover crimes, find hidden objects, etc.

§ Numerology -type of fortune-telling, in which numerical values of names and birthdates reveal a person's identity and character. Now it's disguised as games where you put your name or birthdate and tell your

character, future, and your destiny.

Deuteronomy 18:9-14, When you come into the land that God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominable practices of those nations. There shall not be found among you anyone who burns his son or his daughter as an offering, anyone who practices divination or tells fortunes or interprets omens, or a sorcerer or a charmer or a medium or a necromancer or one who inquires of the dead, for whoever does these things is an abomination to the Lord. And because of these abominations the Lord your God is driving them out before you. You shall be blameless before the Lord your God, for these nations, which you are about to dispossess, listen to fortune-teller and to diviners. But as for you, the Lord your God has not allowed you to do this.

Galatians 5:16-21, walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and Spirit against the flesh: these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if you be led by the Spirit, ye are not under law. Works of the flesh are these: Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry,

witchcraft (occult practices & drugs), hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envying, murders, drunkenness, reveling, and such like: as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

MISTAKES PEOPLE MAKE WHEN THEY ARE SICK

When you are sick, you want to get better as quickly as possible but some of your habits may actually make your symptoms worse. Avoid the following common cold and flu missteps so you can stay on the road to recovery.

DON'T TRY TO KEEP UP WITH YOUR USUAL ROUTINE - Your body needs energy to fight off that cold or flu. Make rest a priority. Cancel plans and stay home from work or school. Along with helping your body recover, you'll also keep from spreading those germs around. Stay home as long as you have severe symptoms like a cough with mucus, vomiting, diarrhea, fever or fatigue because you may be contagious. The CDC recommends staying home at least 24 hours after your fever goes away.

DON'T IGNORE FLU SYMPTOMS – Call your doctor if you have a high fever, body aches and fatigue. They can give you an antiviral drug such as Tamiflu, Relenza or Rapivab. If you take one of these in the first 48 hours that you're sick, you can shorten your illness by a few days.

DON'T SKIMP ON SLEEP – Not getting enough sleep weakens your immune system which makes it harder for you to battle the infection. Go to bed early and take naps during the day. If your cough is keeping you up, take some honey and run a humidifier to help you breathe easier.

DON'T BUG YOUR DOCTOR FOR ANTIBIOTICS – They only kill bacteria and the cold and flu are caused by viruses. <u>Antibiotic resistance</u> is a huge global health problem because bacteria get used to antibiotics so ultimately they won't work when we need them to.

DON'T FORGET TO DRINK ENOUGH – When you stay hydrated, you can thin your mucus and break up congestion. It can also fend off headaches. Drink plenty of water and sip on warm beverages like herbal tea or broth. It can help with a sore throat.

DON'T SKIP MEALS AND SNACKS – Calories and nutrients will fuel the immune cells that attack cold and flu viruses. Try eating a bowl of chicken soup as it may help relieve some of your symptoms.

DON'T SMOKE – It damages your lungs and irritates your throat which can make your symptoms worse. Ditch the cigarettes and vape pens and steer clear of secondhand smoke.

DON'T STRESS OUT — Your body makes a hormone that is released when you stress out which can be hard on the immune system. It also increases inflammation which will make your stuffy nose even worse. Make an effort to focus on relaxing and recovering and you may be back on your feet sooner.



Since it is God's essential nature to love, He demonstrates His love by lavishing it on undeserving people who are in rebellion against Him.

So many confused God's love as a sappy, sentimental, or even a romantically feeling. This is why they do not really comprehend God's love because it is not a feeling. That is such a small aspect of it. God's love is there even when you do not feel anything at all. His love is an agape love, the love of self-sacrifice. An unconditional love that has not beginning and no end.

God demonstrates His sacrificial love by sending His Son to the cross to pay the penalty for our sin {I John 4:10 -10This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.}, by drawing us to Himself {John 6:44 - 44"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day.}, by forgiving us of our rebellion against Him, and by sending His Holy Spirit to dwell within us, thereby enabling us to love as He loves.

He did all this even though we did not deserve it. {Romans 5:8 - "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us"}

God's love is personal. He knows each of us individually and loves us personally. His is a mighty love that has no beginning and no end. Why does God love us? It is because of who He is: "God is love." pg 15
