Northern Lights and the Wildlife of Northern Manitoba I Itinerary (subject to change)

You are embarking on an adventure where daily activities will be determined by weather, opportunities to view wildlife, and other various elements that make up the diverse landscape. This itinerary is a general listing of activities and excursions that may happen during any part of the program. While chosen locations are favorable for witnessing the Northern Lights, we cannot guarantee their appearance. Many factors affect the visibility of this naturally occurring phenomenon.

Day 1: ARRIVE IN WINNIPEG, MANITOBA,
CANADA Upon arrival to Winnipeg
Richardson International Airport an Orbridge
representative will assist with your transfer
to the hotel. Tonight join fellow travel
companions for a welcome dinner and learn
important details of this week's adventures.

Day 2: WINNIPEG I FLIGHT TO GANGLER'S NORTH

SEAL RIVER LODGE Take an early morning
charter flight, arriving at the private airstrip
of Gangler's North Seal River Lodge. Gather
for lunch followed by a brief introduction
to the property and available activities.

Settle into your cabin, then rejoin the group
for a tour of the surrounding area by allterrain vehicle. Return to the lodge for hors
d'oeuvres and a relaxing dinner. If interested
in viewing the northern lights if they appear,
request a wake-up call at the reception desk
before retiring for the evening.

Gangler's North Seal RiverLodge (B,L,D)

Day 3: WILDLIFE EXCURSION After breakfast
embark on a wildlife spotting expedition
across the vast terrain. Lunch is a special
treat—an incredible fresh Shore Lunch. After
dinner watch the sun set over the river.
Overnight:
Gangler's North Seal River Lodge (B,L,D)

Day 4: AREA EXPLORATION Set off on a floatplane excursion north to the Barren Lands to spot for migrating caribou. Land on the tundra (if conditions allow) to stroll the area by foot. Retreat back to the lodge for hors d'oeuvres, dinner and a presentation on Manitoba's ecosystems and the North Seal River's unique characteristics. The evening provides another opportunity to view the northern lights.

Day 5: OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES After breakfast choose from a variety of independent, group or guided activities for the day. Tonight gather with fellow travel companions for a convivial farewell dinner to celebrate the week's arctic adventures.

Day 6: FLIGHT TO WINNIPEG I DEPART FOR U.S.
After breakfast bid a fond farewell to the
Gangler's Lodge staff. Take the return charter
flight to Winnipeg where you'll connect with

Activity Level: Guests should be able to stand for 90 minutes at a time without sitting, walk a moderate-paced mile on uneven terrain without difficulty, and enter/exit skiffs with little trouble. The lodge is located in a remote area without medical facilities or typical infrastructure. Outdoor activities have no access to toilet facilities or other amenities for durations of several hours.

GANGLER'S NORTH SEAL RIVER LODGE

Over 30 years ago, the Gangler family relocated from Chicago to Northern Manitoba to pursue their dream of building and operating a sport fishing camp. Today, Gangler's North Seal River Lodge is recognized as a premier destination. The area is an ideal playground for endless outdoor activities and wildlife spotting.

Lodge Amenities: Restaurant with full-service cash bar open during meal times, lounge area with ping-pong and pool table, tackle store and complimentary fly-tying table, complimentary video library, complimentary Wi-Fi, and satellite telephone and fax machine (additional fees apply).

Osprey Cabin: A private bedroom with two twin beds, dresser, nightstand and private en suite bathroom (with soap, shampoo and hair dryer), and a shared living area.

Eagle Cabin: A full private cabin with two twin beds, dresser, nightstand, private en suite bathroom (with soap, shampoo and hair dryer), and private living area.

Cabin Amenities: Individual climate control, full carpeting, screened-in porch with chairs, closet, couch, coffee table and chairs, coffee maker, and TV with VCR/DVD player.
